RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LAWNMASTER 3YO 1400 (1400 Metres)
SUMI (S Collett) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages and had to be steadied off heels near the 600 metres.	

<p>D Bradley (MIDNIGHT SWEY) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift in near the 250 metres, dictating ARJAYBEE into the line GURTLYN which was hampered.</p> <p>GURTLYN (A Mudhoo) – Hampered 250 metres.</p>	
Race 2	HUMPHRIES CONSTRUCTION 1200 (1200 Metres)
<p>LIFFEY (D Hirini) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Held up in the home straight and hampered when denied a run near the 200 metres. Further hampered when HYDROEXPRESS shifted out.</p> <p>GOT THE CALL (A Mudhoo) - Raced four wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HYDROEXPRESS (M Hudson) – Held up until near the 250 metres prior to being angled out into clear running and in doing so hampered LIFFEY. M Hudson was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>UNCLE TERRY (H Schofer) – Finished well back. When questioned H Schofer was of the opinion the gelding would be better suited to more rain-affected going.</p>	
Race 3	COURTESY FORD 1400 (1400 Metres)
<p>KICK START (S Collett) – Slow to begin (5L). G Vile was advised that a warning has been placed against the barrier manners of KICK START.</p> <p>JEWEL OF PATCH (H Schofer) – Slow away.</p> <p>MEHRTENS (A Mudhoo) - Held up early in the home straight prior to gaining clear running near the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	PLACEMAKERS 1550 (1550 Metres)
<p>SHEZABELTER (C Dell) – Slow away.</p> <p>ALMERAKI (K Asano) - Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>BEADMAN (H Schofer) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FLORENCE O'REILLY (M Singh) – Raced keenly in the back straight. Held up rounding the home turn.</p> <p>EXOTIC PEARL (W Pinn) – W Pinn was questioned into his apparent lack of vigour in the home straight. W Pinn advised that his mount was fractious prior to and in the gates and had crushed his foot against the side of the gate immediately prior to jumping away which had caused him discomfort for the duration of the event. W Pinn was attended to by paramedics and cleared to fulfil his remaining engagements.</p>	
Race 5	FASTTRACK INSURANCE \$5K (1550 Metres)
<p>BIG MIKE (H Schofer) – Steadied near the 50 metres.</p> <p>CREDIT MANAGER (T Taiaroa) – T Taiaroa was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master and issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift in near the finish dictating HYPNOS into the line of BIG MIKE, which had to be steadied. T Taiaroa was advised she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.</p> <p>REMINGTON (D Johnson) – When questioned rider D Johnson advised the gelding was outpaced in the early stages but had run on well.</p>	
Race 6	WAKA PROPERTY, BUILDING & RENOVATIONS 2200 (2200 Metres)

TAVIRA (M Hudson) – Slow to begin.

ZAC BROWN (S Macnab) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

C Grylls (AWESOME AL) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount out when improving near the 800 metres forcing MOZZIE out over extra ground and buffeting that runner for several strides. C Grylls had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 17 April up to and including racing on Wednesday, 22 April (3 national riding days). In addition a fine of \$250 was imposed.

Race 7	CAFÉ CUBA 2100 (2100 Metres)

FLYING MEG (C Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MISTER GERONIMO (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Held up for some distance near the 200 metres, having to be angled wide to improve inside the 100 metres.

LA STRATA (T Yanagida) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MAGIC IVAN (W Pinn) – Raced wide without cover from the 1400 metres when racing keenly.

Race 8	JAPAC HOMES MANAWATU BREEDERS STAKES (Group III) (2000 Metres)

ROSE OF DELGATIE (L Allpress) – Slow away.

BELLE PLAISIR (S Collett) – Had to steady near the 800 metres when MOHAKA (D Bradley) shifted in when not fully clear. After questioning riders, D Bradley was issued with a warning.

GRAND BOUQUET (V Colgan) - Held up for a short distance entering the home straight then had to be angled wide to improve.

IMELDA MARY (R Elliot) - Commenced to give ground rounding the home turn. R Elliot could offer no excuse. A subsequent examination revealed the mare to be dehydrated and was given electrolytes by veterinary staff.

NOT SANTA (W Pinn) - Finished some distance last. When questioned W Pinn advised the mare had over-raced throughout and had little left at the finish.

PLATINUM RAPPER (K Asano) - Lost the near side hind plate during the running.

Race 9	TUI BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 1400 (1400 Metres)

POWER 'N'PASSION (C Johnson) - Held up for some distance early in the home straight, gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

BRADMAN (D Johnson) – Commenced to hang outwards in the back straight then continued to hang for the remainder of the race, proving a difficult ride. Slipped over on returning to the enclosure, with the riding being uninjured. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed BRADMAN to be in an agitated state with a small cut to the hind leg. Trainer R Bergerson advised stewards that he would spell the gelding and alter its gear including the removal of blinkers prior to its next start.

SHOWBOURNE (W Pinn) – Taken wide near the 350 metres by BRADMAN which was hanging out.
