RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HR JONES & CO LTD 2YO (1200 Metres)
SOLDIER BOY (S Collett) – Slow away.	
DRUM MAJOR (R Elliot) – Disappointed. When questioned R Elliot had no excuse.	
Race 2	WHISKER FORESTRY LTD 1200 (1200 Metres)
WAIPAPA (M McNab) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.	
SORTED (F Lazet) - Raced wide without cover.	

HYDRO DARCI (L Allpress) - Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.	
BUSTER'S HABIT (B Ansell) – Had to be steadied off heels for a distance passing the 800 metres.	
RAFFLE (J Parkes) – Held up on the home turn prior to being angled wide to improve.	
PAPENHUYZEN (T Yanagida) - Lost near side front plate during the running.	
Race 3	MILTON PARK STABLES/GARY VILE RACING 1550 (1550 Metres)
BIG HEMA (M Hudson) – Slow away.	
PARTY BELT (T Taiaroa) – Crowded leaving the barriers.	
TED CAN TOO (S Macnab) – Raced three wide without cover and was inclined to over-race in the early to middle stages.	
FLAG HUNTER (M Macnab) – Unbalanced when contacted by PARTY BELT passing the 600 metres.	
HIBERNIA SEA (T Newman) - Held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty finding clear running in the straight until near the 200 metres.	
MIDGE MAISEL (J Parkes) - Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.	
SIR CALEB (S Collett) - Had to steady when in restricted room over the final stages.	
J Riddell (CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY) – Spoken to after weighing in excess of his weighing out weight.	
Race 4	MCVERRY CRAWFORD MOTOR GROUP 1550 (1550 Metres)
FAST WILLIE (T Yanagida) - Slow away. Had to be steadied off the heels of HERE COMES TROUBLE passing the 800 metres when the pace ahead eased and in doing so shifted out forcing JUST BEN over extra ground.	
PAPER CUT (S Macnab) – Restrained early to obtain a position closer to the running rail after jumping from the outside barrier, then being inclined to over-race through the middle stages. Raced greenly throughout.	
ALMERAKI (F Lazet) - Hampered leaving the barriers when JUST BEN jumped inwards. Had to be steadied near the home turn when awkwardly placed on the heels of ALL IN BLACKBERRY.	
HURRICANE LINCOLN (T Taiaroa) – Slow away.	
BEADMAN (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover.	
JUST BEN (S McKay) - Forced over extra ground 800 metres.	
MAKADOON (S Collett) – Over the final stages shifted in and away from BEADMAN when racing greenly and over-reacted resulting in S Collett having to take hold of her mount over the final few strides.	
Race 5	H&T CRUCIAL 2100 (2100 Metres)
WICKLOW (J Riddell) – Slow away.	

MILK POWER (D Bradley) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained shortly after the start and continued to do so into the middle stages. Raced three wide without cover.

CISJURANE (T Newman) – Shifted outwards to improve forward near the 600 metres hampering JOSHUA ONE NINE. T Newman was advised to exercise greater care.

JOSHUA ONE NINE (A Mudhoo) – Hampered 600 metres.

PRINCE OF DOON (J Parkes) - Over-raced. Connections advised the gelding would be spelled.

VORALTO (M Macnab) – Caught wide early so was taken forward leaving the home straight on the first occasion. When questioned M Macnab advised the mare travelled well in the early and middle stages but was under pressure from near the 600 metres, did not finish the race off and was disappointing.

A Mudhoo (JOSHUA ONE NINE) – Issued with a warning regarding the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 6	POWER FARMING MANAWATU 2100 (2100 Metres)

ARANCIA (R Elliot) – Slow away.

LINCOLN LANE (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously, getting its head up when being restrained near the 1900 metres.

COMMOTION (T Newman) - When questioned T Newman said the mare had every chance and was disappointing. Connections confirmed that the mare's future would be reassessed.

KUSUDA (K Asano) - Lost the offside front plate during the running.

Race 7	RAYNER BUILDING 1400 (1400 Metres)

ALL THE RAGE (B Rogerson) – Crowded onto RACED EVENS at the start when STAND TALL jumped inwards.

RACED EVENS (J Parkes) - Crowded start.

PODKAST (S Macnab) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres.

BELLE PLAISIR (K Asano) - Inclined to lug inwards in the home straight.

Race 8	TUI BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 (1550 Metres)

VENT (T Taiaroa) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barrier, incurring a leg injury when kicking the back of its gate after being loaded away and was declared a late scratching at 4.16pm on veterinary advice.

NOT SANTA (W Pinn) – Slow away. Had to be straightened when lugging in under pressure inside the 100 metres.

AOTEA LAD (J Kamaruddin) - Had to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres to improve.

Race 9	BJW MOTORS LTD 1400 (1400 Metres)

DESTINY ONE (K Herccock) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.

SHOWBOURNE (W Pinn) – Jumped outwards at the start dictating FALCO THREE outwards onto MASQUE, which was tightened and got back. Had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when improving up on to heels.

MASQUE (B Rogerson) – Tightened start.

HE'S DONE A RUNNER (L Allpress) - Had to shift ground inwards near the 150 metres to gain clear running.

FALCO THREE (S Macnab) – Went amiss near the 700 metres and was pulled up by its rider. FALCO THREE was attended to by veterinary staff and was humanely euthanised after fracturing a sesamoid. The horse ambulance was deployed.
