## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>POUATU MANUKA 2100 (2100 Metres)</b>
<b>ALARAMA</b> (M Roustoby) - Began awkwardly and got back.	
<b>IRISH FLARE</b> (E Farr) - Raced wide into the first bend prior to being taken forward going into the back straight.	
<b>I'M CHUCK</b> (B Donoghue) - Dictated wide on the home turn when COCONUT improved to its inside and when being straightened shifted in abruptly and bumped COCONUT.	

<b>COCONUT</b> (M Cropp) – Bumped near 300 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>FARMLANDS PAHIATUA 1600 (1600 Metres)</b>
<b>WINE N'DINE</b> (E Farr) – Slow away.	
<b>LADY CALYPSO</b> (R Elliot) – Wide throughout.	
<b>BEAU GESTE</b> (K Macnab) - Held up for a short distance prior to the home turn.	
<b>SUPER SID</b> (S Phelan) - When questioned into the run of SUPER SID, which led throughout but failed to finish the race off, rider was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to being ridden with cover.	
<b>NO CHANGE</b> (L Douglas) - Held up for a short distance behind the weakening SUPER SID approaching the 100 metres.	
<b>NO TIP</b> (B Donoghue) - Eased down in the home straight. Saddle slipped forward on NO TIP in the run along the back straight placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>3 RUN GUNS 1600 (1600 Metres)</b>
<b>LINCOLN LANE</b> (K Asano) – Late scratching at 12.50pm on veterinary advice, being lame in left hind following its preliminary.	
<b>PINSK</b> (D Montes de Oca) – Slow away.	
<b>ALJAY</b> (F Lazet) – Slow away. Shifted in abruptly near the 100 metres hampering MARKSMAN and RAUCOUS, prior to being straightened. F Lazet was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master and advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion. F Lazet was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).	
<b>RED SUNDAY</b> (D Hirini) – Slow away.	
<b>MARKSMAN</b> (C Dell) – Hampered 100 metres.	
<b>RAUCOUS</b> (K Hercock) – Hampered 100 metres.	
<b>TIGERBEE</b> {J Fawcett) – Hung outwards from the 1000 metres.	
<b>RONIN POROTENE</b> (S Macnab) – Returned to the enclosure with a small amount of blood in its mouth.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BREMNER AG 1600 (1600 Metres)</b>
<b>SPACEK</b> (M Singh) - Got back at the start.	
<b>MONITOR</b> (F Lazet) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Tightened shortly after the start when SHOCKING BILL (D Montes de Oca) shifted in when not clear. D Montes de Oca was advised to exercise greater care. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight. F Lazet was reminded of her obligation to straighten her mount.	
<b>ALMERAKI</b> (K Asano) - Steadied for some distance when the pace ahead eased rounding the first turn.	
<b>IT'S NOT THAT EASY</b> (H Schofer) – Raced fiercely going into the back straight and had to be steadied off heels for some distance passing the 800 metres.	

**A Mudhoo** (JUSTASKPERCY) - Was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Master and advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion after he allowed his mount to shift out some distance in the home straight.

**S O'Malley** (MR FLYNN) - Reminded of his obligation with regard to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

**J Fawcett** (LIZZED) - Reminded of her obligation with regard to her whip use on a runner out of contention.

**Race 5** | **THE SALAD BOWL 1200 (1200 Metres)**

**HILLCREST ROAD** (L Allpress) – Saddle slipped near the 800 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. Eased down in the home straight.

**DENY** (M Singh) - Over-reacted when being steadied to trail the leader near the 800 metres and then continued to over-race for some distance.

**SUBTLE POINT** (T Taiaroa) – Raced greenly throughout. Connections were advised a warning has been placed against the gelding's racing manners.

**Race 6** | **PAEWAI MULLINS/TARARUA HELIWORK 1200 (1200 Metres)**

**CHIKIRA LASS** (K Asano) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start after being kicked behind the barrier.

**BRADMAN** (J Parkes) – Got its head up for some distance near the 400 metres when improving onto heels then shifted out abruptly and raced greenly for the remainder. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the racing manners of BRADMAN. Trainer R Bergerson confirmed the gelding will be spelled.

**BEHIND BLUE EYES** (H Schofer) – Finished mid-field. When questioned H Schofer was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to a longer distance.

**Race 7** | **DANNEVIRKE DAIRY SUPPLIES 1400 (1400 Metres)**

**DRAW CARD** (D Bradley) - Shifted out on jumping away dictating WATTABREEZE outwards onto JUST BEN, which was buffeted for some distance.

**JUST BEN** – (J Parkes) – Buffeted at start.

**WIND IN MY WINGS** (K Hercock) - Wide without cover throughout.

**DENNISMAC** (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**KICK ON** (S Macnab) –Briefly held up and had to shift outwards to avoid the heels of the rapidly tiring DRAW CARD approaching the home turn.

**WATTABREEZE** (H Schofer) – Held up and unable to improve rounding the home turn and when seeking a run near the home straight entrance had to be angled inwards to avoid the tiring DRAW CARD. Held up briefly near the 200 metres. When questioned H Schofer advised that after being held up for some distance the filly took some time to work into the race.

**LILLY LAGUNA** (J Fawcett) – Held up in the early part of the home straight gaining clear running near the 150 metres.

**Race 8** | **TARARUA RURAL PROPERTY BROKERS 1400 (1400 Metres)**

**PARTY AT PAROA** (M Singh) - Began awkwardly. Finished some distance last. Rider had no excuse.

**JEWEL OF PATCH** (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.

**SANIBEL** (K Hercock) – Commenced to over-race when the pace eased near the end of the back straight and so was shifted out to avoid heels.

**SAVANAH BELLE** (L Allpress) - Steadied for some distance near the 800 metres when the pace eased. Briefly held up on straightening.

**BELLISSIMO** (J Fawcett) – Buffeted for a short distance when weakening prior to the 200 metres.

**HOROPITO** (S Macnab) - Held up when in restricted room from near the 200 metres until gaining clear running inside the 100 metres.

**Race 9**

**NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 Metres)**

**WHO'S ALICE** (F Lazet) – Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection at the barrier after contacting a fence in the enclosure. Dictated over extra ground 400 metres.

**POLIZZI** (K Hercock) – Began very awkwardly and was reluctant to lengthen into stride losing ground. When questioned, Trainer K Hercock advised that the mare may have not been suited to the application of a noseband and would adjust the gear prior to its next start. Stewards placed a warning against the racing manners of POLIZZI.

**ENCHANTING** (L Allpress) – The tongue-tie slipped through the filly's mouth during the running and eventually became dislodged. L Allpress reported that due to the tongue-tie being displaced she was unable to control the filly which over-raced and hung round the home turn and final straight. Eased down final stages.

**FLAUTINO** (D Hirini) - Had to shift out abruptly to avoid the heels of ENCHANTING near the 400 metres and in doing so dictated WHO'S ALICE out over extra ground.

**JENEVER** (K Asano) - When questioned regarding the performance of JENEVER, rider advised the mare may be better suited to more rain-affected footing.
