BORN TO BE BAD (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved quickly on to the heels of the runner in front near the 1750 metres, having to be steadied.

PERCEIVE (C Barnes) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained to take cover.

PETE THE DRIVER (S Khetoo) – Made the first bend awkwardly. Raced greenly throughout.

AYE BEE HAITCH (K Mudhoo) – Weakened from the 600 metres.

S Khetoo (PETE THE DRIVER) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip action over the concluding stages.

Race 2

AUTO WINDSCREEN REPLACEMENTS / CALDWELL CONTTRACTING FIRESIDE CUP (1335m)

IRISH EXCUSE (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.

WAIMATE BILL (G Jogoo) – Had to be steadied off the heels of the runner in front near the 1200 metres.

EASY HABIT (C Campbell) – When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

G Jogoo (WAIMATE BILL) was reminded of his obligation to ensure he rides his mount out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.

Race 3 GORE ELITE PLUMBING / ADVANCE AGRICULTURE (1335m)

MARMADUKE (K Chowdhoory) – Knuckled at the start. Raced wide in the early stages.

JACKSANTENS (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

RED RIGHT HAND (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly crowding outside runner.

HARVEY DARVEY (D Bothamley) – Crowded on jumping. Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages, getting its head up on a number of occasions.

TAVY ROAD (J Fawcett) – Lay inwards early in the run home and passing the 175 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of DARCI VINO which shifted ground marginally at this point. When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider advised that in her opinion the mare is looking for tracks with more moisture content.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES (1200m)

LILY OF THE VALLEY (M Gestain) – Began awkwardly and was then restrained to the rear from its wide barrier draw. When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised after being obliged to get back from the wide draw the mare had run on fairly over the concluding stages.

SACRED KITTY (K Kwo) – Lay outwards rounding the bend by the 1000 metres.

ROSY CLARK (C Barnes) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MABILIS (R Beeharry) – Raced greenly in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 5 HILLSIDE METALS / MCKENZIE FAMILY PINE BUSH CUP (2000m)

RUBY MARIE (K Chowdhoory) – Fractious in its barrier stall prior to the start, having to be removed to undergo a Veterinary examination before being cleared to race. Bounded at the start. Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover. Made the crossing near the 1700 metres awkwardly.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Shifted in abruptly at the start.

RUAKIWI BLAZE (S Khetoo) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Weakened from the 600 metres.

VANILLA MOON (C Barnes) – Held up rounding the final bend.

K Chowdhoory (RUBY MARIE) was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 AON INSURANCE BROKERS / AB LIME WYNDHAM CUP (2000m)

NOPELE (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

RIVIERA ROCK (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

WILD JACK (C Johnson) – Raced keenly when leading in the early stages.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

HOT TAP (R Mudhoo) – Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

Race 7 MACAULAY MOTORS / TITIROA TRANSPORT / RODGERS GARAGE (1335m)

There was a delay to the start of this event when **FILL YA BOOTS** became fractious in its stall, having to be removed to undergo a Veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered minor lacerations to the inside of its left hind leg and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 3.49pm.

RINGBOLT (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

FINDING NEMO (B Murray) – Raced wide in the early stages prior to being restrained to obtain cover.

CHOICE DU JEU (C Barnes) – Under pressure passing the 600 metres after tailing the field throughout with the rider reporting the mare is looking for greater distance and tracks with more moisture.

LA TARDIGRADA (R Mudhoo) – Lay outwards throughout the final straight. When asked to comment on the seemingly improved performance trainer J Dalton advised that the filly had begun better today and had made the best use of a good draw.

Race 8 ROBERT DENNIS RACING / LES FRISBY CONTRACTING (1335m)

DECEPTIO VISUS (K Kwo) – Bounded at the start losing ground. Held up in the middle stages of the home straight, having to be steadied passing the 50 metres and shifted outwards to find clear racing room.

KITTY POWER (S Khetoo) – Raced four-wide without cover from the 900 metres.

BLEW BY YOU (T Jonker) - Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event.

GLENHOPE (J Fawcett) – Raced greenly throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions with the rider reporting that the gelding would appreciate tracks with more moisture content.
