Waikouaiti RC at Wingatui 16th January 2021 – Race 8 Dunedin Casino Waikouaiti Cup 2200 Metres

Stewards concluded an enquiry in to the ride and performance of **ROSIE GLOW** in this event. After speaking with both the rider and co-trainer Stewards have placed a racing manners warning on the mare after it hung for the majority of the race. Co-trainer K Tyler was of the opinion the mare was feeling the firm nature of the track but the mare had returned to the home stable in good condition and he was happy with her work this week. He further added ROSIE GLOW would carry on in her current campaign but would be looking for tracks with more moisture in them.

Trainer S Blair-Edie (NESTA) advised that his apprentice **A Bohorun** who was dislodged after the winning post underwent a further medical examination and was found to have two small fractures to vertebrae in his neck and he would now be away from all riding for the next three months or possibly longer. A Bohorun was advised he would require a medical clearance prior to riding next.

| Race 1 | ABERNETHY CONTRACTING (1335m) |

VAGUE (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

IRISH ENVY (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin losing ground. Lay inwards throughout the run home and shifted ground inwards

under pressure over the final 100 metres.

CAPO DELL IMPERO (J Lowry) – Crowded shortly after the start then commenced to buck, unbalancing and almost dislodging its rider, losing considerable ground as a result. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

BENNY LINCOLN (D Bothamley) – Raced wide in the early stages. Hampered near the 1100 metres. When asked to comment on the disappointing performance of the favoured runner rider could offer no tangible explanation.

IRISH HEART (A Balloo) – Shifted out abruptly when negotiating the crossing near the 1100 metres forcing CRYSTAL BELLINI outwards into the line of BENNY LINCOLN which had to be steadied.

DRUMISLE (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

PORT STEPHENS (T Moseley) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

Following the running of this race the official track conditions were downgraded to Slow 8.

Race 2 PETER GENETICS (1335m)

UBER ROCA (B Murray) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start and began awkwardly shifting out abruptly. Raced wide throughout.

SABOTEUR (A Balloo) – Slow to begin.

NEVETS (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

OCEAN'S SEVEN (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

OUR CLARRY (R Beeharry) – Briefly blundered at the start.

LET ME TELL YA (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly making firm contact with outside runner shortly after the start.

ARROYO (C Campbell) – Made firm contact with inside runner shortly after the start.

REGAL GIRL (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TAVY ROAD (T Comignaghi) – Shifted ground inwards under pressure in the middle stages of the run home.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1335m)

YAMUNA (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (S Wynne) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. When asked to comment on the disappointing performance of the race favourite rider could offer no tangible explanation.

EXPRESSIVE (B Murray) – Restrained on jumping from its wide barrier.

RITANI (T Moseley) – Restrained on jumping from its wide barrier. When asked to comment on the disappointing performance of the favoured runner rider could offer no tangible explanation.

KITTY POWER (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover in the early to middle stages.

SHIRLEY MAUDE (D Bothamley) – Hung outwards rounding the bend.

Race 4 ROBIN ARCHER MEMORIAL (1200m)

KATE THE GREAT (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin.

HE'S MI BROTHER (L Callaway) - Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Briefly held up rounding

the final bend. Placed in restricted room and had to steady near the 125 metres when MOTHER GOOSE which had improved to the outside of the tiring BLAIR FLIGHT (K Kwo) was dictated outwards onto HE'S MI BROTHER which in turn was forced on to the heels of NEVER QUITZ. Rider K Kwo was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

GLORY CHANCE (R Mudhoo) – Got its head up when over-racing in the early stages.

BLAIR FLIGHT (K Kwo) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages, under pressure in the home straight finishing well back with the rider advising the gelding had not been comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MINT JULEP (K Asano) – Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Race 5 AON INSURANCE HANDICAP (2000m)

SHANZINO (T Moseley) – Bounded at the start losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

TUILANA (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Over-raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo. Rider advised the mare was not suited by the muddling tempo of today's race.

HE'S GOT POWER (R Mudhoo) – Got its head up when over-racing in the early stages.

NESTA (D Bothamley) – Over-raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

CANNOLI (K Chowdhoory) – Over-raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo. Improved wide from the 800 metres.

Race 6 DB/MLT GORE CUP (1800m)

WILD JACK (L Callaway) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after kicking out at the barrier gate and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 2.13pm when found to be lame in the near hind leg. Connections were advised a Veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

NOPELE (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early stages due to the lack of tempo.

ROSIE GLOW (R Mudhoo) – Weakened rounding the final bend with the rider reporting the mare had dropped the bit and failed to respond to his urgings. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed ROSIE GLOW had suffered a cardiac arrhythmia with connections advised a Veterinary clearance would be required prior to the mare racing next. Connections advised ROSIE GLOW will now be sent for a spell.

FLYING SARDINE (M Gestain) – When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner rider advised the mare had not been suited by the slow early tempo and sprint home nature of today's race.

Race 7 REGIONAL FORD (1335m)

MILANO (S Wynne) – Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping crowding SHE'S GOT THE LOOK which lost ground. Lay outwards early in the run home.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

BENAUD (W Papier) – Raced wide throughout.

LEIGHTON WARRIOR (L Callaway) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NOAH (R Beeharry) – Lay outwards under pressure in the home straight.

FILL YA BOOTS (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the performance of the race favourite the rider advised the gelding was under pressure on the home turn, had failed to respond to his urgings and was disappointing.

Race 8 LIQUORLAND GORE GUINEAS (1335m)

GALILEO EXPRESS (G Jogoo) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Reported by its rider to have raced greenly throughout.

PETTY'S LEGACY (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

GRAND GESTURE (J Lowry) – Obliged to improve very wide round the final bend. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding had travelled up well however failed to let down.

CHOKITO (S Wynne) – Crowded and checked near the 50 metres.

SHOWEMHOWITSDONE (T Moseley) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages and passing the 50 metres shied and shifted out abruptly despite efforts of the rider crowding CHOKITO and OCEAN POINT with both these runners having to be steadied. The connections were advised the filly was on a warning for its racing manners.

OCEAN POINT (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked near the 50 metres. Following the running of the event the Connections viewed the footage of the final stages before electing not to proceed with a Protest.

BATTLINAWAY (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

SCANDALOUS (K Asano) – Crowded and lost some ground shortly after the start.

SOUNDS PROMISING (S Wynne) – Shifted inwards abruptly on jumping crowding SCANDALOUS. Raced wide in the early stages when improving to sit outside the leader near the 900 metres. Rider reported that after being trapped wide and having to improve forward the effort had told on the gelding over the concluding stages.

RUBY MARIE (G Jogoo) – Improved wide from the 900 metres. Shifted up the track under pressure throughout the run home.

RUAKIWI BLAZE (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MASTER LINCOLN (B Murray) – Made contact with the running rail near the 400 metres with the gelding going off stride and the rider becoming unbalanced for a short distance.

Race 10 GRANT FARMING PARTNERSHIP (2000m)

AULYN STAR (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing several lengths.

SUPERSTITION (K Kwo) – Raced wide in the early stages.

COLOUR ME RED (L Callaway) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

RED MAJOR (T Moseley) – Over-raced and got its head up on a number of occasions for a distance passing the 1300 metres when the race tempo eased, having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that although the gelding had over-raced in the middle stages it had been disappointing.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (C Barnes) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

TRICKLE TREAT (C Campbell) – Following the running of this race the gelding knuckled when making the crossing and was immediately pulled up by its rider C Campbell. A subsequent Veterinary examination revealed TRICKLE TREAT to have suffered injuries to the off rear suspensory ligament and sesamoid for which it is receiving treatment. Rider C Campbell was subsequently excused from weighing in post-race pursuant to Rule 647(1)(a). The connections were advised the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

C Campbell was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Stipendiary Stewards report as posted is provisional and subject to further review and amendment
