**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1600m</b>
<p><b>D Bothamley</b> (ALTAR GIRL) admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.</p> <p><b>KEEPER BEEL</b> (M Gestain) – Began awkwardly making contact with IFFRAAJABLE losing ground as a result.</p> <p><b>IFFRAAJABLE</b> (K Williams) – Crowded on jumping, held up by tiring runner passing the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>SPLASH PALACE</b> (K Chowdhoo) – Over raced getting its head up on several occasions in the early stages.</p> <p><b>NEVETS</b> (C Campbell) – Raced wide with cover in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SWEET STORM</b> (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MISTLETOE</b> (J Laking) – Got its head up when being steadied to take cover passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>FOLKTALE</b> (R Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied for some distance passing the 700 metres to avoid the heels of the tiring JUSTWONPRINCESS.</p> <p><b>JUSTWONPRINCESS</b> (A Balloo) – Rider reported that the filly had hung outwards throughout the running.</p> <p>The track was downgraded to Slow7 retrospective to this race.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JUICE SIGNS ASHBURTON MAIDEN 1400m</b>
<p><b>VERDIGRIS</b> (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly, held up early in the run home and again over the concluding stages going to the line not fully tested by its rider.</p> <p><b>MR TOOL</b> (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin, raced four wide with cover through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>CHEEKINI</b> (K Chowdhoo) – Hampered at the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>CEEDOUBLEJAY</b> (M Gestain) – Hampered at the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>RUSSIAN FABLE</b> (C Barnes) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping hampering inside runners, raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>LADY MODENA</b> (R Mudhoo) – Over raced through the early to middle stages and had to be restrained away from heels for some distance passing the 900 metres and was then obliged to race four wide without cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>SARAYU</b> (L Callaway) – Steadied to avoid heels passing the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>DREAMS OF HEAVEN</b> (J Laking) – Briefly steadied when crowded for room passing the 100 metres by MERITORIOUS which was laying out.</p> <p><b>MERITORIOUS</b> (K Williams) – Lay out over the concluding stages.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TREVOR WHITING/DAVID QUIGLEY MAIDEN 2200m</b>
<p><b>LANCASTER PARK</b> (J Laking) was a late scratching at 1.38 pm on veterinary advice. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>RAISE YA CARDS</b> (C Campbell) – Held up for clear racing room near the 300 metres after attempting a marginal run to the inside of MADAME CHERIE which shifted inwards slightly under pressure.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>LIQUORLAND RACECOURSE ROAD MAIDEN 1250m</b>
<p><b>SERAPHIC</b> (L Callaway) – Trainer P Harris was fined \$50 for presenting the gelding in pacifiers rather than the visor blinkers which had been notified. Due to no visor blinkers being available SERAPHIC raced in standard blinkers.</p>	

**MOVIE STAR** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly, shifted inwards to find clear racing room passing the 200 metres and then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **PIKEY PRINCESS** (M Gestain) which shifted in marginally under pressure. M Gestain was advised to exercise greater care.

**LACHIE'S MATE** (K Kwo) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover, had to steady near the 200 metres when **MOVIE STAR** (K Mudhoo) shifted ground inwards to find clear racing room. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care. Again steadied near the 150 metres when **MOVIE STAR** was taken in by **PIKEY PRINCESS**.

**PIKEY PRINCESS** (M Gestain) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

**BEALEY INN** (A Balloo) – Raced greenly rounding the bend near the 500 metres and lay out, with the rider reporting the filly had lay out rounding the bend.

**MR HASS** (J Laking) – Held up through the middle stages of the run home when hesitant to take a marginal run to the inside of **GALILEO EXPRESS**.

**Race 5** | **HYGAIN MAIDEN 1250m**

The start was delayed approximately three minutes due to several runners proving difficult to load.

**NELLIE GREY** (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

**SHEZA PRO** (A Balloo) – Slow to begin.

**GREEN EXPRESS** (C Campbell) – Bounded at the start losing some ground, raced three wide with cover throughout, dictated wider near the 900 metres and lay in under pressure in the straight.

**ELIZABETH ROSE** (S Wynne) – Commenced to over race shortly after the start continuing to do so over the middle stages forcing **GREEN EXPRESS** wider at the 900 metres, obliged to race wide rounding the final bend when improving.

**LADY CORA** (T Jonker) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**AMADI LASS** (K Williams) – Lay in in the run home when placed under pressure.

**Race 6** | **GARY MCCORMICK/GRAEME FECHNEY 2200m**

**LAST LETTER** (A Balloo) – Slow to begin.

**JINGO** (K Kwo) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding outside runner, raced keenly for a distance passing the 2000 metres and was then obliged to race three wide without cover.

**MASTER COURTSMAN** (C Barnes) – Crowded at the start losing ground, improved forward from the 1400 metres to lead passing the 1200 metres.

**SEE WHATA PRINCESS** (S Wynne) – Lay inwards in the run home. Rider reported that the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

**JACK BE QUICK** (M Gestain) – Rider reported that the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

**S Weatherley** (YEAH RIGHT) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 7** | **HEARTLAN PRINT 1400m**

**SHOW BAZZ** (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly, over raced in the early and middle stages. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider reported that after over racing the gelding had very little left in the run home.

**JOHNNIE REDMOND** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly losing some ground.

**SORCERESS** (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**MANEKI NEKO** (K Mudhoo) – Lay in throughout the run home.

**CHARLIE BROWN** (R Beeharry) – Was reported by its rider to have hung throughout and lay inwards for the majority of the run home having to be continually straightened.

**THE GARRISON** (K Williams) – Crowded and checked passing the 350 metres having to be restrained and shift outwards near the 250 metres to find clear racing room.

**O’HE CAN** (S Wynne) – Dictated inwards and placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres.

**R Beeharry** (CHARLIE BROWN) defended a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 350 metres dictating O’HE CAN inwards onto THE GARRISON which was checked. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the charge and suspended R Beeharry’s licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 20 May up to and including 28 May and imposed a fine of \$150.

**Race 8**

**TONY COOK LIFE MEMBER APPRECIATION 1400m**

**SERIOUSLY** (K Williams) – Over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

**BLAIR FLIGHT** (L Callaway) – Over raced badly in the early and middle stages.

**SPLENDIOR** (C Campbell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MAMMA SANS which shifted out at this point.

**RECOMMENDED FLIGHT** (S Weatherley) – Held up through the middle stages of the run home and passing the 225 metres made contact with ARE YOU CEREAL which was contacted and briefly unbalanced.

**ARE YOU CEREAL** (M Gestain) – Held up passing the 200 metres and bumped and unbalanced when contacting RECOMMENDED FLIGHT.

**D Bothamley** (I AM A ROCK) was spoken to advisedly in regard to his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.
