RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TOKOROA COSSIE CLUB & SWRC SUPPORTERS 1600

LA VELOCITA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PATSYS LAD (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

QIJI SWORDSMAN (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Dipped passing the 1500 metres.

SHEBRINGSMERUBIES (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

WASP (T Yanagida) – Contacted approaching the 250 metres by LUCKY SHARK (D Johnson) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider D Johnson was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

LUCKY SHARK (D Johnson) - Contacted 250 metres.

Race 2 MATAMATA TRACTORS & MACHINERY MAIDEN (1050 m)

DOV (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and then hung out for a distance. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the fillies racing manners.

ISLA JAY (S Weatherley) – Knuckled soon after leaving the barrier. Commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages. Briefly held up passing the 300 metres.

HEZA SHOWMAN (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

CHARMAINE'S DREAM (D Johnson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

EMPRESS QI (J Fawcett) – Commenced to hang out soon after leaving the barrier making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and running wide.

DOTTIE DEE (S Wynne) – Crowded and hampered passing the 800 metres when crowded by ISLA JAY which shifted out and away from EMPRESS QI which had shifted out when racing ungenerously. Steadied for a distance passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

OUR SASSY CAT (W Pinn) – Crowded passing the 500 metres losing ground and was then retired from the race by its rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Stewards opened an enquiry into the ride of apprentice W Pinn. Trainer V Prendergast was advised to report to Stewards anything that may become apparent in the days subsequent.

Race 3 TOKOROA CLUB (INC) 1200

GIMMEGOOSEBUMPS (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Steadied when in restricted room approaching the 800 metres.

SET IN STONE (A Goindasamy) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

CHEERFUL MOMENT (D Johnson) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

CALLISSIDENT (C Grylls) – Hampered at the start.

LA CAPITA (S Wynne) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

ATULLIBIGEAL (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with CALLISSIDENT. Commenced to overrace in the early and middle stages. Hampered 800 metres then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

JUST MAYBE (T Thornton) – Restrained from its wide barrier.

LEBANESE TRADER (M McNab) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MERCURIAL (W Pinn) – Over-raced in the early stages then raced in restricted room approaching the 800 metres to the inside of CALLISSIDENT which lay in and as a result shifted back onto ATULLIBIGEAL which was hampered. C Grylls was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

SOLDIER BOY (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

Race 4 FERTCO 1200

UP 'N' GONE (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin (4L). Trainer T Autridge was advised that a warning would be placed against the geldings barrier manners. Hampered 700 metres when improving onto heels.

PROSPEROUS (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

MIGHT (S Spratt) – Shifted out shortly after the start.

GLITTERING ARMOUR (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when restrained in the early stages.

AWARENESS (D Johnson) - Raced ungenerously when restrained in the early stages.

EL NYMPH (D Danis) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SIDE BY SIDE (S Weatherley) - Held up until near the 150 metres.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES (1400 m)

LAST LEG (D Danis) – Began awkwardly.

POSER (W Pinn) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

R Elliot (CANTSAYTOOMUCH) - Reminded of his obligation when using his whip on a horse which is clearly winning.

Race 6 TEAM WEALLEANS 1400

EXTERSEA (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

PLAY A PART (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

FORT WILLIAM (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

CHANDLER (T Newman) – Began awkwardly shifting in bumping ERNIE'S TAKEN. Raced wide without cover with apprentice T Newman explaining the gelding had hung badly and had been reluctant to gallop near runners.

ERNIE'S TAKEN (S Spratt) – Bumped at the start.

LIKE A BOSS (L Satherley) – Rider L Satherley reported that the gelding may have held its breath. Steadied when improving onto the heels of the weakening ARONOV.

ARONOV (T Yanagida) – Raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres when MALI STON (S Weatherley) shifted out under pressure. S Weatherley was advised to exercise care.

WEOWNA TIGER (J Fawcett) – Shifted out over the concluding stages making brief contact with CHANDLER.

Race 7 HOLSTER ENGINEERING LALLY AND SYMES SOUTH WAIKATO CUP (2000 m)

FELAAR (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

MIGHTY CONNOR (S McKay) - Slow to begin.

NOWANAGEN (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

POLZEATH (H Schofer) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after becoming tailed off which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 TIRAU VETERINARY CENTRE 2000

HIT THE ROAD JACK (T Harris) – Crowded and unbalanced leaving the barrier.

EL ZITA (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly.

CASH ME OUSSIDE (C Grylls) – Crowded at the start. Clipped a heel and blundered 1500 metres. Steadied when in restricted room 500 metres.

CHARMINGAFFAIR (C Dell) – Commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1500 metres when making the crossing shifting into the line of CASH ME OUSSIDE which clipped a heel and blundered. FLYING STAR which was following shifted out when taking evasive action.

PEECEE PUSSYCAT (S Spratt) – Crowded at the start.

PRIMO STELLA (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

OH TO BE (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly. Briefly unbalanced approaching the 200 metres by CHARMINGAFFAIR which shifted out slightly. C Dell was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

ANHEDONIA (J Fillmore) – Raced keenly when being steadied for a distance passing the 1600 metres.

FLYING STAR (T Thornton) – Hampered 1500 metres and shifted out.

DRAGON REALM (H Schofer) – Raced wide in the early stages.

DAQIANSWEET JUNIOR (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

ROCKWITHATTITUDE (D Danis) – Hampered 500 metres when in restricted room.
