RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION (1200 metres)		
HOT SALSA (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.			

SPLASH OF RED (V Colgan) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Denied clear running passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of DARCI DIVA.

WELL I NEVER (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after.

FRONT PAGE (L Satherley) - Trainer D Sweeney advised Stewards pre-race that the filly was in season.

RED STAR (B Rogerson) - Steadied passing the 1000 metres when placed in restricted room to the outside of HOT SALSA which shifted out slightly and inside of RABADA which was forced inwards by PETONE which was racing ungenerously. C Jones was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

PETONE (C Jones) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when racing wide.

RABADA (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

L Satherley (FRONT PAGE) - Spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 2 THE CHANTELLE SHOWSTOPPER 50TH CELEBRATION (1200 metres)

HALF OF NOTHING (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

ARCARIUS (M McNab) - Held up early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

CAMINATA (L Innes) - Inconvenienced over the concluding stages when CHARMAINE'S DREAM (S Collett) shifted out when placed under pressure. S Collett was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in his opinion the filly would benefit from further easing of the ground.

SWORD OF MERCY (W Pinn) - Lay out when placed under pressure rounding the final bend and early in the final straight placing the rider in difficulty.

C Grylls (MONZA) - Spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 3

THE FRESH MARKET GATE PA SHOPPING CENTRE (1200 metres)

VALADAMS (H Schofer) - Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground. Lay out rounding the final bend shifting wider. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mares racing manners.

LIGHTNING FIELD (O Bosson) - Slow away.

ARONOV (V Colgan) - Rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

MINI MYSTIC (W Pinn) - Raced in restricted room passing the 1100 metres. Crowded passing the 1050 metres.

KOOL CHOUXZ (J Fillmore) - Steadied to avoid heels near the 1150 metres.

JUST KATE (T Thornton) - Checked passing the 1050 metres when MINI MYSTIC was forced inwards by ARONOV which was dictated in by SO CHARMING which shifted in. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

V Colgan (ARONOV) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 1150 metres when not sufficiently clear of KOOL CHOUXZ which had to be steadied.

J Fillmore (KOOL CHOUXZ) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

B Rogerson (SO CHARMING) - Assisted by employer G Rogerson defended a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount SO CHARMING to shift in near the 1050 metres when not sufficiently clear of ARONOV which was dictated in crowding MINI MYSTIC onto JUST KATE which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the charge.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 metres)

FOUR QUEENS (M McNab) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

ZOUPERB (L Innes) - Began awkwardly.

PLAY A PART (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of ARABIA which shifted in passing the 1350 metres. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.

ARABIA (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

GITCHE GUMEE (O Bosson) - Had to be steadied off heels passing the 1200 metres.

K Asano (NIGHT VISION) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of GITCHE GUMEE which had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres.

Race 5 ARTHUR ELGIES BIG DAY OUT (1600 metres)

NOTHINSWEETABOUTME (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

FORT WILLIAM (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

FORTUNE WINGS (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

QUEEN SUGAR (S Weatherley) - Restrained from its wide barrier.

EMBER ATTACK (S McKay) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of FLAG HUNTER which was forced inwards by ALWAYS MORE passing the 150 metres. M Hashizume was advised to exercise care.

Race 6

BOYD MITCHELL MEMORIAL (1600 metres)

CELEBRE (C Grylls) - Had to steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of RED HUSSAR passing the 350 metres then had to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

RHAEGAR (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a postrace veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 THE GOOD LOCAL PYES PA (1400 metres)

EL NYMPH (D Danis) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SPEECHMAKER (E McCall) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PROSPEROUS (C Grylls) - Had to steady after improving onto heels approaching the 200 metres.

AWARENESS (M McNab) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

GINGER TOO (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

T Autridge (UP 'N' GONE) - Issued with a warning after UP 'N' GONE was presented to race with incorrect gear (blinkers instead of side winkers).

Race 8 MILLS REEF WINES (1400 metres)

SHEZAWINKLE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROCK HARD REX (D Danis) - Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground. Commenced to over-race passing the 1100 metres improving onto heels having to be firmly restrained.

EL BANDOLERO (O Bosson) - When questioned rider O Bosson explained that after beginning fairly, the gelding could not muster sufficient speed in the early stages and after drawing wide he elected to restrain the gelding to then obtain cover. Held up rounding the final bend then had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

ALAGANT ANGEL (W Pinn) - Lay out around the bend when placed under pressure and continued to do so in the final straight. When questioned regarding a perceived lack of vigor W Pinn explained that after travelling well in the early and middle stages the mare had commenced to hang rounding the final bend and he was unable to ride his mount out due to its hanging tendencies. W Pinn's explanation was noted on this occasion. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any significant abnormality other than a laceration to the tongue.

D Danis (ROCK HARD REX) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
