RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTH BEST – BEST TRAVEL MEMORIAL 2100 (2100 Metres)
FIRE DANCER (S Macnab) - Slow away.	
IMPERIAL PARTY (D Bradley) - Over-raced in the early stages, shifted outwards at 1700 metres dictating SANLORENZO outwards over extra ground then raced wide for the remainder.	

SANLORENZO (B Ansell) – Dictated outwards over extra ground passing the 1700 metres. Steadied off heels near the 600 metres when improving into a narrow run. B Ansell was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master and advised that she is expected show better judgement in future.

CAPRE DIEM (A Mudhoo) - Raced greenly in the home straight and had to be straightened.

STAR QUALITY (J Parkes) - Eased down over the final stages when the rider considered something may be amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled. Connections advised Stewards the future of STAR QUALITY will be reassessed.

Following the running of the event the track was upgraded to Dead 4.

Race 2	LF SELTZER 3YO 1200 (1200 Metres)

FOR PETE’S SAKE (B Ansell) - Slow away then commenced to over-race and had to be steadied off heels for some distance in the back straight and again near the 700 metres.

TRIBUTE KING (W Pinn) and **KUASA KUDA** (D Hirini) - Bumped going into the first bend, resulting in KUASA KUDA becoming unbalanced.

BOLD IRIS (L Hemi) - Shifted outwards to avoid the heels of KUASA KUDA passing the 800 metres.

MOTIVATION (J Parkes) - Slow away.

HUGO THE BOSS (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly and got back, then commenced to over-race making the first turn awkwardly.

PABLO ESK (F Lazet) - Had to steady for several strides when on heels rounding the home turn.

Race 4	+MORE HAWKES BAY MILE (1600 Metres)

CHASE (S Macnab) - Slow away.

HAUTAPU (D Hirini) - Slow away.

RENAULT (S O’Malley) - When questioned into his ride S O’Malley advised stewards the gelding had been disappointing in recent starts and his instructions were to lead. After going to the front from a wide barrier draw the gelding had hung outwards throughout and had little left at the finish.

KUSUDA (J Parkes) - Had to be steadied off heels near the 900 metres when over-racing and shifted out dictating WHO’S ALICE over extra ground.

WHO’S ALICE (F Lazet) – Forced over extra ground passing the 900 metres.

KALUANUI (W Pinn) - Hung inwards under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 250 metres.

Race 5	KAHUNGUNU KAPA (1600 Metres)

MERCY HILL (D Hirini) - Connections sought and were given permission to race without a back plate after the mare was unable to be re-plated prior to the start.

IVAN KANE (S Macnab) - Over-raced in front in the early stages, dropped out over the final stages. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled.

SHE'S A GODDESS (W Pinn) – Over-raced in front in the early stage.

NO ROCK NO POP (A Mudhoo) - Was inclined to hang out and race wide rounding the home turn and into the straight placing the rider at a disadvantage. Connections advised they would alter the gear on the filly which must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to it's next start.

OSAKA (J Parkes) - Inclined to lay in over the final stages.

E McCall (DAWN JESSIE) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$650.

AVA ADORO (A Mudhoo) – Slow away.

FALCO THREE (S Macnab) – Was taken back from the wide draw.

ASK PA (W Pinn) - Three wide without cover throughout, shifted in under pressure over the final stages.

SURPRIZE ME (L Hemi) - Momentarily hampered near the 100 metres.

RAPID FALLS (J Parkes) – Shifted in under pressure over the final stages.
