RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | LEVIN COSSIE CLUB (2000 Metres)

BRUCIE (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly shifting out making firm contact with GO BOBBY.

GO BOBBY (L Satherley) – Buffeted at the start. Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the gelding failed to handle today’s track conditions.

GREYSTONE (C Jones) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RELDA (D Hirini) – Briefly held up when improving onto heels of a tiring runner passing the 400 metres.

KAHU ROCK (L Allpress) - Placed in restricted room by DUBAI’S MOKO (C O’Beirne), which lay in throughout the run home, resulting in KAHU ROCK being crowded and making contact with the running rail passing the 250 metres.

DUBAI'S MOKO (C O'Beirne) - Lay inwards throughout the run home, having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

L Kauri (CANDY CROSS) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 2 | **LEVIN TAB & SPORTS BAR (1100 Metres)**

CASAQUINMAN (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

LONDON EXPRESS (C Jones) – Got its head up when being restrained to take cover shortly after the start.

TORRE DEL GRECO (T Taiaroa) – Lost both front plates during the running.

J Parkes (DEERFIELD) – Reminded of his obligations regarding the use of his whip prior to 100 metres.

Race 3 | **FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400 (1400 Metres)**

STEELY ZEB (L Hemi) – Slow to begin.

MYSALLY (L Allpress) Crowded at the start losing ground.

MAEBHS RAZEEL (S Macnab) – Began awkwardly, raced wide and greenly in the early stages. Hampered 600 metres.

JAKK IRISH (C O'Beirne) - Lay in and away from IRONWOOD shortly after the start, hampering ALL THAT JAZZ, which had to steady. Rider reported mount better suited to firmer track

ALL THAT JAZZ (H Schofer) – Hampered shortly after the start. Over-raced in the run down the back straight and had to be steadied for some distance passing the 1000 metres.

IRISH PRAYER (D Hirini) - D Hirini was shown footage of her ride after shifting out near the 600 metres hampering MAEBHS RAZEEL.

Race 4 | **VALE PAUL PEARCE (1400 Metres)**

THE SEAGULL (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ESTAFANIA (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin.

JAKKANO (J Mudhoo) - Steadied shortly after the start, losing ground, when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of COOGA MOON.

SO CALL ME (S Macnab) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres.

Race 5 | **COURTESY FORD RYDER STAKES (Listed Race) (1200 Metres)**

IMA ROCA BEE (E Leighton) – Slow to begin.

BELLACONTTE (S Mabnab) – Slow to begin.

TUI ROCKS (L Allpress) – Got its head on a number of occasions when being steadied for a distance passing the 800 metres

BURGUNDY DANCER (J Fawcett) - Rider reported despite racing wide the gelding raced disappointingly.

CATSACHARMER (D Johnson) – When questioned, D Johnson advised CATSACHARMER raced lethargically throughout and in her opinion may be coming to the end of its preparation, which was confirmed by trainer A Sharrock who said the filly would now be given a break. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

FLASH MARY (L Satherley) – Steadied passing the 100 metres when crowded for room by YEABOI (H Schofer) which shifted in under pressure.

H Schofer (YEABOI) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in under pressure passing the 100 metres hampering FLASH MARY, which had to steady.

Race 6 | **RACING THIS TIME TV ON FACEBOOK (1200 Metres)**

MAGIC INCANTO (M Hudson) – Bounded and began very awkwardly, then slow to begin (5L). Connections were advised the mare is on a Barrier Manners warning.

MI CAROL (T Taiaroa) – Began awkwardly losing some ground.

BUTLER (H Schofer) – Hampered shortly after the start.

SEAAPRINCE (L Allpress) – Hampered shortly after the start. Over-raced in the back straight.

L Kauri (EAGLE COUNTY) - Was shown footage of his ride after he angled his mount out shortly after the start when not fully clear of SEAAPRINCE and BUTLER which were hampered.

H Schofer (BUTLER) – Spoken to regarding the use of her whip on a runner clearly winning.

Race 7 | **COURTESY FORD (1600 Metres)**

BELLISSIMO (J Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied and then held up for a distance passing the 200 metres when AKELA BELLA (L Hemi) shifted in under pressure. L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care.

MAUNA KEA (D Bradley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

KAARERAWAY (L Satherley) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

COLLINSTREET (C Jones) – Disappointed. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the gelding had failed to handle today's Heavy 11 track conditions.

Race 8 | **FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1600 (1600 Metres)**

BERRY THE CASH (J Fawcett) - Clipped a heel and lost some momentum shortly after the start when MONITOR shifted out abruptly.

MONITOR (D Hirini) - Shifted out abruptly at the start and over-raced in the early stages.

CHOLULA (F Lazet) – Improved up on to heels approaching the home turn, having to be steadied and angled inwards to improve. Lay in throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions and steadied near the finish when on heels.

ANTIPODES (L Allpress) – Had to steady at the top of the straight when attempting a narrow run simultaneously as HEY HEY HEY (E Leighton) was improving to its inside. Stewards took into account inward movement from THE BLIKSEM (K Hercock) when reviewing the incident. Nevertheless E Leighton was advised to exercise greater care

when shifting ground. Stewards also took into consideration outward movement from PLATINUM BORDEAUX. ANTIPODES continued to be held up and was unable to improve until inside the 200 metres.

MASSO (C Dell) – Briefly inconvenienced passing the 350 metres when BERRY THE CASH shifted out. Connections of the 3rd placed MASSO viewed footage of the final straight with regard to inference by the 2nd placed BERRY THE CASH, but elected not to proceed.
