RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RICHARD SIMPSON CONTRACTING1200 (1200 Metres)
CELTIC WONDER (B Ansell) – Late scratched at 12.42pm after pulling a plate when parading and standing on the toe-clip.	

SEMPER MAGICO (J Riddell) – Crowded leaving the barrier between THE HOTTIE and SOLA POWER, both of which began awkwardly. Had to be steadied for some distance near the 1100 metres when on heels and then over-raced.

THE HOTTIE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly making contact, becoming unbalanced. Lost the off hind plate during the running.

SOLA POWER (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly making contact, becoming unbalanced. Tightened 1100 metres.

HYDRO EXPRESS (S Macnab) - Restrained from a wide barrier. Had to be straightened when shifting in near the 200 metres.

RAINBOW DUNDEE (D Hirini) - Tightened and clipped a heel shortly after the start.

D Bradley (MAROTIRI BELLE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not clear of RAINBOW DUNDEE (D Hirini), which clipped a heel and blundered. Also affected were THE HOTTIE and SOLA POWER, which were tightened. After hearing submissions D Bradley had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 16 January up to and including racing on Saturday, 30 January (6 days). In addition a fine of \$600 was imposed.

HAPPY TAV (R Elliot) - Had to be steadied going into the first turn when SOLA POWER lay in and away from RAINBOW DUNDEE.

Race 2	CHARLES SIMPSON JP MEMORIAL 1200 (1200 Metres)

LINCOLN FALLS (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly. Held up early in the final straight before shifting out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

SCOTCH (L Hemi) – Restrained near the 950 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels. Had to be steadied when attempting a narrow run to the inside of MIGHT (S Collett), which shifted in near the 200 metres. After viewing footage both riders were advised to exercise care.

BLONDLIGN (A Mudhoo) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

EUKA LADY (L Allpress) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance L Allpress was of the opinion the mare had not backed up from its fresh-up performance on 27/12/20.

Race 3	SPREADING RURAL BULK 1400 (1400 Metres)

ROMMEL (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Dropped out in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding had knocked the sensor tendon in the left forelimb.

SUMI (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly. Saddle slipped forward in the back straight placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

PASSIONE (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly then restrained. Briefly held up and had to shift out near the 350 metres to improve.

MEGLIO DI FALCREST (S Macnab) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages. S Macnab was reminded of her obligation to ride her mount out fully to line when able to do so. Stewards were satisfied that her finishing position was not compromised on this occasion.

SIGNORA NERA (S Collett) – Held up early in the home straight when in restricted room for some distance before

gaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

Race 4 | **PROPERTY BROKERS 1400 (1400 Metre)**

JUST FABULOUS (W Pinn) – Slow away. When questioned W Pinn advised the mare was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

WHAT A SMASHER (S Macnab) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced, losing ground.

HARTLEY (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover.

A Goindasamy (TIMES TICKING) – Spoken to regarding the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **SOUTHERN RANGITIKEI VETERINARY SERVICES 1400 (1400 Metres)**

LUCKY SHARK (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly then losing considerable ground. Improved briefly on to the heels of GALWAY BRO near the 200 metres prior to being angled out.

GAMEOUT (A Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

TAVATTACK (R Elliot) - A little slow to begin. When questioned, R Elliot advised the gelding had raced greenly throughout. Trainer A Sharrock advised blinkers would be re-applied to the horse's gear prior to its next start.

KING FAROUK (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly then steadied from its wide barrier. When questioned regarding the performance W Pinn could offer no excuse, other than the gelding had not travelled throughout.

OUTA CASH (S McKay) – Became awkwardly placed near heels passing the 1100 metres.

SWORD OF FIRE (L Allpress) – Briefly had to steady and change ground near the 300 metres when denied a run to the inside of OUTA CASH and a short distance further was crowded when DEDOJE improved to its inside.

Race 6 | **CENTRAL ITM 2100 (2100 Metres)**

BOTTI (S Macnab) - Slow to begin.

MISS SHER NAN (D Bradley) – Blundered leaving the barrier.

MERCY HILL (D Hirini) - Restrained from its wide barrier.

HASABRO (J Riddell) – When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

WHATSUP (A Goindasamy) - Steadied approaching the crossing near the 1700 metres.

CABOCHON (T Bau) – Reared as the start was made and got back. Steadied approaching the crossing near the 1700 metres. Lay in rounding the home corner and bumped with LA MIA SIRENA.

T Bau (CABOCHON) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

LA MIA SIRENA (R Elliot) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

NO COMPROMISE (L Allpress) - Held up throughout the home straight and went to the line without being tested.

L Hemi (FLYING MEG) – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior the 100 metres.

Race 7	JAPAC HOMES MARTON CUP (2200 Metres)

PLATINUM RAPPER (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

JACKSSTAR (T Allan) - Slow to begin.

VEE CECE (S Collett) - Crowded leaving the barrier.

THE GOOD FIGHT (D Johnson) - Crowded approaching the 2100 metres to the outside of FELAAR, which shifted out when avoiding the heels of BEAUDEN, which shifted in when marginally clear.

R Elliot (BEAUDEN) – Issued with a warning after shifting out when not fully clear of LE SABLIER near the 600 metres briefly unbalancing W Pinn).

T Allan (JACKSSTAR) – Issued with a warning regarding the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 8	MARSH INSURANCE BROKERS 1600 (1600 Metres)

WONONEOHWON (L Allpress) – Late scratching at 4.51pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in its barrier. Connections were advised that WONONEOHWON must trial prior to racing next.

NOT SANTA (J Parkes) – Removed from the barrier adjacent to ONEONEOHWON to undergo a veterinary examination and was cleared to run.

THAT'S INCRANIBULL (S Collett) – Slow to begin. When questioned S Collett was of the opinion the gelding was better suited to more rain affected going.

AWATANE (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly.

D Bradley (QUICK PREVIEW) – Issued with a warning after permitting QUICK PREVIEW to shift in passing the 1400 metres crowding LANGKAWI, which had commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained.

LANGKAWI (S McKay) – Crowded 1400 metres.

COOGA MOON (F Lazet) – Shifted out near the 300 metres making contact with LANGKAWI. F Lazet was advised to exercise greater care.

MIKJENE (S Macnab) – Tightened in home straight when placed in restricted room between LANGKAWI (S McKay), which shifted out, and AWATANE. S McKay was advised to exercise greater care.
