<b>Race 1</b>	<b>RACING.CO.NZ TRIBUTE TO GLENN WATSON MAIDEN 1200 METRES (1200 metres)</b>
<b>OWEN MOORE</b> (H Schofer) – Slow away.	
<b>FIZZY MOON</b> (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly shifting out dictating MELODY ROXX outwards into the line of MARKSMAN which got back. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.	
<b>JUST BEN</b> (S McKay) - Improved up onto heels near the 600 metres and had to be steadied	

**LILHOOVESGOTMOVES** (R Elliot) - Held up near the 400 metres and had to be steadied, then angled outwards into clear running near the 150 metres.

**VIN ROUGE** (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Finished last. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

**RIP VAN GOGH** (D Johnson) – When questioned, rider could offer no excuse.

**PIRIWAI** (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly and was very slow into stride (4L). A warning has been placed on the mare's barrier manners.

**GAMESTER** (S Weatherley) - Raced greenly throughout.

**FABIOLA** (C Dell) - Awkward at the crossing in the back straight. Hung outwards rounding the home turn dictating MINI MAXINE and LUCKY VIKING outward.

**MINI MAXINE** (T Taiaroa) – Dictated home turn.

**LUCKY VIKING** (J Parkes) – Dictated home turn.

**J Riddell** (LINCOLN HANOVER) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to cross in the back straight when not fully clear of INFRARED, which had to be steadied.

**INFRARED** (F Lazet) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages then had to be steadied for some distance near the 800 metres, going back on to HERE COMES TROUBLE which was steadied.

**HERE COMES TROUBLE** (K Hercock) - Steadied 800 metres. Had to be angled wide near the 200 metres to improve.

**OCEANIC** (S Collett) – Disappointed; co trainer advised that a gear change would be considered prior to its next start.

The goggles on F Lazet (INFRARED) became detached near the 100 metres.

**CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY** – J Riddell was unable to make the weight for CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule and was replaced by J Parkes.

**KUASA KUDA** (D Hirini) - Shifted out abruptly on jumping away.

**MEG** (L Allpress) – Bumped with MUSE at the start and got back. L Allpress reported the filly may be better suited to a longer distance.

**MUSE** (C Grylls) – Bumped start.

**SONGSUNGBLU** (S Weatherley) - Bounded at the start and slow away.

**LEGALLY BLONDE** (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the back straight and had to be steadied going into the first turn when in restricted room.

**ONCE BITTEN** (S Macnab) - Hung inwards under pressure hampering VALHALLA RISING near the 100 metres prior to being straightened. S Macnab was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**VALHALLA RISING** (L Hemi) - Hampered near 100 metres.

**Race 4** | **MANELY HORSE MAIDEN 1600 METRES (1340 metres)**

**ANGELINA JAY** (M Hudson) – Late scratching at 12.25pm on veterinary advice.

**CISJURANE** (B Ansell) – Slow away.

**VELARDE** (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

**SHOCKING BILL** (J Riddell) – Made the first bend awkwardly when racing greenly, hampering **KALUANUI** and **FAMILY TIME**. Shied at the crossing in the back straight, unbalancing the rider.

**KALUANUI** (L Allpress) – Hampered near 1400 metres.

**FAMILY TIME** (R Elliot) – Hampered near 1400 metres.

**Race 5** | **VISIT YOUR HORSE AT RACEIMAGES.CO.NZ MAIDEN 1600 METRES (1600 metres)**

**DOTHRAKI** (S O'Malley) – Slow away. Raced wide in the early and middle stages when racing greenly.

**LADY CALYPSO** (S Macnab) – Slow away.

**INNOCENT** (C Dell) -Went off stride at the crossing in the back straight.

**ABSCONDED** (T Yangida) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**PLATINUM IMPACT** (A Goindasamy) – Went off stride and changed legs leaving the back straight, unbalancing the rider when racing greenly.

**THE ACTRESS** (C Grylls) – Hampered when attempting a narrow run to the inside of **DOTHRAKI** (S O'Malley) which shifted in near the 200 metres when not fully clear. After questioning riders, S O'Malley was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d). **THE ACTRESS** raced in restricted room for the remainder.

**SOUTHROAD** (H Schofer) - Held up in the home straight prior to being angled outwards near the 100 metres and then was tightened when **DOTHRAKI** hung outwards into its line simultaneously as **ZUMA ROCK** shifted in.

**Race 6** | **SPOONERS DRY CLEANERS 1600 METRES (1600 metres)**

**TAVIRA** (R Elliot) - Steadied going into the first corner

**ENRICHMENT** (D Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**POWER 'N' PASSION** (D Bradley) - Held up and unable to improve for some distance until passing the 200 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

**Race 7** | **G BRISTOL & SONS 1340 METRES (1340 metres)**

**REGAL ROCK** (S Macnab) – Slow away.

**DESTINY ONE** (A Mudhoo) – Raced three wide.

**NO ROCK NO POP** (K Hercock) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 100 metres.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>MEMORIAL TO TREVOR FIELD MAIDEN 2040 METRES (2040 metres)</b>
<p><b>LOMO DE PLATA</b> (M Hudson) Shifted out on jumping away crowding GOVERNOR GREY and LINCOLN LANE resulting in both those runners getting back.</p> <p><b>GOVERNOR GREY</b> (S O'Malley) – Crowded start, getting back.</p> <p><b>LINCOLN LANE</b> (J Riddell) – Crowded start, getting back. Taken forward when racing keenly when three wide in the back straight.</p> <p><b>PLATINUM RAIN</b> (S Weatherley) – Awkwardly on heels near the winning post on the first occasion, shifting out forcing RED GUM over extra ground</p> <p><b>TAKE THAT</b> (L Allpress) and <b>LINCOLN LANE</b> (J Riddell) came together and bumped approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>GOING STEADY</b> (S Collett) - Steadied off the heels of DETONATE near the finish.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>KOOL'S CHICKEN WHANGANUI MAIDEN 2040 METRES (2040 metres)</b>
<p><b>WICKLOW</b> (H Schofer) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>ZEROED</b> (D Bradley) - Had to be steadied on entering the back straight. Shifted in shortly after straightening, briefly hampering WHITE SOX.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>WHANGANUI CHRONICLE 2040 METRES (2040 metres)</b>
<p><b>I AM A CRAFTSMAN</b> (J Parkes) – Slow away. Tailed the field throughout. J Parkes advised stewards the gelding felt flat all the way and was not persevered with in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>VENETO</b> (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>THOMAS AQUINAS</b> (S McKay) – Had difficulty obtaining a run early in the home straight and bumped with MASTER GERONIMO.</p> <p><b>W Pinn</b> (CAGE PHYTA) – Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>MISTER GERONIMO</b> (S Weatherley) – When in restricted room S Weatherley said his mount over-reacted when touching the rail near the 1300 metres.</p>
