RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MCMILLAN EQUINE FEEDS MAIDEN (1200m)

Trainer **A Frye** was issued with a warning for presenting and racing GLORY CHANCE without the notified nasal strip.

Trainer **K Moore** admitted a charge of presenting the wrong horse (AMAZON GODDESS which was an acceptor in Race 9) to race as PARAWANUI LAD. This error was detected at the inspection area with the correct horse then being saddled and presented. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee fined K Moore the sum of \$500.

HAZELSGIRL (B Murray) - Declared a late scratching at 11.55am on veterinary advice after escaping riderless from the stabling area and jumping a fence.

SOLA FIDE (C Campbell) - Bounded at the start losing ground, held up for clear running early in the straight.

GLOBAL STAR (C Barnes) - Crowded and lost ground at the start when runners to either side shifted ground.

AORANGI ASSASSIN (M Gestain) - Slow to begin.

MILFORD SOUND (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, steadied near the 1100 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of JUSTABELLE (G Jogoo) which shifted inwards abruptly before being corrected by its rider. G Jogoo was advised to exercise greater care. When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that after a poor beginning the gelding had got further back than intended after having to be steadied shortly after the start. Ms Wynne further explained she had then considered trying to improve forward from the 600 metres but felt she would have had to cover too much extra ground to do so, electing to stay to the inside and ride for luck with the gelding then making good ground before running out of room over the concluding stages, adding that MILFORD SOUND had been inclined to race greenly and would benefit from today's experience.

ADANNAYA (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

JUSTABELLE (G Jogoo) - Raced wide throughout.

IFFRAAJABLE (C Johnson) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 2 CONGRATULATIONS CHRIS JOHNSON MAIDEN (1200m)

Trainer **N Lloyd** (PONY EXPRESS) was issued with a warning for presenting runner without notified gear (pre race ear covers).

COLLABORATOR (K Chowdhoory) - Proved difficult to get to the barriers delaying the start. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres.

ALLASERA (K Asano) - Crowded and buffeted shortly after the start when runners to either side shifted ground.

PONY EXPRESS (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

NELLIE GREY (G Jogoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

RESUSCITATE (C Campbell) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with NELLIE GREY, taken out by COLLABORATOR shortly after the start then having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LARPOWER which was being dictated inwards by IZZY HOUDINI (T Jonker). Taking into account the contributing shift from COLLABORATOR, T Jonker was issued with a warning on this occasion. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

T Jonker (COLLABORATOR) was issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear.

STREET FIGHTIN MAN (C Johnson) - Raced wide throughout.

LARPOWER (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover until improving forward outside the leader passing the 600 metres.

KHITAN WARRIOR (T Moseley) - Raced wide throughout, when questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner rider advised that the gelding had not been suited drawing the outside barrier today and had never been able to get into the race.

Race 3 ONCEUPONATIME AT BELMONT PARK SPRINT HANDICAP (1200m)

LINEDANCEKING (S Toolooa) - Raced wide without cover throughout, shifted inwards abruptly under pressure passing the 50 metres having to be straightened.

K Chowdhoory (ROCK SENSATION) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 EZYKONECT RURAL BROADBAND DASH HANDICAP (1200m)

GOODANYA (D Bothamley) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

TAP TAP (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VASILIKI (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

STELLA DAZE (S Wynne) - Lay out shortly after the start making contact then being steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after.

NOAH (C Johnson) - Contacted shortly after the start when STELLA DAZE lay out.

IFFIDA (G Jogoo) - Raced wide without cover.

OUR FRANKIE (M Gestain) - Raced wide throughout.

BLAIR FLIGHT (K Kwo) - Over raced in the middle stages.

BENAUD (K Asano) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when KITTY CUGAT was taken out by the weakening TENNESSEE ROCK.

TENNESSEE ROCK (R Beeharry) - Rider was shown film footage in the presence of the riding mentor and advised that in the Stewards' view he should have attempted to restrain his mount in the middle stages with BLAIR FLIGHT which was racing to his inside travelling very strongly.

Race 5 HOPKINSONS & NIGHT 'N DAY PARK HANDICAP (2200m)

PICKUP (B Murray) - Raced wide in the early stages.

HOT TAP (G Jogoo) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

ALBUTME (S Toolooa) - Lay out shifting wider on the track when negotiating the bend near the 1300 metres.

BABY MENAKA (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had every opportunity and was unable to offer any excuse.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE HANDICAP (1600m)

Trainer **P Harris** was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after MCGOWAN was presented without an item of notified gear (blinkers).

NYMPHADORA TONKS (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EASY ON THE EYE (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MISS CURIOUS (C Johnson) - Inclined to get its head up when over racing in the middle stages.

TOO FERLAXED (K Kwo) - Held up on entering the home straight only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres and when doing so was further inconvenienced by LADY VERAWOOD which shifted out after making slight contact with MISS CURIOUS.

MCGOWAN (D Bothamley) - Held up early in the run home.

Race 7 CRAIGMORE SUSTAINABLE HOLDINGS LTD TIMARU CUP (1600m)

The start was delayed two minutes when GALLANT BOY required farrier attention behind the barriers.

WHALE SONG (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

FRANKIE THE FOX (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

I AM A ROCK (C Barnes) - Got its head up when being steadied to avoid the heels of KILLARNEY which shifted out briefly when over racing passing the 1000 metres.

BENEFICIAL (T Moseley) - Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (K Chowdhoory) - Held up passing the 200 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

WHO DARES WINS (S Wynne) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been flat throughout with the strong tempo of the race but would in her opinion be improved by the run.

Race 8 REMEMBERING THOSE WE LOST IN 2020 HANDICAP (1600m)

BIG WINK (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

COLORADO MISS (C Barnes) - Slow to begin, briefly crowded passing the 200 metres when JEWEL OF PATCH shifted outwards under pressure.

SURE IS (T Comignaghi) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground, had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 150 metres.

ARE YOU CEREAL (T Jonker) - Over raced in the run down the back straight.

SOUTHERN OCEAN (L Allpress) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HANUA HANK (J Lowry) which was improving quickly to the inside of QUEEN JETSUN (S Wynne) near the 1400 metres. S Wynne and J Lowry were both advised to exercise greater care. When being steadied HANUA HANK went back onto ALL BLACK MAGIC which also had to be steadied and shifted outwards hampering JEWEL OF PATCH.

JEWEL OF PATCH (L Callaway) - Hampered near the 1400 metres, raced three wide without cover.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (T Moseley) - Had to be steadied off heels near the 1400 metres.

S Wynne (QUEEN JETSUN) was spoken to regarding her whip use.

Race 9 CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN MAIDEN (1600m)

THE EMPORESS (M Gestain) - Slow to begin and further hampered when PAX VOBISCUM (K Asano) which was being restrained to take cover shifted in. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care.

KRISTOFFERSON (S Wynne) - Crowded and lost ground shortly after the start.

RIPEMGINI (L Callaway) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

PAX VOBISCUM (K Asano) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

K Chowdhoory (DA VINCI GIRL) was issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift in shortly after the start dictating EGO TRIPPER inwards crowding KRISTOFFERSON which was checked. Contributing was some outward movement by TAPPY'S LAD onto BARRETT and with film footage somewhat inclusive K Chowdhoory was given the benefit of the doubt on this occasion.

BARRETT (J Lowry) - Contacted on two occasions passing the 1100 metres by DA VINCI GIRL (K Chowdhoory) when that runner was attempting to obtain cover. K Chowdhoory was advised to exercise greater care.

AMAZON GODDESS (R Beeharry) - Underwent a post race veterinary inspection after returning to the enclosure with blood present in a nostril which revealed a laceration consistent with the mare banging its head on the barrier.

Race 10 DAVID WALSH STAYERS HANDICAP (2200m)

TAKE THE DEEL (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards crowding COUP DREAMWOOD which lost ground.

COUP DREAMWOOD (K Chowdhoory) - Crowded start losing ground, steadied passing the 250 metres when crowded between ROCKWITHME (S Wynne), which shifted away from COLOSSAL which was improving to its inside, and SHOCK AND AWE (G Jogoo) which shifted inwards under pressure before being straightened. Both S Wynne and G Jogoo were advised to exercise care.

STOP MAKING SENSE (Y Chew) - Began awkwardly losing ground, was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

NOT USUAL HEAVEN (T Jonker) - Raced keenly into the first bend having to be restrained, continued to race keenly through the early to middle stages.

SULU SEA (M Gestain) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

ZAREEBA (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

VERMONT (C Campbell) - Held up early in the final straight.
