**SUPPLEMENTARY:****Ashburton Racing Club – Thursday 18 March 2021****Race 4 - Malcolm Davidson Memorial 2200 Metres**

Trainer P Harris informed Stewards that after initially advising he was going to retire BATTLINAWAY as a racing proposition it was found the gelding had a very low blood count which may have been due to the onset of a virus. Mr Harris advised he would be treating the gelding and would trial BATTLINAWAY before considering whether to continue its racing career.

**Beaumont Racing Club – Monday 22 March 2021****Race 3 – Edinburgh Realty/Peter Lyon Shearing**

**K Kwo** – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount AGAINST ALL ODDS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of ARROWTOWN which was dictated inwards crowding RAISE YA CARDS which was checked near the 1300 metres with the matter being adjourned by the Judicial Committee due to the full race day film replay system being unavailable following a power outage. The hearing was resumed at Riccarton on Saturday 27 March and after viewing films and hearing submissions K Kwo was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 April until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 8 April and in addition fined the sum of \$250.

**RACE COMMENTS:****Race 1      PAT REARDON FAMILY Rating 74 (1200m)**

**OKAY PAL** (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

**WAY ABOVE** (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

**SPRING BLOSSOM** (C Barnes) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised she was disappointed with the performance and was unable to offer any excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**S Wynne** (OKAY PAL) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 2      SOUTHERN VETERINARY SUPPLIES Rating 65 (1200m)**

**TORO ROSSO** (M Gestain) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start, began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding was out paced throughout.

**SELFIE** (K Asano) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

**THE SELECTION** (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

**AUTHENTIC CHARM** (L Hemi) – Shifted outwards on jumping when beginning awkwardly, held up in the early and middle stages of the run home.

**LOVEBUG** (R Elliot) – Shifted inwards on jumping when beginning awkwardly, when over racing had to be steadied after being placed in restricted room to the inside of ROC MUSIC (D Bothamley) which shifted inwards near the 800 metres. D Bothamley was advised to exercise greater care.

**ACTING UP** (S Wynne) – Raced wide without cover throughout, briefly steadied to avoid the heels of THE SELECTION (K Mudhoo) which shifted inwards under pressure near the 50 metres. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

**TAP ‘N’ GO** (L Callaway) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**JIMINY CRICKET** (T Jonker) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after losing ground in the early stages the gelding had been unable to recover and in her opinion would now be better suited over more ground.

**FIRST ROCK** (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the mare would derive benefit from today’s race.

**M Gestain** (TORO ROSSO) - Spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PETERSENS JEWELLERS LADIES BRACELET TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)</b>
---------------	-----------------------------------------------------------------

**STYLISH DESIGN** (D Danis) - Declared a late scratching at 1.16 pm after refusing to load delaying the start. Connections were advised the filly is now required to barrier trial satisfactorily prior to racing next.

**MACKENZIE LAD** (S Wynne) – Began very awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly making heavy contact with BEAU ROUGE which was forced onto SORRENTO.

**BEAU ROUGE** (L Allpress) – Heavily contacted and buffeted between runners at the start then was not persevered with by its rider who advised that after being crowded the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**SORRENTO** (G Jogoo) – Hampered at the start, lay in over the concluding stages.

**GLOBAL BEAUTY** (R Beeharry) – Shifted outwards on jumping crowding I WANNA FLY and ART DE TRIOMPHE with both runners losing ground.

**ART DE TRIOMPHE** (S Spratt) – Crowded leaving the barriers when EIGHT BALL shifted inwards and GLOBAL BEAUTY shifted outwards.

**EIGHT BALL** (B Murray) – Jumped away awkwardly then had to be steadied shortly after the start when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of FIREGLOW, commenced to race fiercely for a distance shortly after the start.

**DURBAN WAY** (K Williams) – Hampered shortly after the start.

**AERIAL BLUE** (C Johnson) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.

**S Spratt** (ART DE TRIOMPHE) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a \$300 fine.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>JACK THOMPSON OPEN SPRINT (1400m)</b>

**AUGUSTACE** (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**KHIMAR WAR** (C Johnson) – Held up in the straight and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running made contact with QUINTUPLE TWINS near the 200 metres.

**QUINTUPLE TWINS** (G Jogoo) – Contacted near the 200 metres.

<b>ROCK SENSATION</b> (K Chowdhoo) – Lost the left front plate during the running.	
<b>K Chowdhoo</b> (ROCK SENSATION) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>COCHRANES FARM MACHINERY Rating 74 (2000m)</b>
<b>POINT SCORE</b> (C Johnson) – Slow to begin, had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the straight. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding felt reluctant to improve between runners throughout the race and in his opinion may benefit from the addition of an item of head gear.	
<b>MASTER COURTSMAN</b> (L Hemi) – Slow to begin.	
<b>BOTTI</b> (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
<b>PAMIR</b> (D Danis) – Held up rounding the final bend and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight until inside the final 200 metres.	
<b>COLORADO MISS</b> (T Moseley) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.	
<b>LETSBRINGITON</b> (G Jogoo) – Lay in under pressure in the straight.	
<b>BELINDABELLA</b> (K Mudhoo) – Eased down over the final 100 metres with the rider advising that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
<b>LARIPPA</b> (C Barnes) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>SEATON FAMILY MEMORIAL HORORATA GOLD CUP (1800m)</b>
<b>BENEFICIAL</b> (K Kwo) – Jumped in the air at the start and was slow away, held up in the early stages of the run home.	
<b>CAMINO ROCOSO</b> (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin, held up passing the 400 metres having to steady and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.	
<b>OCEANS AWAY</b> (C Barnes) – Hung outwards throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection found the gelding to have a poor rate of recovery.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>SELWYN RAKAIA VET SERVICES THREE-YEAR-OLD (1400m)</b>
<b>ATISHU</b> (K Asano) – Bounded then blundered badly on jumping.	
<b>LARPOWER</b> (K Kwo) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained shortly after the start. Rider was of the opinion that the filly would be better suited by some easing of the ground.	
<b>LELAWALA</b> (D Danis) – Raced wide in the early stages.	
<b>GALILEO EXPRESS</b> (G Jogoo) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start when OHIO SHOWGIRL (K Chowdhoo) shifted in, K Chowdhoo was advised to exercise greater care. GALILEO EXPRESS then commenced to over race and continued to do so into the middle stages.	
<b>OHIO SHOWGIRL</b> (K Chowdhoo) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.	
<b>A Balloo</b> (STREET FIGHTIN MAN) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 4 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Monday 5 April up to and including Saturday 10 April and in addition imposing a fine of \$500.	

<b>D Danis</b> (LELAWALA) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>VALACHI DOWNS SOUTH ISLAND THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS STAKES (1600m)</b>
<p><b>PULLYOURSOCKSUP</b> (S Spratt) – Fractious in the barriers.</p> <p><b>BRONTE BEACH</b> (K Asano) – Shifted outwards on jumping when beginning awkwardly.</p> <p><b>JUST FABULOUS</b> (L Allpress) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.</p> <p><b>TRADITION</b> (C Barnes) – Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.</p> <p><b>S Wynne</b> (BELLE FASCINO) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 27 March up to and including Friday 9 April and in addition imposing a fine of \$1,000.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>FRESHCHOICE PREBBLETON Rating 65 (1600m)</b>
<p><b>SURE IS</b> (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>VICENZA</b> (K Asano) – Raced wide in the early stages, rider lost his whip when racing in restricted room to the inside of MISS CURIOUS passing the 400 metres then being further crowded when MISS CURIOUS (C Campbell) lay in under pressure near the 350 metres.</p> <p><b>C Campbell</b> (MISS CURIOUS) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards under pressure near the 350 metres.</p> <p><b>MISS CURIOUS</b> (C Campbell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, lay inwards under pressure early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>UCALLEDIT</b> (R Elliot) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>S Wynne</b> (SURE IS) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>
