RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC NIUTRITION MAIDEN 1200m
SOLDIER BOY (C Dell) - Slow away. Lay out and clipped a heel of NEST EGG, blundering near the 300 metres.	

NEST EGG (J Riddell) - Restrained early after jumping from the outside barrier.

NOVERRE (O Bosson) – Lay in under pressure in the straight.

FLYING FOR GLORY (J Fawcett) - The rider was of the opinion the filly would be better suited to a firmer track.

Race 2 | **WHANGANUI CHRONICLE MAIDEN 1200m**

ONE TO DIE FOR (T Taiaroa) - Was declared a late scratching at 12.35pm after refusing to enter the barriers. Trainer K Gray was advised the filly must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next.

WINNIE ROSE (M Singh) – Slow away. Had to be steadied passing the 1,000 metres when improving onto the heels of runners ahead, then over-racing for a distance.

BE FLEXI (A Goindasamy) – Slow away

MIDNIGHT SWEY (D Bradley)– Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **PULL NO PUNCHES** which shifted inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear.

C Dell (PULL NO PUNCHES) - Was issued with a warning after permitting his mount **PULL NO PUNCHES** to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear of **MIDNIGHT SWEY**.

COURT A WHISPER (S Macnab) – Raced three-wide without cover.

WOWWHATA HARADASUN (R Bishop) - Lay out rounding the final turn hampering **POROTENE SLING** near the 400 metres. Was not persevered with in the straight dropping out to last then quickly dismounted after pulling up. The filly was attended to by the veterinarian and found to have suffered a suspected fracture to the left-fore cannon bone with x-rays to be taken to determine what further veterinary treatment is required. A veterinary clearance will now be required before **WOWWHATA HARADASUN** next races again.

POROTENE SLING (S Weatherley) - Hampered when crowded near the 400 metres.

Race 3 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1200m**

LITTLE TEXAS SKY (F Lazet) - Scratched on veterinary advice 11.20am after incurring an injury en route to the races.

PIRIWAI (T Yanagida) - Slow away

BELCLARE (S Macnab) - Jumped away awkwardly.

DANZ I AM (D Bradley) – slow away

LILHOOVESGOTMOVES (H Schofer) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

NINJA TURTLE (S Collett) - Raced three-wide without cover.

C Dell (MAKADOON) - Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he allowed his mount to shift out near the 300 metres when not clear of **SPANISH ANGEL** which was checked. **C Dell** had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of races on 27 February through until the conclusion of racing on 11 March, and fined \$250.

SPANISH ANGEL (B Ansell) – Checked near the 300 metres.

B Ansell - Failed to weigh in on the unplaced **SPANISH ANGEL**. Stewards issued her with a warning under Rule 647 (1).

Race 4 | **WANGANUI GREYHOUND CLUB RACING TONIGHT MDN 1340m**

POWER PACK (S O'Malley) – Slow away

BUSTER'S HABIT (C Dell) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

HERMES (W Pinn) – Was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

SIGLO (B Ansell) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

M Singh (TUTIN CANS) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) d in that he angled his mount outwards passing the 300 metres hampering with **SHEZAWINKLE**.

SHEZAWINKLE (A Goindasamy) – Hampered 300 metres.

Race 5

STEVO'S DISTRIBUTORS 1340m

BANGLES (J Fawcett) - Became fractious in the birdcage when reacting adversely to the tongue tie which was removed.

MELODY ROXX (S Weatherley) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after suffering minor lacerations when being transported to the racecourse and was passed fit to race.

TENNESSEE ROSE (B Ansell) – Slow away

DAUPHINE (M Hudson) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Raced three-wide without cover.

SHOWBOURNE (W Pinn) – Rider was dislodged returning to the enclosure after the race but was uninjured.

FALCO THREE (S Macnab) - Disappointed for a run passing the 300 metres having to be steadied and shifted ground inwards across heels to obtain clear running.

A Goindasamy (PLATINUM DUBAI) - Was questioned into the performance of **PLATINUM DUBAI** and in particular his lack of vigour over the final stages. A Goindasamy advised his mount was never comfortable in the Dead 5 going and after being well tried prior to the 200 metres he considered the filly to be a beaten runner. A Goindasamy was reminded of his obligation to ride his mount out fully when circumstances permit and not in a manner which is left open to query.

Race 6

GUTHRIE BOWRON MAIDEN 1600m

WCKET WOY (T Yanagida) – Slow away. Held up over the final 100 metres.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (H Schofer) – Slow away. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1,400 metres to the inside of **SIR CALEB** which shifted in when racing ungenerously.

SIR CALEB (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1,400 metres, then continued to over-race into the middle stages.

ARKLOW (D Hirini) - Raced three-wide without cover.

TED CAN TOO (S Macnab) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TAKE A GAMBLE (M Singh) – Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after the start when crowded between runners. Film footage proved inconclusive with there appearing to be some movement from either side. Was inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of **TED CAN TOO** which shifted outwards under pressure near the 100 metres.

PUTORINO (O Bosson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. When questioned into the run of **PUTORINO**, O Bosson advised that after being crowded in the early stages the gelding got further back than intended and had taken some time to wind up when having to make its run wide.

CISJURANE (B Ansell) – Was inclined to lay outwards in the final straight having some difficulty obtaining clear running.

Race 7 | **MAD BUTCHER WANGANUI 1600m**

MONDORANI (A Mudhoo) - Slow away

MY FATHER'S GUN (K Hercoc) - Raced three-wide without cover.

Race 8 | **TERRY BROTHERS MAIDEN 2040m**

SCARLET REIGN (R Bishop) – Slow away

TEXAN (S McKay) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

GRAND PROSPECT (S O'Malley) - Jumped away awkwardly. Was dictated wide passing the 400 metres when **WICKLOW** improved to its inside.

JOSHUA ONE NINE (C Dell) – Shifted outwards abruptly shortly after the start inconveniencing **VORALTO** and **SWING THE TIDE**.

VORALTO (F Lazet) - Inconvenienced shortly after the start.

SWING THE TIDE (M Mudhoo) - Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Raced three-wide without cover.

ALARAMA (M Singh) – Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained passing the 1,800 metres.

Race 9 | **JOLT COFFEE HOUSE MAIDEN 2040m**

VINCENZO LORENZO (H Schofer) – Slow away. Was inclined to lug in, in the home straight.

EDDIE WOOD (S Collett) - Slow away

CHASING THE CROWN (B Ansell) – Commenced to over-race near the 1,800 metres shifting outwards when being restrained hampering **IRISH TRIX**.

IRISH TRIX (M Hudson) - Hampered passing the 1,800 metres.

DALPARK (W Pinn) – Steadied to avoid the heels of **INDY FOX** which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 1,800 metres.

C Dell (INDY FOX) - Was reminded of his obligations to be clear of other runners after allowing his mount to shift in shortly after the start when not clear of **DALPARK** which had to steady.

Race 10 | **WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE 2040m**

JACKAROO (S O'Malley) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

VINEYARD MCPHEE (S Macnab) - Shifted inwards to avoid the heels of **HINEPARA** near the 1,600 metres hampering **ZEROED**. Held up near the 250 metres prior to being angled out into clear running near the 200 metres.

ZEROED (D Bradley) - Hampered near the 1,600 metres and then inclined to over-race through the middle stages. Bumped near the 250 metres after **JACKAROO (S O'Malley)** was taken out by **THOMAS AQUINAS (S Weatherley)** and momentarily unbalanced. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care.

ROSE OF DELEGATIE (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover for the majority.

CARPE DIEM (R Bishop) - Crowded when weakening rounding the home turn. R Bishop was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

LOVEITORLEAVEIT (A Goindasamy) – Raced in restricted room near the 200 metres.

VULTURE STREET (J Fawcett) - When questioned J Fawcett was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.
