Race 4 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400

EXALTATION (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of EXALTATION, however, will look to go back racing the mare on left-handed tracks. J Richards further advised EXALTATION has now been sent for a brief freshen up.

Race 9 BARFOOT & THOMPSON AUCKLAND CUP (3200m)

STAR TSAR (C Grylls) – Co-trainer A Forsman advised Stewards, STAR TSAR, underwent a veterinary examination which included x-rays on Tuesday 16 March which revealed no further abnormalities, with the lameness to the left

hind leg which was detected after the race now subsiding. A Forsman further advised STAR TSAR has now been sent for a spell.

Racing Matamata Wednesday 17 March 2021

Race 2 MATAMATA TRACTORS & MACHINERY MAIDEN (1050 m)

W Pinn (OUR SASSY CAT) - An enquiry was concluded into the ride by Apprentice W Pinn on OUR SASSY CAT after the filly was retired from the race from near the 500 metres. When questioned Apprentice W Pinn explained that OUR SASSY CAT had been reluctant to gallop after racing in restricted room passing the 500 metres and after pushing the filly for several strides, W Pinn advised that the filly had not responded with OUR SASSY CAT being pulled out of the race as a precaution. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to find any significant abnormality with Trainer V Prendergast reporting that OUR SASSY CAT had trained on well since the race.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 1200

TANGO LOVE (T Newman) - Began awkwardly.

ZOLTAN (T Harris) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NO FILTER (A Calder) - Held up passing the 300 metres.

KELLY RENEE (W Pinn) - Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had been out-paced in the early and middle stages.

Race 2 TAURANGA CROSSING FASHIONS IN THE FIELD NEXT SATURDAY 1200

QUE PRET (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin. Trainer C Isdale reported that the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Connections were advised that the gelding would now be subject to the mandatory 3 month stand down from racing, 2 month stand down from training with a veterinary clearance being required prior to racing or trialing next.

MINI MYSTIC (J Fawcett) - Restrained in the early stages.

TAUPARAE (J Kamaruddin) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

S McKay (SNAKEYE) - Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 3 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1200

LITTLE BELLE (M Hashizume) - Crowded at the start. Had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

LIMENTIS (A Calder) - Jumped outwards at the start losing ground.

RHAPSODY IN BLUE (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered shortly after the start then restrained from its wide barrier.

DIVINE DIVE (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously in the middle stages when commencing to hang outwards.

MONTANA MIST (L Satherley) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

WOODCOTE LASS (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly.				

MADAM HASS (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider reported his saddle slipped forward shortly after the start placing the rider at a disadvantage.

HEZTHEWONFORUS (A Calder) - Held up throughout the final straight.

NEW YORK JAZZ (J Fawcett) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Steadied when hampered near the 50 metres.

T Newman (IRISH GIRL) - Admitted a breach of careless riding, in that she permitted her mount IRISH GIRL to shift in near the 50 metres when insufficiently clear of NEW YORK JAZZ which was steadied when hampered. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended T Newman's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 24 March up to and including racing on Wednesday 7 April, 7 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 5 ALL FROCKED UP GIRLS 1600

SEAJETZ (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

INITIATIVE (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres for a distance. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

BAD 'N' BOUJ (S McKay) - Slow to begin.

RHAEGAR (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced fiercely in the early stages before improving forward to lead passing the 700 metres.

CELEBRE (T Thornton) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ALL THE RAGE (B Rogerson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

Race 6 PACIFIC STONE KITCHEN AND VANITY BENCHTOPS 1600

CHA SIU BAO (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

WATCH THIS SPACE (S McKay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

RAY'S IN COMMAND (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

KATIE PERRIE (T Newman) - Held up entering the final straight.

ACUTUS (D Danis) - Raced in restricted room briefly passing the 200 metres.

Race 7 TALL POPPY TAURANGA SOUTH 1400

GALLARDO (M Hashizume) - Contacted at the start.

FOOGAYZEE (T Harris) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early for the majority of the final straight then improved into a marginal run inside the final 50 metres having to be steadied when placed in restricted room.

GIANT GEM (A Calder) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that he had got further back than anticipated when trying to obtain a position closer to the running rail.

COME BACK TIGER (D Danis) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ON DEMAND which shifted out passing the 250 metres. J Kamaruddin was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

WILLY AWAY (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

BEA A ROCA (T Thornton) - Held up passing the 350 metres before shifting out to obtain clear running.

MASQUE (J Fawcett) - Lay out making the final bend.

Race 8 WORLDS END BAR AND RESTAURANT FRASER COVE 2100

JAYDEEAR (D Danis) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved onto heels passing the 1650 metres having to be steadied. Became tailed off passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

PIPING HOT (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

ALEXANDRITE (E McCall) - Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres.

SUPER GEE (M Hashizume) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MASTER PAINTON (W Pinn) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1500 metres with the saddle shifting forward placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

M Hashizume (SUPER GEE) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 1500 metres when not sufficiently clear of MASTER PAINTON which had to be steadied.

L Satherley (MASTER HERB) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
