Race 4 - NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m

MISS SWEET PEE (S Wynne) – Stable representative M Marshall advised that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however confirming upon return to Mr F Auret's stable MISS SWEET PEE will be sent for a spell.

Race 1	RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN (1800m)
<p>MAN OH MAN (J Laking) – Crowded on jumping losing ground.</p> <p>TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied to avoid heels approaching the 1600 metres, Raced wide in the early stages, raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>GROOVEYTOWN LAD (K Asano) – Got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1600 metres then having to be further restrained when MADAME CHERIE (S Wynne) shifted inwards going back onto TANTALEE which had to be steadied.</p> <p>S Wynne (MADAME CHERIE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards approaching the 1600 metres crowding GROOVEYTOWN LAD.</p> <p>NAMIBIA MISS (K Williams) – Steadied to avoid heels going into the bend near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>K Chowdhoo (ARROWTOWN) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	CIRCUS MAXIMUS @ WINDSOR PARK STUD RATING 65 (1600m)
<p>MISS CURIOUS (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Rider advised that the mare had hung inwards throughout the race.</p> <p>SHOWBOURNE (W Pinn) – Shifted outwards on jumping making contact with CHAMPERS which was forced onto DIRECT FLIGHT, raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>DIRECT FLIGHT (C Barnes) – Hampered leaving the barriers.</p> <p>CHAMPERS (S Macnab) – Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>JIN LU (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding his riding tactics, B Murray advised he had been wanting to ride the gelding with cover particularly taking into consideration its clear top weight but in the early stages he had been unwilling to take up a position behind HIGHLAND DANCER given that runner's recent form so had endeavoured to go forward with a view to taking up a position outside RUNNING MAN, but when that runner had come away from the running rail and other runners had kicked up to his inside he had been unable to get in and had been caught wide throughout.</p> <p>HIGHLAND DANCER (T Taiaroa) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>GURTLYN (L Allpress) – Had a tendency to over race when being restrained in the middle stages.</p>	
Race 3	ELLIE STOKES TRUST RATING 74 (1200m)
<p>FINAL SAVINGS (L Allpress) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CELINE (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>CAITLYN JAY (K Asano) – Became awkwardly placed on heels when held up near the 100 metres.</p>	

PULLYOURSOCKSUP (K Williams) – When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare is better suited over more distance.

Race 4 | **ANGUS MEATS GREAT AUTUMN HANDICAP (2500m)**

VOLVIK (K Williams) – Raced wide in the early stages. Placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres then having to be steadied for a distance when crowded near the 150 metres and further hampered near the 75 metres not being persevered with for the remainder of the race.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (L Allpress) – Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1600 metres.

SITARIST (W Pinn) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 1800 metres.

LETSBRINGITON (G Jogoo) – Lay in under pressure in the straight.

MAJOR TOM (K Chowdhoo) – Lay in under pressure in the straight and was unable to be fully ridden out as a result.

G Jogoo (LETSBRINGITON) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards under pressure when not sufficiently clear crowding POINT SCORE onto VOLVIK near the 150 metres, with POINT SCORE then having to be severely checked near the 100 metres when LETSBRINGITON continued to shift inwards. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended G Jogoo's licence to ride at race meetings for 11 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 8 May up to and including racing on Thursday 27 May and in addition imposed a fine of \$300.

POINT SCORE (C Johnson) – Crowded passing the 200 metres before having to be severely checked near the 100 metres going badly off stride and losing all momentum then not being persevered with.

Race 5 | **NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY RATING 65 (1200m)**

NOAH (C Barnes) - Declared a late scratching at 1.49pm after escaping under the front of its barrier stall and taking some time to be recaptured. Consequently the start was delayed approximately 9 minutes.

GRANITE RIDGE (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

OUR ROSETTE (K Williams) – Over raced in the early stages when being restrained.

MAKABAR (W Papier) – Raced very wide throughout, ducked outwards when struck with the whip passing the 400 metres and was then inclined to shift inwards under pressure when the rider swapped the whip to the right hand. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PAPAGENA (K Kwo) – Raced in restricted room near the 400 metres before shifting outwards across the heels of HARBOURSIDE to obtain clear running.

SELFIE (J Laking) – Held up early in the straight until near the 300 metres.

W Papier (MAKABAR) - Admitted a charge in that he failed to take all reasonable and permissible measures to ensure his mount was given the best chance to finish in the best possible placing by permitting MAKABAR to cover more ground than reasonable during the running. After viewing footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended W Papier's licence to ride at race meetings for 4 weeks effective from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 8 May up to and including racing on Saturday 5 June.

<p>The start was delayed approximately 4½ minutes due to the delay in the previous race.</p> <p>ART DE TRIOMPHE (K Williams) – Jumped away awkwardly, was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight crowding LUCYBELLE near the 250 metres.</p> <p>MOZZARELLA (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MACKENZIE LAD (S Wynne) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.</p> <p>LUCYBELLE (R Mudhoo) – Crowded near the 250 metres.</p> <p>FIREGLOW (K Chowdhoo) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 7	DAVID EMERSON CHARTERED ACCOUNTANT & BUSINESS CONSULTANT RATING 65 (2000m)
<p>MY SOVA (J Laking) – Declared a late scratching at 2.58pm after refusing to enter the barriers. Co-trainer J Parsons was advised that MY SOVA is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.</p> <p>THE EMPORESS (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WANNABEE 'N' PARIS (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>TAKEITLIKEAMAN (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DARCEE QUE (W Pinn) – Bumped with TAKE THE DEEL near the 300 metres.</p> <p>TAKE THE DEEL (J Lowry) – Bumped with DARCEE QUE near the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 8	DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL GREAT EASTER STAKES (1400m)
<p>KILLARNEY (G Jogoo) – Reluctant to load delaying the start. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.</p> <p>ROCK SENSATION (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CARSON RIVER (K Mudhoo) – Crowded on jumping.</p> <p>KHIMAR WAR (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>WHAT A SMASHER (S Macnab) – Over raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>JOHNNY JONES (J Laking) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>SEVERINE (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SHE'S A LADY (L Allpress) – Held up early in the straight.</p>

<p>ST ANDRE (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.</p>	

HUNTER VILLAIN (K Asano) – Slow to begin.

QUEEN SWEEP (L Allpress) – Slow to begin, raced wide without cover from the 1400 metres.

CANNOLI (S Wynne) – Over raced near the 1200 metres having to shift outwards to avoid heels.

BENEFICIAL (J Laking) – Over raced in the middle stages.
