RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Riccarton Park Function Centre Maiden (1200 Metres)
EASYRIDER (C Campbell) – Blundered on jumping.	
SOMBRA DEAMOR (G Jogoo) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.	

ROCMEMAMA (R Mudhoo) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.

BRIGHT FLASH (A Balloo) – Shifted inwards on jumping crowding inside runners.

POSTCODE ENVY (M Gestain) – Crowded on jumping.

MANSFIELD (K Mudhoo) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.

SWEET FIELDS (T Moseley) – Crowded on jumping.

WHIPPERSNAPPER (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards crowding inside runners, raced three wide without cover throughout, lay in for the majority of the race with the rider reporting she was unable to ride the gelding out due to it laying out. Following the race WHIPPERSNAPPER was found to have suffered a minor injury to the off hind leg and was treated by the on-course veterinarian.

INHERITANCE (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout, lay in when negotiating the crossing. Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2 | **Punters Challenge 10 April Maiden (1200 Metres)**

CROCODILE ROC (T Jonker) was a late scratching at 12.56 pm after refusing to load. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

AORANGI ASSASSIN (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

HIGH REZ (K Mudhoo) – Crowded at the start.

MISS HARLEY QUINN (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SILVER CANNON (T Moseley) – Hung inwards throughout the home straight.

Race 3 | **NZB South Island Sale 14 April Rating 65 (1200 Metres)**

ANJARDEN (B Murray) – Began very awkwardly bounding at the start and losing ground. A warning was placed on the mare's barrier manners.

TOUCHABEEL (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

OUR ROSETTE (K Chowdhoo) – Raced keenly through the early to middle stages skying its head on a number of occasions.

DIAMOND (L Allpress) – Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance of this favoured runner.

ROC MUSIC (D Bothamley) – Rider dropped whip passing the 125 metres.

B Murray (ANJARDEN) was warned for the manner in which he used his whip shortly after the start.

Race 4 | **Piccadilly Books Stocktake Sale On Until 15 March Maiden (1600 Metres)**

GALILEO EXPRESS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

STAR VISTA (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

IL SONETTO (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly, raced wide without cover throughout.

KRISTOFFERSON (S Wynne) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

JACK THE RIPPER (C Barnes) – Over raced in the early stages.

SAM'S SONG (D Bothamley) – Briefly crowded and had to steady passing the 1500 metres when HOMBRE (M Gestain) shifted in when not sufficiently clear. M Gestain was advised to exercise greater care.

CLUBCARD (K Chowdhury) – Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

B Murray (SPLASH PALACE) was stood down following this race suffering the effects of dehydration and was replaced on his remaining rides.

M Gestain (HOMBRE) was issued with a warning for using her whip in consecutive strides.

Race 5 | **Fern Law Ltd Lawyers Maiden (1400 Metres)**

Trainer **D Frye** requested a ruling under Rule 534(1) in that he wished to late scratch his runner GELATO due to track conditions, with the Judicial Committee ruling that the horse should start as there had been no material change in track conditions. As D Frye proceeded to late scratch GELATO, he admitted a breach of Rule 534(1) with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

SWEET STORM (Y Chew) – Slow to begin then crowded shortly after the start contacting a heel and blundering when DICELAND shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of the rider.

PENTESLA (R Beeharry) – Over raced in the early and middle stages and had to be restrained away from heels passing the 1000 metres.

JACK KNOWS BEST (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

DROPS OF JUPITER (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

ANCHOR ME (D Bothamley) – Held up early in the run home.

Race 6 | **Coupland's Bakeries Celebrating 50 Years Open (1400 Metres)**

JEWEL OF PATCH (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

Race 7 | **Kam Transport Marlborough Cup (2000 Metres)**

SULU SEA (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, held up near the 150 metres and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

LETSBRINGITON (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout, held up early in the run home having to shift ground outwards near the 300 metres to find clear racing room.

OCEANS AWAY (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

RAINMAN (G Jogoo) – Briefly held up near the 450 metres.

ZAKUNDA (L Callaway) – Lay in through the run home.

Race 8 | **Racecourse Hotel & Motor Lodge Rating 65 (1600 Metres)**

SURE IS (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, shifted ground over the concluding stages before being straightened by its rider.

SHOW PARK (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

FLOAT (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

MONASH (K Chowdhury) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when RELIABLY PERKY was taken in by MAIDINTHEMIST.

M Gestain (MAIDINTHEMIST) was issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in passing the 1000 metres dictating RELIABLY PERKY inwards onto MONASH which was crowded and briefly steadied.

LAPHROAIG (D Bothamley) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.

MISS CURIOUS (C Campbell) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.

GRAB THE BAR (G Jogoo) – Held up and had to shift ground outwards near the 200 metres to find clear racing room and passing the 100 metres was dictated wider on the track when SURE IS lay outwards at this point before being straightened by its rider. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care and straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.
