RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TEAM LANDRIGAN 2YO (1100 Metres)
LADY LOLA L Allpress – Was tightened at the start and slow away. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and shifted out dictating MOLINARA over extra ground. L Allpress advised Stewards that LADY LOLA raced greenly throughout.	
JUST BOB J Fawcett – Raced greenly in the home straight and was inclined to lug out.	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MDN F&M (1200 Metres)

H Schofer JAXX BE NIMBLE admitted a breach of Rule 649(1)(a) in that she attempted to weigh out without leathers and irons. H Schofer was fined \$500.

DROP THE BEAT L Hemi – Bounded at the start and then raced awkwardly for several strides.

LILHOOVESGOTMOVES S McKay – Raced greenly in the home straight and shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres hampering JAHZARA forcing that runner inwards across heels and when being corrected shifted out and bumped with THE HOTTIE which was shifting ground inward.

JAHZARA L Allpress – Held up early in the home straight, then hampered near the 200 metres and forced inwards across heels and then bumped with THE HOTTIE.

THE HOTTIE S Collett – Bumped in the home straight.

J Fawcett JE SUIS D'OR – Was reminded of her obligations with regard to her whip use being slightly above shoulder height.

Race 3 | **MONSTAVISION MDN (1400 Metres)**

IMAGE OF YOU M McNab – Began awkwardly. Over raced in the back straight and was steadied for a short distance near the 1000 metres.

HERMES A Mudhoo – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADIES MAN H Schofer – Began awkwardly and was slow away. Dictated out on the home turn when EDDIE WOOD improved to its inside.

Race 4 | **DENNIS WHEELER EARTHMOVING NEW PLYMOUTH CUP OPN HCP(1800 Metres)**

ROLL THE GOLD J Fawcett – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LADY RUDOLPH S Collett – Had to be angled out near the 100 metres to improve.

OBSESSIVE A Goindasamy – Finished well back. Connections advised the gelding's future is to be re-assessed.

Race 5 | **NP PUNTING COMP FEB 6TH MAIDEN 3YO (1600 Metres)**

DAQIANSWEET JUNIOR L Allpress – Blundered at the start and lost its footing. Raced in restricted room over the final stages and had to be steadied near the finish when NUN HISSING shifted in and away from SWING THE TIDE.

NUN HISSING S MacNab – Steadied passing the 1000 metres when the pace ahead eased.

M McNab – When questioned into the run of ASTRADEEL M McNab was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to the stop start tempo of the race but was unable to offer any other explanation. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 6 | **WHITAKER CIVIL CONSTRUCTION 1600 RATING 65 (1600 Metres)**

BANGLES – Jumped inwards at the start dictating CAPE BLANCO inwards on to MR JIMMY POCKET which got back.

POROTENE CHARM L Hemi – Began awkwardly and lay in unbalancing the rider.

CATHAY NOVA M McNab – Ran wide at the junction into the back straight.

BARNEY RUBBLE S Collett – When questioned into the improved performance, connections advised the dead4 track conditions and the step up to 1600 metres were beneficial to the gelding.

POWERWORX TARANAKI CUP FEB 6TH RATING 65 (1200 Metres)

KELTIC ROCKSTAR S McKay – Slow away.

SHADY GREY A Mudhoo – Raced keenly throughout. Made the home turn awkwardly. Raced in restricted room rounding the turn and for the majority of the home straight.
