Race 2 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK PREMIER (1400 Metres)	
TRANSITORY (L Allpress) – Co-trainer E Haworth advised Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of TRANSITORY, and it is their intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.	
Race 5 WENTWOOD GRANGE CUDDLE STAKES (Group III) (1600 Metres)	
TABATA (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards, TABATA underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 22 March which revealed no abnormalities. S Marsh further advised it is his intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.	

Race 8 AL BASTI EQUIWORLD DUBAI NEW ZEALAND OAKS (Group I) (2400 Metres)

NEEDLE AND THREAD (C Grylls) – Co trainer K Shailer advised Stewards, that on return to the stable **NEEDLE AND THREAD** underwent a veterinary examination which revealed a bone chip to the near front fetlock joint. **NEEDLE AND THREAD** will undergo surgery on Thursday 25 March and will then be spelled for eight weeks.

Race 1	BROOKS RACING STABLES MDN 1800
<p>WICKLOW (M Hudson) - Reared at the start and was slow away. Momentarily held up near the 350 metres prior to being angled outwards to improve.</p> <p>NUN HISSING (S Collett) - Tightened at the start and got back. Held up for a short distance prior to the home turn.</p> <p>MILLDOON (J Parkes) - Over raced in the early and middle stages when wide without cover and had to be steadied for some distance.</p> <p>UP 'N' POWER (D Danis) - Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Steadied passing the 500 metres when crowded between MILLDOON (J Parkes) and STONEHENGE (M McNab) when both runners shifted ground. J Parkes and M McNab were both advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>CAPTION (T Tairaoa) - Raced in restricted room over the final stages.</p>	
Race 2	KASA BLOODSTOCK 2YO 1100
<p>JAMAICAN EXPRESS (S Collett) - Tightened and got back at the start when runners either side shifted ground on jumping away. Improved onto heels near the 700 metres having to be steadied. Continued to over race around the home turn. Held up for a short distance near the 100 metres.</p> <p>NO NAY JUBILEE (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly. Made the first corner awkwardly and shifted wide.</p> <p>RANGI TOA (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MY TARNZ GIRL (L Allpress) - Was inclined to shift out under pressure over final stages.</p> <p>LASER'S FURY (J Parkes) - Steadied when in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>ALL IN ECHOES (T Thornton) - Denied clear running passing the 100 metres when BELLE WIND shifted in then being held up for the remainder of the race.</p>	
Race 3	STABLE BOOKS SUPPORTING NZ TRAINERS MDN 1200
<p>PARDON (L Hemi) - Dislodged rider L Hemi during its preliminary and after being recaptured was cleared to race by the Veterinarian. L Hemi was uninjured.</p> <p>HARDTIMES (M Hudson) - Slow to load and after rearing over behind the gates underwent a veterinary examination being cleared to race. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners.</p> <p>BALLINA (T Thornton) - Slow away.</p> <p>FIZZY MOON (T Tairaoa) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Forced wider when tiring near the 400 metres when TWITCH improved to its inside.</p>	

SO CHARMING (R Elliot) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

PAPENHUYZEN (C Grylls) - Was attended to post-race by the on course veterinarian after suffering from the thumps.

D Johnson (TWITCH) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 | **KINGSLERE STABLES MDN 1200**

BOLD MAC (J Parkes) - Reared and lost all chance at the start. Connections were advised the gelding will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

CAPALDI (R Elliot) - Had to shift outwards passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

D Montes de Oca (BLACK EYED SUE) - Issued with a warning for his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **SPARTA RACING 1200**

MELODY ROXX (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SUMI (S Collett) - Was slow away after being fractious in its gate. (3L) Had to be angled inwards in the home straight to improve.

GOBUYIT (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

MIGHT (D Danis) - When questioned into the disappointing run of MIGHT the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 6 | **STABLE BOOKS 1200**

HIGH ACHIEVER (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Improved on to heels passing the 600 metres having to be steadied.

SECRET SQUIRREL (M Singh) - Began awkwardly.

NUBIAN SMILE (S MacNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 | **WEATHERLEY BLOODSTOCK MDN 1400**

DROP THE BEAT (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres, then commenced to over race through the middle stages. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

GINGER SNAPZ (T Yanagida) - Shifted out at the start bumping with VISHAKHA (T Taiaroa).

BATTLE SECRET (R Elliot) - Stewards permitted R Elliot to replace S O'Malley (over weight) as there were no other suitable apprentice replacements available. Over raced in the early stages and had to be steadied for some distance.

KAZADEROSE (M Hudson) - Raced wide throughout.

SHEZABELTER (C Dell) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early and middle stages of the final straight.

JUST BEN (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions.

D Montes de Oca (IRISH FLARE) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of DROP THE BEAT (L Hemi) which had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.

D Montes de Oca (IRISH FLARE) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively in the final straight with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine \$300.

Race 8

REMEMBERING HAROLD TUSON 1600

PIERIAN SPRING (B Rogerson) - Slow away.

BRUNO MAGILE (S MacNab) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

BOSTON STRONG BOY (J Parkes) - Made the bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly and shifted out to avoid heels, then was obliged to race wide without cover for the remainder of the race. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced keenly when wide. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

WINE N' DINE (T Thornton) - Was briefly held up near the 300 metres.

ZENKURO (R Elliot) - Inconvenienced passing the 175 metres when EXQUISITE PEARL (L Hemi) shifted in. L Hemi was advised to exercise care.

Race 9

NEXT RACEDAY SAT 15 MAY R65 2000

MISTER GERONIMO (S Weatherley) - Slow away. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

SONGSUNGBLU (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly then commenced to over race shifting out abruptly when on heels near the winning post on the first round, then race three wide for the remainder.

DANGERMAN (F Lazet) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

LA STRATA (L Allpress) - Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when DANGERMAN (F Lazet) shifted out to obtain clear running when not fully clear. F Lazet was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.
