# GENERAL:

#### RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 HENLEY PARK 1500

 CHA SIU BAO (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Held up before shifting outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.

WATCH THIS SPACE (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

**INITIATIVE** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

Race 2 STELLA ARTOIS 1400

**SONOFABUTCHER** (S Collett) – Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.

MAKABAR (C Jones) – Raced in restricted room leaving the barriers and steadied.

**UP 'N' GONE** (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable offer any excuse.

**THREE SIXTY** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly. Hampered 1200 metres having to steady to avoid the heels of GIANT GEM then over-raced through the middle stages.

**GLITTERING ARMOUR** (A Calder) – Crowded for a distance then checked approaching the 1200 metres. Over-raced in the early and middle stages then improved forward outside the leaders racing three wide without cover from passing the 800 metres.

GIANT GEM (M McNab) – Crowded and hampered near the 1200 metres.

**SAIGNON** (B Rogerson) – Blundered near the 400 metres then shifting outwards dictating TINA AGAIN and COME BACK TIGER wider.

TINA AGAIN (L Satherley) – Inconvenienced when forced wider 400 metres.

COME BACK TIGER (M Hashizume) – Inconvenienced when forced wider 400 metres.

**MOUTON** (J Riddell) – Lay out under pressure approaching the 100 metres having to be corrected.

**V Colgan** (ALL PAID UP) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted ALL PAID UP to shift inwards near the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of GLITTERING ARMOUR which was crowded and checked, shifting in and crowding GIANT GEM. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended V Colgan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 13 March up to and including racing on Saturday 20 March, 4 National Riding Days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$300.

# Race 3 RACE IN SYDNEY WITH GO RACING NATHAN'S MEMORIAL 2200

DAYTONA RED (A Calder) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

**CITY SLICKER** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Was eased down passing the 300 metres and retired from the race returning to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination confirmed the

mare to have bled and is now subject to the mandatory two month stand down from training and three month stand down from trialling or racing with a veterinary clearance also required before trialling or racing again.

**TRIOMPHE** (K Asano) – Began awkwardly.

HE NO OPILIO (L Allpress) - Raced keenly when leading.

**POLZEATH** (J Fawcett) – Held up entering the final straight but failed to respond once placed under pressure.

Riders L Allpress (HE NO OPILIO) and Apprentice E McCall (ISKANDER) were questioned regarding their riding tactics after disputing the lead for the majority of the race with rider L Allpress explaining that she had been asked to lead on HE NO OPILIO which she had done and when challenged through the middle stages she had attempted to restrain the gelding which continued to race keenly. Apprentice E McCall explained that she had been given riding instructions to lead on ISKANDER and had attempted to do so from early in the back straight when challenging for the lead for some distance. Apprentice E McCall concurred with Stewards in that she had erred in her judgement by not taking a sit when there had been an opportunity to do so and was further advised that she would be expected to show better judgement in her riding in future.

Race 4 GRAEME THOMSON ANTIQUE & ESTATE JEWELLERY 1600

**LES CRAYERES** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly making contact with ARRAIGNMENT which was bumped out onto EASY M'LADY which became unbalanced losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**EASY M'LADY** (S Collett) – Contacted leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced, losing ground.

**RISING RENOWN** (A Calder) – The left side-winker became detached near the 1500 metres. The side-winker was found to be in good condition, nonetheless Trainer N Bishara was reminded that he must ensure the gear is securely attached.

**THE BUZZ** (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

# Race 5 FASTTRACK MUFHASA STAKES (1300 m)

**HOLYHEAD** (C Grylls) – Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier.

Race 6 VERTICAL LOGISTICS 1200

The start of the race was delayed due to the saddle of **MONTANA MIST** having to be readjusted behind the barriers.

**TEARS OF JUPITER** (A Goindasamy) – Jumped away awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded shortly after the start.

**ROCH 'N' HORSE** (L Allpress) – Crowded shortly after the start.

**IRON EAGLE** (S McKay) – Crowded passing the 1100 metres to the inside of THE DOM which lay in away from BREEZON with IRON EAGLE going back onto MONTANA MIST which had to be steadied.

MONTANA MIST (T Newman) – Steadied off heels passing the 1100 metres.

**SUPER PURSUIT** (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start. Raced wide without cover.

**MAI TAI** (O Bosson) – Held up rounding the final turn making contact with ROCH 'N' HORSE when attempting to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres. MAI TAI then continued to be held up before having to be steadied over the concluding stages when crowded to the inside of ROCH 'N'HORSE which shifted inwards. Prior to the authorisation of dividends trainer J Richards viewed film footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

**MANRICO** (C Jones) – Crowded between BREEZON and SUPER PURSUIT near the 250 metres. Lost right hind plate during the running.

**L Allpress** – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount ROCH 'N' HORSE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of MAI TAI which had to be checked inside the final 50 metres. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 11 March up to and including racing on Sunday 14 March, 3 National Riding Days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 7 HAUNUI FARM KING'S PLATE (1200 m)

JUSTACANTA (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin.

**MONACO** (T Newman) – Jumped away awkwardly.

SUMMER PASSAGE (S Weatherley) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

**PRETTY TO SEA** (M McNab) – Hampered leaving the barriers when ENTRIVIERE jumped outwards.

**MASCARPONE** (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover. Crowded when weakening near the 300 metres when ENTRIVIERE shifted inwards. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle todays track conditions.

**D** Johnson – Issued with a warning after permitting ENTRIVIERE to shift inwards crowding MASCARPONE near the 300 metres.

# Race 8 MCKEE FAMILY SUNLINE VASE (2100 m)

SAINTE ELISABETH (L Innes) – Began awkwardly making contact then crowded and steadied.

AQUAOIR (S Collett) – Bumped then steadied when leaving the barrier.

**BELLA BUTTON** (D Johnson) – Steadied from a wide barrier and made the first turn awkwardly near the 1700 metres making contact with the hindquarters of BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE.

BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE (K Asano) – Unbalanced when received contact to its hindquarters near the 1700 metres.

WAIMOKU FALLS (J Parkes) – Made the crossing near the 1650 metres awkwardly.

**SLAVE TO LOVE** (A Goindasamy) – Made the first turn near the 1700 metres awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider A Goindasamy advised the filly had not been comfortable in the existing track conditions.

**L Allpress** (SPINE TINGLE) – Reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

**O Bosson** (AMARELINHA) – Suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 13 March until the conclusion on Thursday 18 March, 3 National Riding Days and in addition fined the sum of \$2,000 after admitting a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres on his mount AMARELINHA.

Race 9	VODAFONE NZ DERBY (2400 m)

**IL AFFARE** (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly.

**GRIP** (S Collett) – Slow away, then crowded. Steadied 2200 metres when improving onto the heels of TOKORANGI which was taken in slightly by PERFECT SCENARIO. Briefly held up rounding the turn approaching the 400 metres.

**LORD ARDMORE** (M McNab) – Slow to begin, then crowded. Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1600 metres. Rider reported that the colt had felt indifferent in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**IFFIE SHOWS** (S Weatherley) – Steadied from a wide barrier. Raced three wide without cover through the middle stages before improving forward to lead near the 1200 metres.

**FRONTMAN** (D Johnson) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 2100 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of TRIBUTE KING with FRONTMAN then continuing to over-race into the middle stages. Came together with MILFORD early in the straight. Lay out under pressure over the final 150 metres.

**PERFECT SCENARIO** (O Bosson) – Raced wide from the 1000 metres. Unbalanced when contacted approaching the 400 metres. Lost the right front plate during the running. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to see out the 2400 metre distance of todays race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be grade 1/5 lame in the right foreleg.

**TANNAHILL** (J Riddell) – Lost right hind plate during the running.

**JASON BELLTREE** (V Colgan) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages and made the crossing awkwardly near the 1700 metres. Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.

EDGE OF WONDER (W Pinn) -- Lay out rounding the final turn when commencing to give ground.

**MILFORD** (L Innes) – Placed in restricted room near the 1900 metres to the inside of TRIBUTE KING which was taken in by TANNAHILL. J Riddell was advised to exercise care. Came together with FRONTMAN early in the straight.

**MONTRE MOI** (L Allpress) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 2200 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages. Raced in restricted room rounding the bend approaching the 400 metres when TOKORANGI was improving to its inside becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of PERFECT SCENARIO then making contact with that runner being hampered.

**ROCKET SPADE** (C Grylls) – Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of MONTRE MOI near the 1900 metres. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

**L Innes** (MILFORD) – A charge was filed with the Judicial Committee in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and adjourned until Saturday 13 March at Ellerslie due to L Innes having left the course.

**S Collett** (GRIP) – Spoken to with regards to her whip use in consecutive strides early in the straight.

# Race 10 BARFOOT & THOMPSON 1600

**BEA A ROCA** (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

HARBOURSIDE (K Asano) – Began awkwardly losing ground

**QUICK PREVIEW** (M McNab) – Steadied early after jumping from a wide barrier.

**BRUNO MAGILE** (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover. Steadied when inconvenienced near the 250 metres.

**TONY BE** (R Elliot) – Held up early in the straight.

**CLIQUE** (S Collett) – Briefly steadied to avoid the heels of HONESTY which shifted inwards under pressure near the 200 metres.

HUMBUCKER (V Colgan) – Steadied away from the heels of HONESTY near the 150 metres.

JOY ALONE (C Grylls) – Held up near the 300 metres and did not obtain clear running until the 150 metres.

**W Pinn** (HONESTY) – Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift inwards under pressure hampering CLIQUE near the 200 metres and HUMBUCKER near the 150 metres.
