Race 1	CRAIGS INVESTMENT PARTNERS MAIDEN (1400 metres)
COPPER XPRESS (E McCall) – Crowded shortly after the start.	
FLAVIUS (D Johnson) – Restrained from its wide barrier.	
DEAR OH DEAR (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting in approaching the 150 metres.	
THE REAL TEST (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.	

Race 2	TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE (1400 metres)

N Bishara (VERRY FLASH) – Issued with a warning after VERRY FLASH was presented to parade later than the specified time.

MARRONI (O Bosson) – Jumped outwards at the start losing ground.

AILEEN GRACE (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly then steadied. The saddle slipped near the 600 metres placing the rider in difficulty for the remainder of the race.

RANGER (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MANRICO (J Kamaruddin) – Over-raced in the early stages shifting out away from heels passing the 1000 metres.

CALL ME EVIE (J Fawcett) – Held up until near the 150 metres.

DUNEAGLE (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Held up making the final bend improving into a narrow run approaching the 300 metres, then crowded and steadied for a distance.

LES CRAYERES (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight before shifting in to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres crowding DUNEAGLE which was steadied

Following the race, the connections of the 3rd placed horse **DUNEAGLE** lodged a protest against the 1st placed horse **LES CRAYERES** alleging interference in the final straight. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

D Johnson (LES CRAYERES) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift in near the 300 metres when insufficiently clear of DUNEAGLE which was crowded and steadied. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended D Johnson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 April up to and including racing on Thursday 8 April, 4 national riding days and also imposed a fine of \$400.

SAINTE ELISABETH (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight but failed to respond when placed under pressure.

SPIRIT OF BAZ (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

MARCHIONESS (M McNab) – Made the final bend awkwardly. Raced greenly in the final straight ducking out when struck with the whip passing the 100 metres inconveniencing WAIMOKU FALLS.

WAIMOKU FALLS (A Calder) – Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

Following the race, the connections of the 3rd placed horse **WAIMOKU FALLS** lodged a protest against the 2nd placed horse **MARCHIONESS** alleging interference in the final straight. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

MY GIFT (M Hashizume) – Raced three wide without cover.

<p>NEDWIN (T Thornton) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.</p> <p>QUICK PREVIEW (J Riddell) – Contacted at the start.</p> <p>RISING RENOWN (C Jones) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MIGHTY ASLAN (A Calder) – Held up early in the final straight before shifting in approaching the 250 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 6	ULTIMATE MAZDA JAPAN TROPHY (1600 metres)
<p>PRISE DE FER (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>IMELDA MARY (S Weatherley) – Restrained from its wide barrier.</p> <p>GINO SEVERINI (M McNab) – Knuckled at the start. Lost the off fore plate during the running.</p> <p>GERMANICUS (J Fawcett) – Commenced to hang out when being steadied in the early stages. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1100 metres to the inside of PACKING ROCKSTAR (L Innes) and then continued to hang out for a distance through the middle stages.</p> <p>SIRACUSA (D Johnson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>OCEAN BILLY (J Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider J Parkes advised the gelding had been outpaced when the field quickened and would be better suited to a further distance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>L Innes (PACKING ROCKSTAR) – Issued with a warning after allowing PACKING ROCKSTAR to shift in passing the 1100 metres placing GERMANICUS in restricted room for a distance.</p>	
Race 7	CRAIG ORR BAYLEYS RESIDENTIAL HANDICAP (1200 metres)
<p>WERTHEIMER (S Weatherley) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Improved onto heels passing the 75 metres and was steadied for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>LILHOOVESGOTMOVES (D Johnson) – Slow away. Had difficulty finding clear running until inside the final 200 metres. Crowded and steadied over the concluding stages.</p> <p>MALT TIME (A Goindasamy) – Commenced to hang out in the early stages making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres with the saddle then shifting placing rider A Goindasamy in difficulty. MALT TIME then ran wide passing the 600 metres dictating OUR FINE WINE very wide on the track taking no further effective part in the race. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to trial right-handed to the satisfaction of Stewards before being permitted to race right-handed.</p> <p>OUR FINE WINE (J Kamaruddin) – Forced very wide passing the 600 metres taking no effective part in the race.</p> <p>HENRY HUDSON (T Harris) – Hung throughout the middle stages making the final turn awkwardly. Was inclined to shift out under pressure in the final straight. Crowded approaching the winning post.</p> <p>BETTE DAVIS EYES (T Thornton) – Crowded approaching the 200 metres by HENRY HUDSON (T Harris) which shifted out when struck with the whip before being corrected by its rider.</p>	

SECRET AMOUR (O Bosson) – Held up early in the final straight improving into a marginal run passing the 250 metres. Ducked out approaching the winning post despite the efforts of its rider crowding KEATS which was steadied and when being correct by its rider SECRET AMOUR shifted in further crowding KEATS close to the winning post.

KEATS (J Riddell) – Crowded passing the 50 metres and steadied away from heels. Crowded over the concluding stages.

T Harris (HENRY HUDSON) – Issued with a warning for permitting HENRY HUDSON to shift out near the 300 metres crowding the weakening BETTE DAVIS EYES.
