Race 7, +More Hawke's Bay 3YO

ROMMEL – Trainer J Bary reported the gelding has now been retired from his stable after sustaining a suspensory ligament injury to the left foreleg.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER (1400 Metres)
FOOGAYZEE – D Johnson replaced O Bosson (overweight).	
SHARE POWER (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly. Steadied off heels near the 1000 metres. When questioned into the run of SHARE POWER, J Parkes advised the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises. Trainer M Breslin advised that he would have the gelding undergo an endoscopic examination on return to his stable and report any finding to the Stewards.	
PLATINUM PETALS (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay out under pressure over the final stages.	
GURTLYN (C Johnson) – Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of HERE COMES TROUBLE near the 900 metres.	
THE HOTTIE (S Collett) – Held up early in the straight until near the 200 metres.	
LINCOLN HANOVER (M McNab) - Held up early in the straight.	
BELT ROAD (K Assano) - Lay in under pressure passing the 100 metres.	
Race 2	CONCEPT SECURITY PREMIER (1200 Metres)
KLAASEN (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide throughout.	
REAL SLIM TRADIE (K Hercock) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.	
DANSEUSE (T Allan) - Commenced to buck shortly after the start and was retired from the race. Trainer T Allan was advised that the filly must trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.	
NO FILTER (A Calder) – Held up until passing the 300 metres.	
DE LA TERRE (R Elliot) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres.	
HOLD THE PRESS (D Johnson) - Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had changed stride and felt indifferent in its action late in the race. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
Race 3	STAPHANOS BY THE GREAT DEEP IMPACT PREMIER (1200 Metres)
ON SHOW (C Grylls) – Blundered leaving the barriers.	

PARAWANUI LAD (W Pinn) - Slow to begin.

KICK START (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

CEDDY SMITH (M McNab) – Hampered when contacted near the 500 metres when GOT THE CALL was taken out by ROC CHA crossing the junction onto the course proper.

LINCOLN'S KRUIZ (J Riddell) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Held up early in the straight and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

POWERBALL (C Johnson) – Commenced to over-race for a distance near the 1000 metres.

Race 4 | **JOIN TEAM TE AKAU – SIX x KARAKA MILLION WINNER (1000 Metres)**

CAVALLO VELOCE (J Kamaruddin) - Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary examination after coming into contact with its barrier.

MR UNIVERSE (H Schofer) – Restrained in the early stages from its wide barrier. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

EXCELLERATION (F Lazet) – Made contact with GRAND MAYSON when attempting to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

POKURU'S GIFT (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

RACED EVENS (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare is better suited to more rain-affected footing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 | **PLATINUM HOMES TARANAKI PREMIER (2100 Metres)**

GERDA (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres then being checked near the 300 metres when KING OF THE DANCE lay in simultaneously as POSH POROTENE was taken out by HOROPITO, which was laying out.

POSH POROTENE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

KING OF THE DANCE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

RUKITA (K Asano) - Commenced to over-race passing the 1600 metres having to shift outwards to avoid heels.

ZAC BROWN (S Macnab) - Shifted outwards to avoid heels when the pace steadied passing the 1600 metres and was then allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1200 metres.

Race 6 | **NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK DESERT GOLD STAKES (Group 3) (1600 Metres)**

SWEET ANNA – S Collett replaced O Bosson (overweight). Contacted and shifted outwards across the heels of FORCE OF WILL passing the 200 metres.

KEY (D Johnson) - Slow to begin. Disappointed for a run near the 300 metres having to be steadied when crowded between PASSIONE (L Innes) which shifted outwards, and DA VINCI GIRL, which lay in.

L Innes (PASSIONE) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift outwards near the 300 metres crowding KEY.

PASSIONE (L Innes) – Dictated outwards by **VICTOREM** (L Allpress) which shifted outwards under pressure passing the 200 metres, with **PASSIONE** making contact with **SWEET ANNA** becoming unbalanced. L Allpress was advised to exercise greater care.

SAMINA BIBI (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

CHARMS STAR (S Weatherley) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from a wide barrier.

KALUANUI (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 7	HARCOURTS THORNDON MILE (Group I) (1600 Metres)

SINARAHMA (D Johnson) – Very slow to begin (5L). Trainer A Sharrock was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare. Mr Sharrock advised that **SINARAHMA** was showing signs of being in season post-race.

THE MITIGATOR (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.

ROCK ON WOOD (R Elliot) – Was retired from the race after going amiss when racing free of interference passing the 1000 metres. **ROCK ON WOOD** was immediately attended to by the on-course veterinarian with horse ambulance being deployed. The gelding was found to have suffered a fracture to the left hind fetlock and pastern being humanely euthanised.

M McNab (DEERFIELD) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

O Bosson (MELODY BELLE) – Issued with a warning after weighing-in in excess of his weighed-out weight.

ROSE OF DELGATIE (L Allpress) - Slow away.

POINT BREAK (S Macnab) - Jumped away awkwardly crowding **CATE BLANCO**.

RIPPER OF A DREAM (O Bosson) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.

ORLOV (R Elliot) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact, hampering **SON OF BIELSKI**.

SON OF BIELSKI (M McNab) – Hampered start.

CATE BLANCO (S Collett) – Crowded leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

A member of the public entered the race track during the running of this event just inside the final 100 metres, with a number of riders reacting to varying degrees. Following the race a request for a ruling was lodged by the Stipendiary Stewards with the Judicial Committee as to whether the chances of **BOSTON STRONG BOY** (J Parkes) had been affected with the Judicial Committee ruling that **BOSTON STRONG BOY** be declared a non-starter and all bets on that runner to be refunded. A male Caucasian was arrested by Wellington Police being charged with Criminal Nuisance, Section 145 Crimes Act 1961, in doing an act endangering public safety and is due to appear in the Lower Hutt District Court on Monday 1 February.

BOSTON STRONG BOY (J Parkes) – Declared a non-starter following a ruling that its chances of finishing in a better placing by a member of the public entering the race track.

HA'PENNY BRIDGE (K Asano) – Trainer A Meadows was advised that an endoscopic examination was required with results to be provided to the Stipendiary Stewards following a report that the gelding had been observed to have blood present in the nasal area post-race. It was subsequently confirmed that HA'PENNY BRIDGE had bled now being subject to the mandatory stand down periods. Mr Meadows indicated that the gelding would now be retired.

Race 9 | **NZ CAMPUS OF INNOVATION & SPORT WELLINGTON CUP (Group 3) (3200 Metres)**

VEE CECE (W Pinn) - Slow to begin. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight with the rider being unable to ride the mare out fully over the concluding stages. Rider reported that the mare had hung throughout.

MASETTO (S McKay) – Steadied to avoid heels passing the 3000 metres then commencing to over-race for a distance. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 500 metres when WAISAKE shifted outwards to avoid the heels of the weakening AWESOME AL.

TE AKAU CALIBURN (M McNab) – Held up rounding the final turn until passing the 400 metres.

J Fawcett (SUPER HOOF) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of MASETTO which had to be steadied passing the 3000 metres.

DR VELOLCIOUS (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SUPER HOOF (J Fawcett) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

A Calder (JUSTAMAIZ) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

L Allpress (SERGEANT BLAST) – Was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Monday 8 February up to and including racing on Friday 19 February (6 national riding days) after admitting a charge in that she used the whip excessively on her mount prior to the 100 metres.

Race 10 | **TURKINGTON FORESTRY DOURO CUP (1600 Metres)**

SUNBURST (D Danis) - Slow away.

HE NO OPILIO (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly.

C Grylls (RANGITATA) – Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

W Pinn (FATHER LENIHAN) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

WHALE SONG (H Schofer) - Rider reported the gelding was not suited by today's track conditions.
