Race 1	BLAIR RACZ FENCING & FLIPPIN FISH (1400m)
<p>SHEZA PRO (A Balloo) – Fractious and reared in its barrier prior to the start unseating rider A Balloo. Removed from its stall and underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination before being cleared to race. Slow to begin and was further hampered when crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>IZZY HOUDINI (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When asked to comment on the seemingly disappointing performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse. Trainer advised in her opinion the mare had failed to handle today’s track conditions. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>WILD LIKE (K Chowdhoory) – Shifted out at the start crowding outside runners. Lay outwards throughout.</p> <p>CODA BIANCA (L Callaway) – Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>DIAMOND RIVIERE (R Beeharry) – Crowded and got back shortly after the start.</p> <p>ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (M Gestain) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>KAMENNA (C Campbell) – Raced wide in the early stages. Rider advised that the mare had not been entirely comfortable with today’s track conditions.</p> <p>DROPS OF JUPITER (J Lowry) – Briefly placed in restricted room near the 900 metres when SOVIET WONDER lay inwards on the point of the bend before being straightened by its rider.</p> <p>MISS HARLEY QUINN (T Moseley) – Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>WANNABE ‘N’ PARIS (C Barnes) – Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>Apprentice rider S Khetoo (KING OF THE CASTLE) in the presence of the riding mentor was shown the films of the final straight and spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	FORDE AUTO SERVICES AND INSURANCE BROKERS ALLIANCE (1400m)
<p>MARMADUKE (K Chowdhoory) – Bounded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>HARLEEN QUINZEL (R Mudhoo) – Blundered at the start losing ground. Got its head up for a short distance and shifted out abruptly when being steadied negotiating the crossing near the 1250 metres.</p> <p>SLINKY LINKY (T Jonker) – Raced four-wide without cover in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>BRUCIE (C Campbell) – Raced greenly passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>KAPALKA (M Gestain) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>AGAINST ALL ODDS (G Jogoo) – Shifted inwards abruptly when struck with the whip near the 150 metres hampering DARCI VINO.</p> <p>DARCI VINO (K Kwo) – Hampered near the 150 metres.</p> <p>C Campbell (BRUCIE) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.</p> <p>K Chowdhoory (MARMADUKE) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>C Johnson (BENNY LINCOLN) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip in an excessive manner prior to</p>	

the 100 metres. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$500.	
Race 3	EWEN ALLAN HONDA AND PANKHURST SAWMILLING EXCELLENCY STAKES (1100m)
<p>CLASSIC DIVA (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres having to be straightened by its rider.</p> <p>JUSTANACE (K Chowdhoo) – Shifted in and away from CLASSIC DIVA passing the 150 metres hampering PICKENS. Shied at the winning post unbalancing the rider who lost the use of his outside iron.</p> <p>PICKENS (C Campbell) – Hampered near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 4	J G CARRAN 60 YEARS SINCE FIRST RIVERTON WINNER APARIMA HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>IRISH EXCUSE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>EASY HABIT (C Johnson) – Got back shortly after the start.</p> <p>MINT JULEP (K Kwo) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early stages of the run home.</p> <p>R Mudhoo (KING COUGAR) - was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 5	SOUTH PACIFIC MEATS AND SPARROW LOGGING FAIRFAX HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>SHAM ON TOAST (T Jonker) – Fractious and reared in the barriers then kicked out at the back gate prior to the start. Removed from its stall and underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have some superficial abrasions on the back legs and as such was declared a late scratching at 2.19pm.</p> <p>LA TARDIGRADA (K Kwo) – Reared as the gates opened and began awkwardly and was then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early stages and got its head up when being restrained, shifting in abruptly and crowding PINHEAD passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>KITTY POWER (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>WALKTHISSWEY (B Murray) – Began awkwardly and shifted out crowding LA TARDIGRADA. Got its head up in the early stage when being restrained to take cover. Raced four-wide without cover through the early stages and three-wide without cover thereafter.</p> <p>DREAMING EASY (R Mudhoo) – Got back shortly after the start.</p> <p>PINHEAD (S Khetoo) – Crowded passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>PHYLLITE (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>BENAUD (W Papier) – Improved wide from the 600 metres.</p> <p>FINAL SAVINGS (R Beeharry) – Briefly held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>LOUIS LUCK (D Bothamley) – Briefly held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>MOTHER GOOSE (K Mudhoo) – Placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres, having to be severely restrained when WALKTHISSWEY which was laying out, shifted out and away from FINAL SAVINGS simultaneous to PINHEAD laying in at this point.</p> <p>STRAIGHT SETS (K Chowdhoo) – When asked to comment the rider could offer no tangible excuse for the seemingly disappointing performance of this favoured runner.</p>	
Race 6	BUPA CARE SERVICES FRANCOLIN STAKES (1400m)
<p>Trainer P Harris admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) when presenting RIVERFALLS with the incorrect saddlecloth and was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee.</p> <p>QUINTUPLE TWINS (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.</p>	

ROSIE GLOW (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Improved wide from the 1100 metres to lead passing the 700 metres.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

IMBLAZE (C Johnson) – Blundered passing the 1300 metres. When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that after blundering early the mare had travelled up well but when asked for an effort had failed to let down and had been disappointing.

MEARA MARY (K Chowdhoo) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

KIWI IDA (R Beeharry) – Reported by its rider to have hung throughout.

S Khetoo (FLYING SARDINE) was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7	ILT AND SPEIGHT'S POURAKINO HANDICAP (2147m)

FIRODEN (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied shortly after the start when **VAGUE** which was improving forward shifted in. **R Beeharry** (**VAGUE**) was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

FINDING NEMO (B Murray) – Weakened from the 1000 metres. Rider reported the gelding had failed to hit out at any stage and had been under pressure a long way from home. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

DOUGH BOY (T Moseley) – Raced three-wide with cover throughout.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (R Aukett) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Dictated inwards near the 300 metres hampering **SHANZINO**.

COUNTESS RUBY (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final bend.

JACK BE QUICK (G Jogoo) – Held up in the early stages of the run home.

SHANZINO (T Jonker) – Placed in restricted room having to steady near the 300 metres when **BEAM ME UP SCOTTY** was taken inwards by **FIRODEN** which shifted marginally at this point.

VAGUE (R Beeharry) – Lay inwards in the run home.

R Aukett (**BEAM ME UP SCOTTY**) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip in an excessive manner prior to the 100 metres. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 8	CARRIERS ARMS HOTEL RIVERTON CUP (2147m)

Trainer **S Blair-Edie** was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 616(4) when presenting **HE AIN'T HEAVY** with Blinkers and not the declared Visor Blinkers.

HOT TAP (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

SCAGLIONI (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (S Khetoo) – Raced three-wide without cover from the 1000 metres. Lay inwards over the concluding stages having to be straightened by its rider.

DR VELOCIOUS (T Moseley) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend dictating **OUR BOY RITCHIE** wider on the track.

B Murray (**TAPDOG**) – was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

C Campbell (**GOLD'NGURU**) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip in an excessive manner prior to

the 100 metres. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Campbell's licence to ride from the 11th April up to and including the 18th April (6 days) and a fine of \$200.

Race 9	ST COLUMBA'S CLASS OF 67 REUNION

RED MAJOR (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

NESTA (C Johnson) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

EXCHANGE (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. Lay inwards near the 300 metres and became awkwardly placed on the heels of VEE TWELVE having to be straightened by the rider.

THE MOLE (C Barnes) – Shifted outwards and away from CANNOLI near the 200 metres.

C Barnes was issued with a warning under the Careless Riding rule when allowing her mount to shift out passing the 200 metres dictating VEE TWELVE outwards onto EXCHANGE which in turn made contact RINGADINGDING with stewards advising her she must straighten her runner sooner than she did on this occasion.

RINGADINGDING (S Khetoo) – Bumped by inside runner and had to be shifted across heels passing the 200 metres losing some momentum.

Race 10	MARQUEE PARTY HIRE AND MARTIN FORDE WAIPANGO HANDICAP (1600m)

Trainer **K Dickson** was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 616(4) when presenting THE FLAGON with Visor Blinkers and not the declared Blinkers.

ST ANDRE (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

PABLEAU (T Moseley) – Restrained from its wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SHOW PARK (R Mudhoo) – Restrained from its wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start. Placed in restricted room and made contact with the running rail passing the 700 metres when ORAKA PLAYBOY was laying at this point.

GLENHOPE (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced in the early stages.

GRAND EXPRESS (T Jonker) – Raced three-wide throughout. Returned to the birdcage with an injury to a hind leg consistent with being galloped on during the running.

THE FLAGON (S Khetoo) - Raced four-wide throughout.

ORAKA PLAYBOY (K Kwo) – Had to steady passing the 200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MILANO which was laying out under pressure.

MASTER LINCOLN (C Johnson) – Steadied near the 200 metres when GLENHOPE shifted in under pressure. Rider reported that after having to steady near the 200 metres the gelding had battled on fairly over the concluding stages.

NON BLONDE (C Barnes) – Rider reported that the mare had got further back than anticipated and had found it difficult to make ground on a muddling tempo.

MILANO (D Bothamley) – Reported by its rider to have hung throughout.

R Mudhoo (SHOWPARK) – was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
