# Race 1 HES EARTHMOVING MAIDEN 1600 (1600 METRES)

VISHAKHA (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

**DOTHRAKI** (S O'Malley) - Slow away. When questioned regarding the improved performance rider advised that the gelding had disappointed in its first two starts proving difficult to control when racing in the open, but in today's race which was run at a good tempo the gelding had settled well when he had been able to obtain cover adding that he had been confident of its chances.

CHASE (S Macnab) - Slow away.

KODAK (H Schofer) - Commenced to over-race near the 1400 metres, continuing to do so through the middle stages.

PIN UP BOY (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover.

**DO THE MATHS** (D Bradley) - Made the first turn near the 1300 metres awkwardly when over-racing and shifted outwards.

**GOLD WINNER** (McNab) - Steadied when crowded near the 1300 metres after DO THE MATHS shifted outwards. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the gelding had been disappointing.

**LARNI MAE** (A Goindasamy) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

S O'MALLEY (Dothraki) - Spoken to regarding his whip use, with his arm being raised above shoulder height.

**S MACNAB** (Chase) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

#### Race 2 CIVIL CONTRACTORS HAWKE'S BAY/EAST COAST MILE (1600 METRES)

**CONTRIBUTE** (S McKay) - Slow away.

**SUNBURST** (L Allpress) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Briefly steadied near the 300 metres.

SHADY GREY (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

**MANDALORIAN** (A Goindasamy) - Made the bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly when over-racing, steadied to avoid the heels of SCUTAR which shifted inwards near the 1100 metres. K Hercock was advised to exercise more care. Lay in when continuing to over-race crowding FEELIN' FANCY which had to be steadied near the 1050 metres. Taking into account his mounts racing manners A Goindasamy was advised to exercise more care.

**FEELIN' FANCY** (J Parkes) - Steadied when crowded near the 1050 metres, held up rounding the final turn having to shift ground inwards near the 300 metres inconveniencing SUNBURST which had to be briefly steadied.

**COLYTON SKY** (D Bradley) - Raced wide without cover, steadied when weakening in the final straight near the 350 metres when placed in restricted room to the outside of CONTRIBUTE which shifted outwards to obtain clear running. S McKay was advised to exercise care.

ASK PA (L Hemi) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

#### Race 3 GROCHEM 2YO (1300 METRES)

**DIVINE SAVA** (A Goindasamy) - Shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering ROC DANCER, SLEEPY JEAN, and FINAL IMPACT, made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly.

**ROC DANCER** (D Bradley) - Hampered start losing ground.

**SLEEPY JEAN** (S Macnab) - Hampered start losing ground.

**FINAL IMPACT** (S McKay) - Hampered start losing ground, checked when crowded between SILKY RED FOX (M Singh) and DIVINE SAVA (A Goindasamy) which both shifted ground near the 100 metres. M Singh was issued with a warning and A Goindasamy advised to exercise more care.

**M SINGH** (SILKY RED FOX) - Issued with a warning after he permitted his mount to shift outwards near the 100 metres.

KORUBELA MISS (L Hemi) - Slow away.

**SILKY RED FOX** (M Singh) - Jumped away awkwardly.

THE PERFECT PINK (D Hirini) - Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 800 metres.

**SPECTRIER** (J Parkes) - Raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding was still immature and he was of the understanding that it was now to be spelled.

RANGI TOA (M McNab) - Lay in under pressure making contact with IVANKA near the 100 metres.

IVANKA (K Hercock) - Contacted near the 100 metres.

# Race 4 FARMLANDS 1200 (1200 METRES)

LINCOLN'S KRUZ (L Allpress) - Slow away.

**SECRET SQUIRREL** (S O'Malley) - Slow away.

TRANSITORY (S Macnab) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**DAWN PARADE** (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover, made the final bend awkwardly being inclined to lay out. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that despite being caught wide the gelding had nevertheless been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

**ROC CHA** (L Hemi) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres, then over-raced for a distance.

## Race 5 POWER TURF SPRINT (1200 METRES)

**MOTIVATION** (J Parkes) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**CASAQUINMAN** (K Hercock) – Slow away, steadied off heels rounding the final turn passing the 400 metres.

**WHAT A SMASHER** (S Macnab) - Over-raced when being restrained after being placed in restricted room to the inside of ROCK 'N' AFFAIR passing the 900 metres. T Taiaroa was advised to exercise greater care.

**SPYDAPUS** (F Lazet) - Came under pressure passing the 600 metres and commenced to give ground quickly prior to entering the final straight. A post-race veterinary inspection showed the mare to have a slow rate of recovery. Trainer

V Wilson was spoken to and advised that the mare would be expected to be more competitive in any future racing, with a warning being placed against the mare.

**ROMANTIC LADY** (L Allpress) – Made contact with ROCH 'N' HORSE when attempting to obtain clear running near the 300 metres then continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the straight.

ROCH 'N' HORSE (A Goindasamy) - Contacted near the 300 metres.

# Race 6 VINTECH PACIFIC POVERTY BAY CUP (2500 METRES)

MONDARANI (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

**BOTTI** (S O'Malley) - Slow away.

PLUSHENKO (L Allpress) - Slow away.

**VITTACHI** (S McKay) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had never travelled well and, in his opinion, may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

H SCHOFER (THAT'S INCRANIBULL) – lissued with a warning regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

J PARKES (TORQUE TIME) – Issued with a warning regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

# Race 7 POWER FARMING HAWKE'S BAY CUP (2200 METRES)

**HUNTA PENCE** (D Bradley) - Slow away, commenced to over-race shortly after the start continuing to do so into the middle stages.

**SKYPHYTA** (T Taiaroa) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

**SINARAHMA** (J Parkes) – Raced three wide from the 1200 metres. Trainer A Sharrock advised that the mare would now be sent for a spell.

S O'MALLEY (ON THE ROCKS) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

**S MCKAY** (RANGITATA) – Issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

## Race 8 BAYLEYS RURAL 1400 (1400 METRES)

**LANGKAWI** (S McKay) - Slow away, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the run down the back straight, steadied off heels near the 800 metres.

**PABLO ESK** (F Lazet) – Inclined to over-race in the middle stages, severely checked near the 1000 metres, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight until inside the final 100 metres.

**LILHOOVESGOTMOVES** (M Singh) - Slow away, shifted inwards under pressure in the home straight crowding JEWEL OF PATCH near the 150 metres then again inconveniencing that runner near the 100 metres. M Singh was advised to exercise more care.

**TONADILAS** (D Hirini) - Restrained shortly after the start after jumping from the outside barrier.

**H SCHOFER** (LINCOLN HILLS) – Issued with a warning when after riding her mount forward to lead, she then commenced to heavily restrain LINCOLN HILLS passing the 1100 metres going back onto JEWEL OF PATCH which was hampered. Also hampered as a result was VIRTUOSO LAD.

VIRTUOSO LAD (A Goindasamy) - Hampered passing the 1100 metres.

**SECRET AMOUR** (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout, lay in under pressure in the straight inconveniencing GO JAMES near the 200 metres.

**GO JAMES** (T Taiaroa) – Raced three wide without cover, inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

**JEWEL OF PATCH** (S Macnab) – Hampered passing the 1100 metres, held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight, crowded near the 150 metres then further inconvenienced near 100 metres.

**A GOINDASAMY** (VIRTUOSO LAD) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PABLO ESK which was severely checked near the 1000 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Monday 26 April until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 8 May, 8 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.
