#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

### Race 1 VICKI WILSON RACING STABLES 1400 MAIDEN

JUST BEN (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

**RELISH** (T Taiaroa) – Slow to begin.

**DOLLARBEEL** (K Hercock) – Began awkwardly then steadied. Crowded and checked 1100 metres losing ground.

**CORRETTO** (H Schofer) – Raced ungenerously 900 metres when in restricted room.

**EXTORTION** (T Yanagida) – Raced three wide without cover. Contacted 300 metres becoming briefly unbalanced, and again near the 250 metres by FELICIENNE which was shifting out when looking to obtain clear running. J Parkes was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

**FELICIENNE** (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Shifted out to obtain clear running 300 metres making contact with EXTORTION which became briefly unbalanced, again making brief contact with EXTORTION near the 250 metres. Raced in restricted room 50 metres when briefly contacted by EXTORTION which lay in under pressure and again passing the winning post. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

L Hemi (SPIRIT OF KAHA) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted SPIRIT OF KAHA to shift in near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of DOLLARBEEL which was crowded and checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Hemi's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 01 May up to and including racing on Saturday 08 May, 3 national riding days and in addition imposed a fine of \$250.

Following the race connections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed horse **FELICIENNE** viewed Stewards footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest.

## Race 2 SNEAKING TO WIN STANDING AT TE AUTE STUD 2YO (1200 metres)

**EAGLE TARZAN** (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.

**ROCA FUNDEEDA** (M Singh) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

LADY HYSTERIA (L Hemi) – Contacted leaving the barriers becoming briefly unbalanced.

**REGAL LION** (D Hirini) – Steadied from its wider barrier draw.

**MEDAL** (J Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

**RACCOURCI** (S Macnab) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**ALL IN ECHOES** (T Yanagida) – Raced in restricted room 900 metres.

**FIVE ROAD JUNCTION** (M Hudson) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres to the outside of FLYING AMELIA which was laying out then crowded and further steadied by IVANKA which then shifted in.

**FLYING AMELIA** (T Taiaroa) – Commenced to hang out soon after leaving the barrier. Crowded and steadied approaching the 900 metres when IVANKA shifted in.

**LADY PRISTINA** (W Pinn) – Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 600 metres to the inside of RACCOURCI which commenced to weaken with LADY PRISTINA then being held up for a distance until passing the 400 metres. Improved near heels approaching the 100 metres and steadied.

**K Hercock** (IVANKA) – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount IVANKA to shift in near the 1000 metres when insufficiently clear of FIVE ROAD JUNCTION and FLYING AMELIA which were both crowded and steadied.

J Parkes (MEDAL) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

#### Race 3 TONY LYNDON FAREWELL 1600

BAYARMAA (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly. Had difficulty finding clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

**JOLENE** (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Had to shift out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

JUSTASKPERCY (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide in the early and middle stages.

**CORINNE** (S Macnab) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

MASAROVA (K Hercock) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting in passing the 300 metres.

**S Mcnab** (CORINNE) – Advised she must ensure she rides her mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

#### Race 4 LEE SOMERVELL RACING MILE (1600 metres)

**AKELA BELLE** (F Lazet) – Slow to begin becoming tailed off from the body of the field for the remainder of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Connections were advised that AKELA BELLE would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

**ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL** (M Hudson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

JESSIE'S ROCK (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**VOLITOVO** (S O'Malley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

FLICKERING SHADOW (W Pinn) – Steadied 1400 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

**MANDALORIAN** (T Yanagida) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 900 metres.

**ATOMIC KITTEN** (K Hercock) – Held up entering the straight before shifting out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

**RADEGAST** (J Parkes) – When questioned regarding the performance rider J Parkes could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Connections were advised that a suitable veterinary clearance would be required prior to trialling or racing again.

**RED JAKKAL** (C Dell) – Held up early in the final straight before shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

## Race 5 JOHN BARY RACING 1200

MONTANA MIST (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 900 metres when the pace steadied.

**LINCOLN'S KRUZ** (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Hampered when the pace steadied passing the 900 metres and then raced ungenerously for a distance when awkwardly placed near heels.

**CELTIC WONDER** (S Macnab) – Slow to begin.

SUPERDONNA (W Pinn) – Badly hampered 900 metres when the pace steadied abruptly.

**NO ROCK NO POP** (A Mudhoo) – Badly hampered 900 metres when the pace steadied abruptly. Crowded over the concluding stages.

MISCONDUCT (K Hercock) – Hampered 900 metres when the pace steadied.

**BUCKY** (S O'Malley) – Raced wide without cover for a majority of the race. Trainer J Bary reported that BUCKY had been coughing post-race and has undertaken to report to Stewards any findings of a veterinary examination on return to the stable.

**ANDUIN** (L Hemi) — Crowded over the concluding stages becoming unbalanced.

**HYDROEXPRESS** (M Hudson) – Shifted in abruptly under pressure over the concluding stages crowding NO ROCK NO POP and ANDUIN.

**L Hemi** (ANDUIN) – Admitted a breach in that she unreasonably reduced the pace of the race passing the 900 metres hampering SUPERDONNA who was following that runner and NO ROCK NO POP which was following SUPERDONNA. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Hemi's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 08 May up to and including racing on Thursday 13 May, 3 national riding days.

**M Hudson** (HYDROEXPRESS) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted HYDROEXPRESS to shift in over the concluding stages crowding ANDUIN and NO ROCK NO POP. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Hudson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 02 May up to and including racing on Wednesday 12 May, 5 national riding days and in addition imposed a fine of \$250

Following the race the connections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed **ANDUIN** and 3<sup>rd</sup>= placed **NO ROCK NO POP** lodged a protest against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed horse **HYDROEXPRESS** alleging interference in the final straight. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

#### Race 6 HAWKE'S BAY OWNERS & BREEDERS ASSOCIATION 1200

**HIGH ACHIEVER** (J Parkes) – Slow to begin.

KICK START (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin (3L). A warning was placed against the geldings barrier manners.

**TONADILLAS** (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**THE DOM** (L Hemi) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**CAN I GET AN AMEN** (H Schofer) – Improved onto heels passing the 200 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running.

## Race 7 TREMAINS STARTING GATES 1400

**RAPOSA RAPIDA** (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

**STUMPY** (T Taiaroa) – Steadied approaching the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed near heels. Raced wide without cover through the middle stages.

**HARTLEY** (A Mudhoo) – Made contact with the running rail near the 700 metres.

A Mudhoo (HARTLEY) - Issued with a warning for his whip use.

### Race 8 FASTTRACK \$5K OPEN (2200 metres)

**HUNTA PENCE** (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly losing ground then ridden urgently to recover improving onto the heels of JUNIOR which was shifting in with HUNTA PENCE then racing ungenerously for a distance. Apprentice rider T Taiaroa was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Shifted out to obtain clear running 200 metres.

MARIETTA LANE (W Pinn) – Shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier.

**STARRYBEEL** (T Yanagida) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

**CISJURANE** (S Macnab) – Raced ungenerously when steadied in the early stages.

**BEAUTY STAR** (L Hemi) – Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres by HUNTA PENCE which shifted out to obtain clear running.

## Race 9 PAM HOLDEN RACING MILE (1600 metres)

**ROLL THE GOLD** (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground then raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Became awkwardly placed near the heels of PABLO ESK passing the 400 metres which shifted out when briefly contacted by OUR MODENA which had improved into a run to its inside. As a result PABLO ESK then shifted out forcing BOBBY DEE onto ROLL THE GOLD which was crowded across the heels of UAREASTAR which shifted in slightly. Rider H Schofer was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

**BULLY BOY** (S O'Malley) – Began awkwardly. Held up entering the final straight then shifted when looking to obtain clear running.

**MAZZURO** (J Parkes) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground. Briefly hampered 350 metres.

JAMES BARRIE (T Yanagida) – Shifted out passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.
