GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 METRES)NO TIME TOO JAZZ (D Hirini) - Slow away, had to be firmly restrained to avoid heels when MELODIOUS shiftedinwards near the 1100 metres, when questioned regarding performance D Hirini reported that the mare had racedgreenly throughout.

PARISIAN POPPY (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover.

MISS ONAKI (J Parkes) – Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres when the pace eased going back onto PAGE THREE, with MELODIOUS also being hampered, briefly hampered near the 600 metres when PARISIAN POPPY shifted inwards when improving forward. L Allpress was advised to exercise greater care. When questioned regarding performance J Parkes reported that in his opinion the filly may be better suited to being ridden more quietly in the early stages.

PAGE THREE (R Elliot) - Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.

MELODIOUS (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered having to ease off heels passing the 800 metres.

EXOTIC PEARL (F Lazet) - Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 800 metres when the pace eased.

KWAUSSIE GIRL (H Schofer) – Briefly placed in restricted room near the 600 metres between MISS ONAKI and PARISIAN POPPY which both shifted ground.

J Kamaruddin - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount MELODIOUS to shift inwards when steadying and not fully clear of NO TIME FOR JAZZ which had to be restrained near the 1100 metres.

Race 2 K9 PETFOODS 3YO (1400 METRES)

SUGAH SWEET (S Macnab) - Slow away, hampered near the 1300 metres, over-raced for a distance when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

LEGIT (J Parkes) – Lay out crossing the junction onto the course proper near the 1300 metres hampering GOLDEN HUE, UP 'N' POWER, MEG and SUGAH SWEET, inconvenienced near the 250 metres when MARCHIONESS lay in.

GOLDEN HUE (B Rogerson) - Hampered near the 1300 metres, commenced to over-race near the 1200 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages.

UP 'N' POWER (J Fawcett) – Hampered near the 1300 metres, crowded onto KUASA KUDA then badly checked approaching the 500 metres losing ground.

MEG (L Allpress) – Hampered near the 1300 metres, raced wide before improving forward to dispute the lead near the 800 metres, was a beaten runner entering the final straight being eased down by its rider over the final 250 metres finishing a distance last. A post-race veterinary examination found the filly to have suffered from cardiac arrythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance now being required prior to racing again.

THINKSO (S McKay) – Lay out and raced greenly passing the 800 metres, made the final turn awkwardly with the rider advising the filly had raced very greenly throughout and had recommended to connections that the addition of headgear, such as side winkers, may be beneficial.

UNDER HER SPELL (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered approaching the 500 metres.

MARCHIONESS (W Pinn) - Lay in once placed under pressure in the final straight.

KUASA KUDA (D Hirini) – Contacted near the 500 metres.

H Schofer (JOY ALONE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she angled her mount outwards passing the 600 metres when not sufficiently clear of UP 'N' POWER which was checked resulting in UNDER HER SPELL also being hampered. After viewing footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 27th February until the conclusion of racing on Friday 12th March (6 national riding days) and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 3 PGG WRIGHTSON 1400 (1400 METRES)

TONADILLAS (D Hirini) - Slow away.

HONNEUR NOIR (E McCall) - Got its head up when being steadied near the 800 metres. When questioned regarding performance E McCall advised that the mare was disappointing with connections advising its future will be reassessed.

KINSHASA (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover outside the leader from the 800 metres.

Race 4 KIWI TRANSPORT LTD MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

PAPENHUYZEN (H Schofer) - Jumped away awkwardly and was inclined to lay inwards in the early stages.

MYLA (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover.

Race 5 BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES (HB) 1200 (1200 METRES)

MANDALORIAN (W Pinn) - Contacted leaving the barriers when UP 'N' GONE jumped outwards.

UP 'N' GONE (J Fawcett) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with MANDOLORIAN.

ROC CHA (T Thornton) - Slow away.

GOLDCHI (F Lazet) - Raced wide without cover.

MISS SWEET PEE (M Singh) – Had a tendency to over-race when disputing the lead in the middle stages.

Race 6 WAIROA BUSINESS SUPPORTERS/BAY FORD 1600 (1600 METRES)

NYMENCHE (W Pinn) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after arriving on course with a minor skin irritation being passed fit to run.

LADY CALYPSO (R Elliot) – Slow away, held up near the 350 metres having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.

ATLANTIC FLYER (S McKay) – Crowded leaving the barriers when FOR PEPE'S SAKE was forced inwards after being bumped by ASK PA. The crowding to ATLANTIC FLYER was then exacerbated by outward movement from QUIET MICHAEL onto CHAMPERS. ATLANTIC FLYER then clipped a heel of FOR PEPE'S SAKE and blundered.

QUIET MICHAEL (S Collett) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight having to be checked off the heels of VELARDE near the 300 metres. Continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running before again being badly held up when disappointed for a run near the 200 metres and could not obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

ALMERAKI (E McCall)- Held up early in the straight and was unable to obtain clear running until improving into a tight run to the inside of CHAMPERS near the 150 metres, then being taken in by CHAMPERS which shifted ground under pressure. ALMERAKI was again inconvenienced when taken in by CHAMPERS near the 75metres. S Macnab was advised to exercise greater care.

VELARDE (J Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover, checked when weakening approaching the 100 metres when ALMERAKI was taken in by CHAMPERS.

R Bishop (SOVEREIGN EXPRESS) - Issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 AFFCO NZ LTD WAIROA CUP (2100 METRES)

HO NO OPILIO (L Allpress) - Made the first turn awkwardly.

DUPLICITY (S Macnab) – Briefly held up having to steady off heels near the 400 metres.

PIPING HOT (J Kamaruddin) - Had to shift ground near the 75 metres when improving onto the heels of PEP TORQUE.

Race 8 WAIROA EXPATS & SUPPORTERS MILE (1600 METRES)

HIGHER POWER (S Collett) – Slow away.

UNCLE BRO (S McKay) – Shifted outwards making contact with SHEBRINGSMERUBIES near the 1400 metres then having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of MATT CAIN (M Hudson) which was improving to its outside and shifting inwards. With Stewards taking into account outward movement from DEN BOSCH which was making the turn awkwardly M Hudson was on this occasion issued with a warning. UNCLE BRO then raced ungenerously for a distance.

M Hudson (MATT CAIN) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear crowding UNCLE BRO.

DEN BOSCH (J Parkes) - Made the first turn awkwardly.

MATT CAIN (M Hudson) – Raced three wide without cover, shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages having to be straightened just short of the finish.

J Kamaruddin (SHEBRINGSMERUBIES) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use.
