GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LAND ROVER HOY 9-14 MARCH STAYERS (2100 Metres)
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MONDORANI (R Elliot) – Slow away.

ZAC BROWN (S Macnab) – Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of MISS SHER NAN (D Bradley) which shifted inwards near the 1900 metres when not fully clear.

D Bradley – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount MISS SHER NAN to shift inwards near the 1900 metres when not fully clear of ZAC BROWN.

ARLINGTON GOLD (M McNab) – Raced three wide without cover before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1100 metres then disputing the pace when FLYING MEG, which had been the leader, improved again to his inside. ARLINGTON GOLD then had a tendency to lay in, particularly rounding the final turn when MISS SHER NAN was improving to its outside and ARLINGTON GOLD being inclined to shift away from that runner. When questioned regarding the run of ARLINGTON GOLD rider M McNab advised that he had not been issued any specific instructions but was expecting to ride the gelding in a forward position with cover. M McNab further stated that after beginning only fairly from a wide barrier he had been caught wide rounding the first bend and had been unable to obtain cover, then opting to improve forward to lead. Once reaching the lead and looking to give his mount a breather, FLYING MEG had kicked up to his inside with ARLINGTON GOLD then commencing to over-race with this being further exacerbated when MISS SHER NAN improved to his outside near the 600 metres and as a result ARLINGTON GOLD had then been unable to finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

RED ‘N’ SURF (D Hirini) - Held up entering the straight and did not obtain clear running until inside the final 150 metres.

HINEPARA (D Johnson) – Held up early in the straight until near the 200 metres.

HYPATIA (L Allpress) – Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormality.

D Bradley (MISS SHER NAN) - Issued with a warning after failing to ride his mount out to the finish of the race.

Race 2	TIME TEST 3YO 1300 (1300 Metres)
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SHARE POWER (J Parkes) - Reared at the start striking its head on the top of the barriers and beginning very awkwardly, losing several lengths. Returned to the enclosure with a laceration high up on its near-side hind leg consistent with having contacted the barriers on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any significant abnormality other the laceration to a hind leg which was described as superficial.

REAL SLIM TRADIE (K Hercock) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, then over-raced for a distance and continued to make the bend awkwardly before being briefly held up when unable to obtain clear running entering the straight.

Race 3	LITTLE AVONDALE BIG ON WINNING MILE (1600 Metres)
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HAKUNA MATATA (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

IT’S DOABLE (S Collett) - Raced wide around the first bend when improving forward.

KING FAROUK (T Taiaroa) - Raced wide without cover.

VIRTUOSO LAD (W Pinn) - Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight, going to the line under a hold when awkwardly placed near heels.

SASSENACH (V Colgan) - Held up early in the straight having to angle outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

T Taiaroa (KING FEROUK) - Reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the finish whenever circumstances permit.

T Thornton (NEDWIN) – Spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 4	POWER FARMING HB CUP ON SALE NOW MAIDEN (1400 Metre)
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BILLY EASTON (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly hampering SASKATCHEWAN.

SASKATCHEWAN (M Sanson) – Hampered start, then raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward wide from the 900 metres.

TELLME YOU LOVEME (W Pinn) – Had to be firmly restrained off heels going into the bend near the 800 metres.

KUASA KUDA (D Hirini) – Struck a heel of SASKATCHEWAN and blundered badly passing the 400 metres hampering FOUR QUEENS.

FOUR QUEENS (M McNab) – Hampered 400 metres.

K Asano (PRINCE OF TALLIN) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount PRINCE OF TALLIN to shift outwards near the 400 metres when not sufficiently clear forcing KUASA KUDA outwards onto the heels of SASKATCHEWAN. After hearing submissions K Asano had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Vodafone NZ Derby Day currently scheduled for Sunday 7 March up to and including racing on Thursday 18 March (7 national days) and in addition imposed a fine of \$750.

GOLDCHI (T Newman) - Trainer P Rodewald reported that he will be giving consideration to the racing future of the gelding.

Race 5	PER INCANTO PROVEN 1400 (1400 Metres)
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MISS LABASA (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

HUNTA PENCE (D Bradley) – Inconvenienced leaving the barriers when VIGOR WINNER jumped outwards.

MORE WONDER (B Rogerson) - Raced three wide without cover.

COLORADO STAR (L Hemi) – Held up rounding the final turn, continuing to be held up in the straight until near the 150 metres.

Race 6	WINTech PACIFIC POVERTY BAY CUP APRIL 17 1200 (1200 Metres)
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DUNEAGLE (W Pinn) - Jumped away awkwardly then ducked outwards abruptly from the outside barrier, dislodging rider W Pinn. W Pinn was stood down from his remaining rides aggravating a knee injury and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next. Co-Trainer C Murray was advised the gelding is required to barrier trial satisfactorily prior to racing next.

OCEAN BELLE (D Johnson) – Slow away.

ON SHOW (L Allpress) – Retired from the race after going amiss when racing free of interference approaching the 700 metres. ON SHOW was immediately attended to by the course veterinarian and the horse ambulance deployed, with ON SHOW being found to have suffered a right fore limb bilateral sesamoid fracture and was humanely euthanised.

PUYSEGUR (K Asano) – Held up early in the straight and did not obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.	
Race 7	LITTLE AVONDALE STUD LOWLAND STAKES (Group II) (2100 Metres)
<p>FLEETWOOD MACA (S Collett) – Was removed from the barriers after becoming fractious, being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 5.00pm after suffering facial injuries.</p> <p>PRIMO STELLA (R Elliot) – Slow away.</p> <p>CHARMS STAR (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly. Held up near the 300 metres having to angle outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>SWING THE TIDE (T Thornton) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of LLANACORD (L Hemi) which, after receiving some pressure from VICTOREM (S Macnab), shifted away from that runner near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>LLANACORD (L Hemi) - Crowded near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>S Macnab (VICTOREM) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift inwards crowding LLANACORD onto SWING THE TIDE near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>CIAMBELLA (D Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover. Hampered 600 metres.</p> <p>L Hemi (LLANACORD) – Issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards passing the 600 metres making contact with LILY’S LADY, with CIAMBELLA being hampered as a result.</p> <p>LILY’S LADY (C Grylls) – Contacted passing 600 metres.</p> <p>CHEAPER THANDIVORCE (V Colgan) - Held up rounding the final turn.</p>	
Race 8	TREMAINS STARTING GATES 2100 (2100 Metres)
<p>PERSISTENCE (L Hemi) - Slow away.</p> <p>BEAR GRYLS (S Collett) - Dropped its head as the start was affected and was slow away as a result.</p> <p>VINEYARD MCPHEE (S Macnab) – Slow away. Dismounted on pulling up and was attended to by the course veterinarian being found to have suffered a tendon injury to the right foreleg. Rider S Macnab advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A veterinary clearance is now required prior to VINEYARD MCPHEE racing again.</p> <p>SCOTTISH STAR (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>MASTER HERB (L Satherley) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>POROTENE CHARM (T Taiaroa) - Held up early in the straight. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres.</p>
