RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ONLINE CONTRACTORS 1300
<p>MIGHTY ASLAN (S Spratt) - Jumped away awkwardly shifting outwards hampering GLITTERING ARMOUR.</p> <p>KEATS (J Riddell) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader.</p> <p>SAIGNON (B Rogerson) - Jumped away awkwardly. Had to be steadied off the heels of OVERTHEMARK for a distance passing the 600 metres. Held up entering the final straight having to angle outwards across heels to obtain clear running.</p> <p>SHADY GREY (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 300 metres.</p> <p>GLITTERING ARMOUR (S Collett) - Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>O Bosson (THE LOST BOYS)- Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not fully clear of the weakening OVERTHEMARK which was steadied near the 300 metres then continuing to shift outwards hampering FELIX FAURE passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>OVERTHEMARK (J Fawcett) - Steadied away from heels when weakening near the 300 metres.</p> <p>FELIX FAURE (L Satherley) - Lay in early in the straight. Hampered passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>THE LOST BOYS (O Bosson) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running prior to the 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding racing a little greenly in only its second race day start.</p>	
Race 2	TE AKAU SHARK – FAREWELL TO A LEGEND 1200
<p>MONTANA MIST (T Newman) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>BURGUNDY ROSE (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Held up early in the straight making contact with BREEZON on a number of occasions in an attempt to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres before shifting back to the inside near the 200 metres.</p> <p>BREEZON (L Innes) - Contacted on a number of occasions passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>O’CHARM (S Spratt) - Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres having to be steadied over the concluding stages.</p> <p>J Kamaruddin - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards making contact with BREEZON on a number of occasions passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>HARBOURSIDE (M McNab) - Held up early in the straight.</p>	
Race 3	ALLIED SECURITY 2100
<p>MIGHTY CONNOR (S McKay) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after contacting a rail entering the birdcage becoming entangled and was cleared to start. Slow to begin.</p> <p>THAT’S INCRANIBULL (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>TORQUE TIME (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p>	

KIWIANNA (S Collett) - Crowded and checked over the concluding stages.

WHEAO (L Satherley) - Crowded having to be steadied over the concluding stages.

AMANO (C Grylls) - Contacted becoming unbalanced over the concluding stages.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the 2nd placed AMANO, viewed Steward's footage with regards to interference to the 1st placed ARLINGTON GOLD over the concluding stages before electing not to proceed with a protest.

M McNab - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount ARLINGTON GOLD to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear crowding KIWIANNA, AMANO and WHEAO which were all hampered and checked over the concluding stages. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M McNab's licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 13th February until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 27th February, 7 national days and in addition imposed a fine of \$700.

Race 4	LEGACY LODGE WAIKATO GUINEAS (Group II) (2000 metres)

LAUNCH PAD (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

MONTRE MOI (M McNab) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. M McNab advised that he had then got further back than intended and been forced wide when attempting to improve forward from the 500 metres.

ZEE FALLS (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover until improving forward to lead near the 1300 metres.

BRAZIER (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1300 metres.

MACS (L Satherley) – Held up entering the final straight continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

EMBER ATTACK (S McKay) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres after TANNAHILL shifted out under pressure. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

Race 5	WAIKATO STUD 1400

Trainers **P & D Williams** were fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement schedule after failing to declare a rider for **TEARS OF JUPITER** by the required time.

SCOTCH (M McNab) - Jumped away awkwardly then had to be steadied shortly after the start when awkwardly placed near the heels of ACUTUS which lay out. Was inclined to get its head up when being restrained through the middle stages.

TEARS OF JUPITER (D Johnson) - Underwent a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality after the rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages.

Race 6	BCD GROUP SPRINT (Group I) (1400 metres)

There was a delay to start of this race due to MASCARPONE requiring farrier attention.

LEVANTE (S Collett) – Slow to begin losing considerable ground. Co-trainer K Kelso was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.

Race 7	DAVID & KARYN ELLIS FILLIES CLASSIC (Group II) (2000 metres)

SAMINA BIBI (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

KEY (M McNab) - Slow away.

AMARELINHA (D Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding SWEET ANNA onto SLAVE TO LOVE. Held up early in the final straight then angling out across the heels of NEEDLE AND THREAD hampering VICTOREM. D Johnson was advised to exercise care. AMARELINHA was then disappointed for a run when SWEET ANNA rolled in with AMARELINHA having to shift outwards across the heels of SWEET ANNA to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

SWEET ANNA (L Innes) - Crowded start.

SLAVE TO LOVE (A Goindasamy) - Contacted start. Placed in restricted room near the 1800 metres when BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE lay in.

BELLA BUTTON (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

NEEDLE AND THREAD (C Grylls) - Lay out rounding the final turn.

V Colgan – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount CANUHANDLEAJANDAL to shift inwards crowding ILL AFFAIRE passing the 350 metres.

IL AFFARE (J Parkes) - Hampered when crowded 350 metres then having difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 100 metres.

VICTOREM (T Thornton) - Steadied off heels near the 350 metres.

BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE (L Satherley) - Held up 350 metres having to angle outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 8	HERBIE DYKE STAKES (Group I) (2000 metres)

CAMINO ROCOSSO (C Johnson) - Jumped away awkwardly then being restrained in the early stages. Commenced to over race near the 1200 metres being allowed to improve forward three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

SINARAHMA (D Johnson) – Slow away. Hampered near the 1600 metres.

DEERFIELD (M McNab) - Jumped away awkwardly.

ROYAL PERFORMER (J Riddell) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MELODY BELLE (O Bosson) – Raced in restricted room rounding the final turn between CAMINO ROCOSO and TIPTRONIC with the rider dropping his left reign near the 300 metres. MELODY BELLE continued to be unable to obtain clear running before having to be steadied near the 100 metres. When questioned rider advised that when racing in restricted room the mare may have switched off to a degree. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormality other than a minor laceration to the left hind coronet.

TIPTRONIC (V Colgan) – Shifted outwards to avoid the heels of MELODY BELLE near the 1600 metres when over racing. When being steadied, TIPTRONIC went back onto THE CHOSEN ONE and SINARAHMA which were both hampered. Required veterinary treatment post-race after being gallop on during the running.

THE CHOSEN ONE (T Harris) - Hampered near the 1600 metres.

Race 9	PETER KELLY – BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE MILE (1600 metres)

RAPID FALLS (M McNab) - Jumped away awkwardly and was then slow into stride losing touch with the body of the field in the early stages. Held up approaching the 200 metres shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres with THE GREEN GREMLIN laying out away from that runner crowding MILK POWER.

ALEXANDRITE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

MILK POWER (S Spratt) - Knuckled leaving the barriers. Steadied when crowded approaching the 100 metres.

LES CRAYERES (D Johnson) - Held up entering the straight and did not obtain clear running until near the 150 metres.

OCEANA LAD (R Elliot) - Held up near the 350 metres before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.
