RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 RAY WHITE PAPAMOA 2YO (1200 m)

GYPSY PRINCESS (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

MR BLUE SKY (M McNab) – Began awkwardly and was then ridden urgently to recover. Raced wide in the early stages.

DRUM MAJOR (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover.

MILLEFIORI (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running having to shift out passing the 150 metres.

Race 2 RAY WHITE COMMERCIAL HANDICAP (1200 m)

ROSE BOWL (S Collett) – Restrained off heels soon after leaving the barrier after beginning awkwardly. Held up early in the final straight until passing the 150 metres. Shifted in when becoming awkwardly placed on heels making contact with BACKINTYME passing the 100 metres.

TEARS OF JUPITER (A Goindasamy) – Restrained 1100 metres when awkwardly placed near heels losing ground. Then over-raced for a distance. Hampered when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BACKINTYME near the 400 metres which was taken out by SHOWBOAT with D Danis being reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Shifted out under pressure near the 300 metres inconveniencing CALL ME EVIE.

ACUTUS (J Kamaruddin) – Had to be steadied off heels passing the 600 metres. Held up early in the final straight shifting out passing the 200 metres.

SHOWBOAT (D Danis) – Shifted out under pressure near the 400 metres.

BACKINTYME (M Hashizume) – Dictated out near the 400 metres. Was found to be mildly lame post-race and received veterinary attention.

M Hashizume (BACKINTYME) – Issued with a warning for shifting in near the 1100 metres when not fully clear of TEARS OF JUPITER.

Race 3 RAY WHITE BAYFAIR AND TE PUKE HANDICAP (1400 m)

ALL PAID UP (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LOVETTORLEAVEIT (V Colgan) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier.

AILEEN GRACE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly then crowded soon after leaving the barrier. Held up for a distance from near the 300 metres until inside the final 150 metres.

FORCE OF WILL (K Asano) – Restrained from its wide barrier.

SPEECHMAKER (M Hashizume) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier to the inside of LOVETTORLEAVEIT which was crowded by MOUTON which lay in despite the efforts of its rider.

MOUTON (T Harris) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight until shifting out near the 250 metres.

O'HE CAN (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight.

OUR WONDERLAND (R Elliot) – Was not persevered with over the final 150 metres after commencing to give ground. When questioned regarding the performance Rider R Elliot was unable to offer any excuse for the gelding's performance.

Race 4 RAY WHITE CHERRYWOOD HANDICAP (1400 m)

MISTRESS MINX (S Collett) – Slow to begin after being restless in its barrier.

LORD PAINTON (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

PRINCE KANTO (T Yanagida) – Restrained passing the 1100 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of ONE MORE TIME. V Colgan was issued with a warning after allowing ONE MORE TIME to shift in nearing the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear.

ONE MORE TIME (V Colgan) – Shifted in 1100 metres.

MEMORIES ONLY (S Weatherley) – Raced wide without cover. Commenced to lay in near the 350 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

GIANT GEM (T Harris) – Shifted out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

DAWN PARADE (L Innes) – Commenced to give ground passing the 200 metres and was not persevered with over the final 100 metres with Rider L Innes unable to offer any reason for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 RAY WHITE WHAKATANE AND OHOPE HANDICAP (1200 m)

EARL OF ORKNEY (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

SIDE BY SIDE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly then restrained away from heels. Shifted in when looking to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres then improved onto heels over the final 100 metres when held up.

JIMMY FIVE (L Innes) – Restrained soon after leaving the barrier then further restrained in the early stages to obtain cover and raced keenly.

AMAL ROSE (V Colgan) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

GLITTERING ARMOUR (S Collett) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 250 metres. Lost left front plate during the running.

SAINTLY WAY (S Weatherley) – Briefly crowded passing the 100 metres by SIDE BY SIDE which was looking to obtain clear running.

Race 6 RAY WHITE GREERTON HANDICAP (1600 m)

WATCH THIS SPACE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

WEAPONRY (J Kamaruddin) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Improved wide from the 700 metres and commenced to give ground passing the 250 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider J Kamaruddin was unable to offer any reason for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

NASHA RIVA (M Hashizume) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 500 metres dictating ROYAL PERFORMER wider.

LINCOLN KING (D Johnson) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WATCH THIS SPACE which shifted out under pressure near the 50 metres.

ROYAL PERFORMER (W Pinn) – Dictated wider 500 metres.

DAYTONA RED (A Calder) – Awkwardly placed near heels 150 metres.

Race 7 RAY WHITE TAURANGA HANDICAP (2100 m)

CALPURNIA (T Thornton) – Reared as the start was effected losing considerable ground with a barrier warning being placed against the mare. Was ridden forward from the 1400 metres to lead approaching the 1000 metres.

AMANO (C Grylls) – Knuckled leaving the barriers. Lost left front plate during the running.

DAWON (T Yanagida) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

HAKUNA MATATA (J Kamaruddin) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Restrained 1700 metres after improving inside the heels of MEANT TO BE.

PATSYS LASS (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MIGHTY CONNOR (S Weatherley) – Commenced to give ground passing the 200 metres and was not persevered with over the concluding stages. Rider S Weatherley advised the gelding was disappointing and may prefer some easing of the track.

Race 8 RAY WHITE MOUNT MAUNGANUI HANDICAP (1600 m)

RUSAVY (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for a majority of the race. When questioned Rider S Collett advised the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing with a post-race veterinary examination revealing no obvious abnormalities.

CELEBRE (C Grylls) – Crowded leaving the barrier. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.

LA VELOCITA (S Weatherley) – Crowded and steadied leaving the barrier. Held up early in the final straight until near the 250 metres.

GREEN BRAVO (V Colgan) – Held up until shifting out passing the 150 meres to obtain clear running.

RAGGEDY DOLL (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly then crowded and steadied.

SUPER SID (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly making contact and then was steadied.

VOLITIVO (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly making contact and then was steadied. Raced ungenerously when making the bend passing the 1000 metres. Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 600 metres and again passing the 400 metres. Held up entering the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

TRIGON LAD (A Calder) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up until shifting out near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.
