RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC NUTRITION (1200 Metres)

MISS SAILOR (F Lazet)- Reared at the start and lost ground. Jumped the crossing in the back straight. Checked near the 1000 metres when J Riddell (BELARDO BOY) angled his mount inwards when not clear of IVANKA (D Hirini) which was dictated inwards crowding MISS SAILOR. J Riddell defended a subsequent charge of careless riding. After

submissions the charge was found proved and J Riddell had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 11 April up to and including racing on Sunday, 18 April (5 national riding days) and in addition a fine of \$200 was imposed.

IVANKA (D Hirini) - Tightened near the 1000 metres.

HUNGRY (R Elliot) - Tightened at the start and got back.

BELARDO BOY (J Riddell) - Had to shift ground outwards near the 150 metres to improve.

THE STONEY ONE (J Parkes) – Held up rounding the home turn and early part of the home straight and was denied a narrow run near the 100 metres when in restricted room over the final stages.

Race 2 CHASE A FOX RACING SYNDICATE MAIDEN (1200 Metres)

COLLECTOR (S Collett) – Tightened at the start when there was movement from runners either side.

HESACITYBOY (W Pinn) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from runners either side.

RETZENA (A Mudhoo) - Raced greenly in the straight and shifted in and away from NO LIMITS near the 200 metres and bumped with WATTABREEZE.

NO LIMITS (J Parkes) – Shifted inwards over the final stages. J Parkes was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

WATTABREEZE (H Schofer) - Bumped 200 metres.

SPIRIT O'PHEE (L Hemi) - Tightened near the 1000 metres when POROTENE CRUZA (C Johnson) shifted in when not fully clear. Stewards took into account some outward movement of runners to the inside nevertheless, C Johnson was issued with a warning.

K Hercock (ROADHOUSE) - Spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES (1200 Metres)

TRENDY BELT (T Taiaroa) – Made the first bend awkwardly when racing greenly. Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres hampering MI GRACIE.

MI GRACIE (C Grylls) - Hampered 200 metres.

CHIKIRA LASS (W Pinn) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 4 LISA LATTA RACING STABLES MAIDEN (1350 Metres)

SORTED (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly when in front in the early and middle stages.

CHEROKEE ANGEL (S Weatherley) Raced wide without cover throughout.

ADDICTED TO YOU (B Rogerson) - Shifted out abruptly at the start.

ONE TO DIE FOR (L Allpress) – Slow away.

ERNA (H Schofer) - Shifted out at the start dictating RONIN PR outwards into the line of HEY which was bumped and got back.

KEW PLAYER (S Collett) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages and had to be steadied of heels for some distance.

ISPYWITHMYLITTLEEYE (L Hemi) - Denied a run near the 100 metres when ONE TO DIE FOR shifted in.

Race 5 KEVIN MYERS STABLES MAIDEN (1350 Metres)

FOREVER WONDERING (M Hudson) – Slow away. Improved rapidly up on to heels near the 800 metres and when being steadied went back onto BLUE CHOUX.

SPACEK (S Waverley) - Slow away

BLUE CHOUX (M Singh) – Slow away, then raced fiercely in the back straight and had to be steadied abruptly for some distance.

M Singh (BLUE CHOUX) - Issued with a warning for the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 6 BERNIE GUDSELL'S 90TH BIRTHDAY MAIDEN (1350 Metres)

WINNIE ROSE (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin losing several lengths. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the filly's barrier manners. Held up for a short distance near the 350 metres.

NINJA TURTLE (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly and shifted in at the start. Hampered near the 1000 metres when HYDRO DARCI (S Collett) shifted in. S Collect was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

COURT A WHISPER (L Hemi) - When questioned into the disappointing run, L Hemi advised the gelding had a breathing issue. Connections confirmed that COURT A WHISPER has been retired.

Race 7 RATHBONE RACING STABLES (1350 Metres)

ROCKONEVE (S Macnab) – Tightened at the start and got back.

SUMMER MONSOON (J Parkes) – At the request of connections SUMMER MONSOON underwent a veterinary inspection post-race after returning to the enclosure making a respiratory noise. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a poor recovery rate consistent with being dehydrated.

Race 8 TINA EGAN RACING MAIDEN (1600 Metres)

TARTAN FIELD (D Bradley) - Slow away.

A Mudhoo (DOTHRAKI) was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master, particularly over the early stages, after he angled his mount out abruptly near the 1400 metres when improving rapidly onto the heels of a runner ahead. DOTHRAKI then raced three wide without cover for the remainder.

JOKERMAN (J Riddell) - Held up near the 400 metres and denied a run for some distance near the 350 metres, gaining clear running over the final 150 metres.

SIR CALEB (S Collett) - When questioned into the run of SIR CALEB rider S Collett advised that after leading and being taken on near the 800 metres, the gelding had little left at the finish.

Race 9 ROCHELLE LOCKETT RACING STABLES (1600 Metres)

SCUTAR (K Hercock) - Over-raced into the first bend. Held up briefly near the 400 metres.

SOUTHERN COOL (F Lazet) - Slow away.

JESSIE'S ROCK (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

MATT CAIN (W Pinn) - Raced keenly into the first bend.

GEEZAS GEORGE (M Hudson) - Denied a run near the 350 metres and held up for some distance prior to gaining clear running near the 150 metres.

PETE (L Allpress) – When questioned into the run of PETE which finished back, L Allpress had no excuse and advised the gelding was disappointing.

Race 10IG & RJ HACKETT FARRIER AND RACING MAIDEN (2050 Metres)DUELLED WHO (S Macnab) - Slow away.

EZDARA (R Elliot) – Had to be steadied near the winning post on the first occasion when I'M CHUCK (K Hercock) shifted in. K Hercock was advised to exercise more care.

IRISH TRIX (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout and lay in near the 1000 metres bumping with SWING THE TIDE (L Allpress).

SWING THE TIDE (L Allpress) – Bumped 1000 metres.

MILK POWER (W Pinn) – Bumped near the 350 metres when RED 'N' SURF improved to its inside.
