# **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	FASTTRACK \$5K MAIDEN (1400m)			
STAN WITH ME (R Elliot) – Fractious in the barrier prior to the start, began awkwardly. Lost the left hind plate during the				
running.				
<b>SWEET STORM</b> (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, held up passing the 100 metres and had to be steadied in the shadows of the post when crowded for room.				
	ed with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in under pressure over the concluding stages crowding the shadows of the post.			

**KERALA** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection and declared a bleeder after returning to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. The connections were advised that the gelding is stood down from racing for the mandatory three month period with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next. Trainer D Crozier advised it was his intention to retire the gelding as a racing proposition from his stable.

**HOMBRE** (G Jogoo) – Blundered on jumping away and slow to begin.

BLACKJAKK (V Colgan)- Blundered on jumping away losing some ground.

**SPECK SAVERS** (J Laking) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Suffered a fractured left front fetlock when being eased down after the winning post. The horse ambulance was deployed with the gelding being humanely euthanased due to the injury.

**CHAMPERS** (S Macnab) – Raced wide throughout.

**FLASH ASH VEGAS** (C Barnes) – Had to be steadied near the 1000 metres when HOMBRE (G Jogoo) shifted ground inwards when not fully clear. G Jogoo was advised to exercise care.

Race 2 FASTTRACK \$5K MAIDEN (1400m)

**AREYOUOKAY** (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly losing ground, over raced near the 700 metres having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels.

**CRIMSON STAR** (C Barnes) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.

**WILD LIKE** (M Gestain) – Crowded on jumping losing ground, raced three wide without cover throughout and over raced through the middle stages.

LACHIE'S MATE (K Kwo) – Got its head up when being steadied through the early stages.

**SWEET FIELDS** (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout, made contact with CAPITAL GAINS on two occasions early in the run home.

JACK KNOWS BEST (C Johnson) - Over raced through the middle stages.

**MADAME CHERIE** (V Colgan) – Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of the runner in front when racing keenly passing the 700 metres.

CAPITAL GAINS (S Macnab) - Made contact with SWEET FIELDS on two occasions early in the run home.

**CAPALDI** (R Elliot) – Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages having to be steadied by its rider.

Race 3FIXINE FOR EQUINE RATING 65 (1800m)COLORADO MISS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

**BETATHEDEVILUNO** (S Macnab) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.

JOJO ROXX (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

**WESTERN GIRL** (C Johnson) – Over raced through the early to middle stages.

VICENZA (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**POLAR NIGHT** (G Jogoo) – Held up early in the run home.

MISS TAVI (K Williams) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

K Chowdhoory (THE EMPORESS) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**S Wynne** (DEELS DONE) was spoken to advisedly regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**KUSUDA** (S Weatherley) – When asked to comment on the performance today, rider was of the opinion the mare would appreciate tracks with more moisture.

**DEELS DONE** (S Wynne) – Rider reported that although she had been disappointed with the effort, the gelding was looking for more distance.

#### Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1000m)

STYLISH DESIGN (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

**MACKENZIE LAD** (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly, over raced in the middle stages, placed in restricted room and crowded passing the 900 metres, raced greenly throughout the run home.

**CLASSIC DIVA** (L Callaway) – Crowded shortly after the start, placed in restricted room and crowded passing the 900 metres.

**CHOISIA PRINCE** (V Colgan) – Over raced and raced greenly in the early to middle stages.

**BAD FLAMINGO** (K Kwo) – Crowded having to steady passing the 900 metres when runners to the inside were placed in restricted room by CHOISIA PRINCE which was racing greenly at this stage. Also contributing was some inwards movement from ROUSSANNE.

**ART DE TRIOMPHE** (K Williams) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

## Race 5 ELLIS STOKES TRUST OPEN SPRINT (1200m)

**JOHNNY JONES** (W Pinn) – Raced wide throughout, crowded and had to be steadied near the 250 metres when placed in restricted room between SCARFI and KHIMAR WAR which both shifted ground.

**MASQUE** (B Rogerson) – Held up early in the run home.

**MUMMS JEWEL** (B Murray) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 250 metres when MIDNIGHT RUNNER was taken in by SCARFI which when laying in shifted in before being straightened by its rider.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (J Lowry) - Crowded passing the 250 metres, held up until inside the 150 metres.

SCARFI (K Williams) – Held up until inside the 200 metres.

**CHOSEN PEAK** (S Macnab) – Had to be steadied near the 100 metres when TELLYAWHAT (A Balloo) shifted inwards. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the mare would be suited to tracks with more moisture.

**K Chowdhoory** (ENZO'S LAD) admitted a charge of excessive whip use after striking his mount on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

**A Balloo** (TELLYAWHAT) was issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift inwards passing the 100 metres resulting in CHOSEN PEAK having to be steadied.

#### Race 6 GAVELHOUSE.COM RATING 74 & JUMPERS (2500m)

AQUATTACK (A Balloo) – Slow to begin.

LETSBRINGITON (G Jogoo) – Bounded at the start losing ground, held up in the early stages of the run home.

**POINT SCORE** (C Johnson) – Had to be steadied when over racing near the 2300 metres when TAKE THAT (L Hemi) shifted inwards. L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care.

KHAFEEF (K Asano) – Raced wide from the 1000 metres when improving.

HOT TAP (T Moseley) – Had to be restrained to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres when the pace of the race eased, raced

ungenerously near the 600 metres.

**ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN** (K Chowdhoory) – Had trouble obtaining clear running throughout the run home having to be steadied near the 150 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SITARIST.

**DEN BOSCH** (S Weatherley) – Rider reported the gelding made abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be a bleeder, with the connections advised it would be stood down from racing for the mandatory period with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

#### Race 7 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSTEP STAKES (2000m)

**YOLO** (R Elliot) – Crowded on jumping. Rider reported the filly would be better suited to tracks with more moisture.

**TOWN CRYER** (W Pinn) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding YOLO, over raced when leading in the early to middle stages.

EXQUISITE PEARL (L Hemi) – Raced greenly in the run home and was inclined to shift ground throughout the straight.

LARPOWER (K Kwo) – Rider accidentally dropped his whip passing the 350 metres.

K Asano (ATISHU) was spoken to advisedly regarding his victory salute on the finishing line.

### Race 8 SPEIGHT'S RATING 65 (1400m)

O'GUY (K Asano) – Slow to begin, had to be heavily restrained passing the 900 metres when over racing.

CALL ME COQUETTA (W Pinn) – Blundered leaving the barriers.

**SOMBRA DEAMOR** (R Beeharry) – Over raced in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels passing the 1100 metres.

**CURVE** (K Chowdhoory) – Over raced in the early stages.

STREET FIGHTIN MAN (A Balloo) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

**O'HE CAN** (B Murray) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

**DIRECT FLIGHT** (C Barnes) – Had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home.

UCALLEDIT (R Elliot) – Shifted in passing the 350 metres making contact with JIN LU which became briefly unbalanced.

**SHOWBOURNE** (L Hemi) – Placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres when STREET FIGHTIN MAN lay inwards before being straightened, steadied in the shadows of the post when SANTISSIMA (S Wynne) shifted out under pressure. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care.

SANTISSIMA (S Wynne) – Shifted out under pressure in the concluding stages.

**ISLAND HOP** (S Weatherley) – When asked to comment on performance, rider advised that the gelding had been slightly disappointing but he believed carrying top weight had been detrimental to today's performance.

Following the running of this race apprentice W Pinn was examined by St John Paramedics after collapsing in the jockey room suffering from heat exhaustion and dehydration. W Pinn was advised that a medical clearance is required prior to racing next.

#### Race 9 COCA-COLA CANTERBURY GOLD CUP (2000m)

WILLIAM WALLACE (S Macnab) – Slow to begin, had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

**CAMINO ROCOSO** (G Jogoo) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.

RITANI (C Johnson) - Raced wide in the early stages

BRONTE BEACH (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**BENEFICIAL** (D Bothamley) – Got its head up when over racing having to be restrained passing the 1500 metres, continued to race keenly through the middle stages.

**SHADOWS CAST** (S Wynne) – When questioned about performance, rider advised that the gelding was not suited to the tempo of today's race.

#### Race 10 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 74 (1600m)

EXCHANGE (J Lowry) – Very slow to begin (4L).

**FRANKIE THE FOX** (R Mudhoo) – Crowded shortly after the start, held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

**BLAIR FLIGHT** (K Kwo) – Over raced and raced wide in the early stages and continued to over race in the middle stages with the rider reporting the saddle had moved forward placing him at a disadvantage.

**CLOONEY** (C Barnes) – Over raced passing the 1400 metres shifting out to avoid heels and was then obliged to race three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Raced wide without cover throughout.

ITSONLYMONEY (S Wynne) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

**RECOMMENDED FLIGHT** (K Williams) – Raced keenly when leading and continued to race keenly throughout the middle stages when challenged by BLAIR FLIGHT which improved to sit outside that runner.

**RIVALDO** (D Bothamley) – Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres, again hampered having to steady passing the 175 metres and continued to be held up until inside the final 150 metres.

**SERIOUSLY** (T Moseley) – Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.
