<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ASH DAIRIES/MURRAY FREE CONTRACTING LTD 3YO (1400 Metres)</b>
<b>PARISIAN POPPY</b> – Late scratching @ 12.50pm on veterinary advice after sustaining an injury en route to the course.	
<b>WHITE LIGHTNING</b> (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly approaching the 800 metres when placed on heels and shifted out when being steadied forcing REAL SLIM TRADIE wide momentarily.	

<p><b>REAL SLIM TRADIE</b> (K Hercock) – Forced wide near 800 metres. Made the final bend awkwardly and had to be continuously straightened in the home straight when inclined to lay outwards.</p> <p><b>T Allan</b> (DANSEUSE) – Issued with a warning for his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>POWER FARMING MANAWATU 1200 (1200 Metres)</b>
<p><b>HE'S DONE A RUNNER</b> (J Parkes) – Fractious in its barrier prior to the start and began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DAUPHINE</b> (M Hudson) - Restrained on jumping to take cover from its wide barrier. Held up in the early stages of the run home having to shift ground outwards near the 150 metres to gain clear running.</p> <p><b>ABBAY ROAD</b> (S O'Malley) - Restrained on jumping to take cover from its wide barrier. Had to be steadied near the 100 metres when placed in restricted room.</p> <p><b>MANDALORIAN</b> (D Johnson) – Raced wide early stages.</p> <p><b>IFNDOUBTGETOUT</b> (K Asano) - Inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PROPERTY BROKERS 1400 (1400 Metres)</b>
<p><b>DAWN COUNTY</b> (S Macnab) – Slow away. Held up early stages of the home straight.</p> <p><b>S Collett</b> (FLICKERING SHADOW) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear of SOVEREIGN EXPRESS which was dictated inwards on to HERE COMES TROUBLE, which had to be steadied and JUSTASKPERCY, which also had to steady. Stewards took into account outward movement from SUNLIT LANE when assessing the interference.</p> <p><b>HERE COMES TROUBLE</b> (T Taiaroa) - Steadied after start. Raced wide early stages.</p> <p><b>S O'Malley</b> (SUPER SIMON) – Advised to exercise care after allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of ARKLOW, which had to be steadied near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>BRADMAN</b> (D Johnson) -Had to be steadied when improving onto the heels of FIVE FORTUNE passing the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>FLORENCE O'REILLY</b> (M Singh) – Over-raced in the middle stages and then held up for a short distance approaching the home turn.</p> <p><b>WOTARIPPER</b> (L Hemi) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight.</p> <p><b>SUPER SIMON</b> (S O'Malley) - Lay inwards and had to be straightened by its rider near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>JUSTASKPERCY</b> (D Bradley) – Steadied after start. Had to be angled wide in the home straight to improve.</p> <p><b>SUNLIT LANE</b> (H Schofer) – Blundered at the start. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance H Schofer advised Stewards that despite being a little fractious in the barrier she could not offer any tangible excuse. Connections agreed to monitor the mare in coming days and report any anomaly to Stewards.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>DL TREE SPECIALISTS LTD/CHRIS GOMMANS CONTRACTING LTD (1300 Metres)</b>
<p><b>BRAHMA SUNSET</b> (K Asano) – Reared as the start was made, losing ground.</p> <p><b>KAPINOS</b> (T Taiaroa) – Had to steady when TRIFOLIUM (M Singh) shifted in when not fully clear passing the 900 metres. M Singh was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p>	

**MEHRTENS** (J Riddell) - Raced wide early.

**BELLE PLAISIR** (J Parkes) - Raced wide early.

**ARTURO** (S Collett) - Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

**ACE ROYALE** (H Schofer) - Raced keenly and was awkwardly placed on heels having to shift outwards near the 800 metres.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CARTERS ASHHURST POHANGINA CUP (2000 Metres)</b>

**HURRY CANE** (S Macnab) – Slow into stride. Raced wide from the 1000 metres. S Macnab reported the gelding was unsuited to the tempo of the race.

**PEP TORQUE** (F Lazet) - Steadied abruptly going into the first turn when FATTORE OTTO (M Hudson) shifted inwards when only marginally clear. After questioning riders M Hudson was issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift in near the 1800 metres when not fully clear. Stewards took into account the pace ahead easing near the 1800 metres when assessing the interference.

**SIR NATE** (A Goindasamy) - When questioned into the disappointing run of SIR NATE, A Goindasamy was of the opinion the gelding was not suited to the tempo of the race, which he described as stop/start. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

**KING FAROUK** (S Collett) – Slow away. Held up in the early stages of the run home.

**THE RIPPA** (J Riddell) - Held up from near the 150 metres going to the line without being fully tested.

**SANIBEL** (K Hercock) - Briefly tightened when tiring near the 150 metres.

**CREDIT MANAGER** (T Taiaroa) – Held up in the early stages of the home straight, then lay inwards over the concluding stages.

**C Dell** (MIKJENE) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in the home straight.

**KELLYS INSPIRATION** (J Riddell) – Slow away.

**FREE TO SHINE** (S O'Malley) - Bounded at the start.

**BRUNO MAGILE** (F Lazet) – Raced in restricted room to the outside of KELLY'S INSPIRATION coming around the home turn and had to be steadied off the heels of the rapidly tiring FREE TO SHINE and shifted in to avoid that runner's heels simultaneously as KELLY'S INSPIRATION was on an outward movement, resulting in BRUNO MAGILE having to be checked.

**MADURO** (T Taiaroa) – Raced wide throughout. Rider dropped whip near the 150 metres.

**BELLESGIRL** (D Johnson) – Race wide early stages. When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the mare would be better suited to more rain affected footing.
