RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 LITTLE AVONDALE LOWLAND STAKES 3 MARCH 2100 (2100 Metres)

ATLANTIC FLYER (S Macnab) - Commenced to over-race in the home straight on the first occasion and had to be continuously steadied for some distance.

WHO'S ALICE (K Hercock) - Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted out.

PLATINUM RAIN (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Went off stride abruptly near the 1000 metres with rider S Weatherley not persevering with the gelding after he considered something amiss. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear. Stewards advised connections that the gelding must trial. The track was inspected by staff and found not to be a factor.

ESTABLISHMENT (S O'Malley) - Had to take evasive action to avoid PLATINUM RAIN near the 1000 metres. Obliged to race wide for the remainder.

CAPITAL GAINS (W Pinn) – Held up in the early part of the home straight and again when improving on to heels inside the final 50 metres.

ASTRADEEL (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had never travelled well throughout and had only run on fairly when placed under pressure, further advising the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

CASTLE BLACK (R Elliot) - Rider R Elliot reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed mild lameness in the right foreleg.

Track upgraded to Good 3 following Race 1.

Race 2 POWER FARMING HAWKE'S BAY CUP 17 APRIL 2100 (2100 Metres

FOR PEPE'S SAKE (M Hudson) - Raced keenly early after reaching the lead on the first round.

PIERRO ROSSO (J Riddell) - Shifted out when being steadied near the winning post on the first occasion hampering JACKAROO.

JACKAROO (S O'Malley) – Hampered final stages.

CAPELLANI (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover.

RIP US OFF (H Schofer) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 3 WAIROA RC @ HASTINGS 1200 (1200 Metres)

INDEEM (R Elliot) – Slow away.

WEOWNA TIGER (J Fawcett) - Raced fiercely in the back straight and when being steadied shifted out and hampered MARCHIONESS.

MARCHIONESS (M McNab) – Hampered back straight. Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

SUNLIT LANE (L Allpress) - Made the first bend awkwardly when racing greenly and bumped with THINKSO near the 400 metres.

THINKSO (D Johnson) – Bumped near 400 metres.

MYLA (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HANGING LOOSE (S MacNab) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 POVERTY BAY CUP 17 APRIL 1400 (1400 Metres)

EXALTATION (D Johnson) - Shifted out abruptly at the start dictating HONNEUR NOIR (E McCall), PODKAST (S Macnab), PABLO ESK (M McNab) and SAIGNON (R Beemud) wider on the track with R Beemud becoming unbalanced.

HONNEUR NOIR (E McCall) – Dictated start. Lost both front plates during the running.

PODKAST (S Macnab) – Dictated start. Hampered near the finish when shifting out across the heels of KING FAROUK.

PABLO ESK (M McNab) – Dictated start. Eased down in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a respiratory discharge as well as coughing, which required treatment.

SAIGNON (R Beemud) – Dictated start with rider becoming unbalanced.

Race 5 BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND MAIDEN (1400 Metres)

PARENUI – S Collett replaced S McKay (transport difficulties). Raced greenly throughout.

SIETE (R Beemud) - Shifted in abruptly at the start bumping with FLAUTINO and KUASA KUDA which became unbalanced.

FLAUTINO (A Mudhoo) - Bumped start. Bumped 400 metres.

KUASA KUDA (D Hirini) - Bumped start becoming unbalanced. Made the 400 metre bend awkwardly and shifted out simultaneously as PARISIAN POPPY was improving to its outside, resulting in PARISIAN POPPY and FLAUTINO coming together and bumping.

PARIS RUBY (T Newman) - Slow away. Bumped 400 metres.

DO THE MATHS (T Thornton) - Raced keenly in the back straight and had to be steadied near the 800 metres when FALCO THREE (S Macnab) shifted in. S Macnab FALCO THREE was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master, and issued with a warning.

MILK POWER (J Parkes) - Angled outwards abruptly when improving on to heels near the 500 metres. Inclined to shift inwards over the final stages.

FALCO THREE (S Macnab) – Inclined to lug inwards in the home straight.

JAHZARA (D Johnson) – Received veterinary attention following the race after being galloped on. Connections were advised the filly requires a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

Race 6 LF SELTZER MAIDEN (1400 Metres)

MISS WRIGLEY – D Hirini replaced S McKay. Got back from its wide draw.

MOHEGAN STAR (L Hemi) - Tightened at the start and slow away.

OHITI LASS (K Hercock) - Slow away and got back. Steadied 800 metres.

NEWSTALK (S Macnab) - Had to be steadied near the 800 metres when over-racing.

HIBERNIA SEA (T Newman) - Improved up on to heels passing the 800 metres and had to be steadied and went back on to OHITI LASS, which was steadied.

GOLDCHI (S Malley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 +MORE HAWKE'S BAY 3YO (1400 Metres)

TAR AND CEMENT (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

ROMMEL (J Riddell) - Slow away. Commenced to hang out in the early stages running wide when making the final bend and was not persevered with in the home straight. J Riddell confirmed the gelding had hung throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed ulcers on the inside of the mouth. Connections were advised to monitor the gelding over coming days.

CAPITAL EXPENSE (L Allpress) - Contacted leaving the barrier.

VELOCE SORELLA (J Fawcett) - Contacted leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.

SONG FOR ANNA (S Collett) and GOLDEN HUE (B May) came together and bumped near the 200 metres.

Race 8CHRIS "GRUGLY" KING MEMORIAL (1400 Metres)NO ROCK NO POP (K Hercock) – Inclined to hang outwards rounding the turn.

SWEET HUNTER (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly and then bumped, becoming unbalanced. When questioned into the disappointing run of SWEET HUNTER, which finished some distance last, S Weatherley advised the filly, which usually leads got back at the start after being fractious in its gate which had been detrimental to its chances. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

LANDRY (S Collett) - Shifted out at the start crowding the following runners -RAINBOW DUNDEE, SHEBRINGSMERUBIES, NO ROCK NO POP and SWEET HUNTER.

THE VILLAIN (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout.
