Race 7 VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE 28/8 1400

KOOL POWER (V Colgan) – A follow up on the filly was completed by Stewards, with Trainer Mr S Crawford reporting, that upon return to the stable KOOL POWER, was examined by the stable veterinarian to determine the extent of the

injury from the laceration to the right hind leg. S Crawford further advised, that the results from the examination showed significant tendon damage to the leg, with the filly having to be humanely euthanised.

Race 8 BGP BATTLERS CUP (2100 metres)

SHE SPEEDS (K Asano) – Trainer Mr S Marsh advised Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, SHE SPEEDS will now no longer be considered as a racing prospect for Marsh Racing stable.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 POP STAR PRINCESS FAREWELL 1550

LORD PAINTON (O Bosson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

WILLY AWAY (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly.

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced passing the 550 metres when KIRRA LAD shifted outwards to improve. S Weatherley was advised to exercise care.

KIRRA LAD (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages.

FLEURGUNDY (J Fawcett) – Unable to obtain clear running early in the final straight.

ERIDANI (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised that the mare may be better suited to a shorter distance.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE SERIES FINAL 3YO 1550

GOODO JO (J Fillmore) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MARTINA MARIEA (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

BANG BANG (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

ROWIN (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight then lay out when placed under pressure making contact with TREVINO.

TREVINO (T Newman) – Contacted and forced wider early in the final straight.

SPOILER ALERT (K Asano) – Held up throughout the final straight.

PIERRO ROSSO (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson could offer no excuse.

Race 3 MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 1550

PENNY JANE (H Schofer) – Slow to begin.

GOLDEN EAGLE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly then hampered, losing ground. Made contact with WHILE YOU'RE THERE when attempting to shift outwards to improve near the 900 metres then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SOPHUN having to steady. Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.

NORTH OF HAVANA (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PABLO CASALS (L Satherley) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider was of the opinion that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

K Asano (NORTH OF HAVANA) – Was questioned regarding a perceived lack of vigour rounding the final bend and early in the final straight. Mr Asano explained that the mare had lay out and away from runners that had improved up to his inside rounding the bend near the 350 metres then had continued to lay out in the final straight. Mr Asano advised that he was mindful of not causing interference to the runners to his outside so elected to attempt to keep his mount straight rather than urging it forward. Stewards noted K Asano's explanation.

Race 4 MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 1300

DUBY (D Johnson) – Jumped in the air at the start and was slow away as a result. Stable representative P Richards advised that the mare would likely be sent for a spell. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

LE CAPILLA (D Danis) – Jumped away awkwardly. Commenced to over-race in the early stages making the bend awkwardly near the 950 metres and shifted out becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be firmly restrained.

EASY PEASY (J Fawcett) – Slow away.

CLEVER RUDS (L Satherley) – Blundered leaving the barriers and shifted in hampering BOLD PERFORMER.

SECRET SHOW (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

BOLD PERFORMER (T Yanagida) – Hampered on jumping away. Steadied when crowded near the 1200 metres.

LEX'S ONE (L Innes) - Briefly steadied near the 1200 metres.

L Satherley (CLEVER RUDS) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of BOLD PERFORMER crowding that runner onto LEX'S ONE which had to be steadied near the 1200 metres.

Race 5THE OAKS STUD 970

ROC CHA (L Satherley) – Slow away.

Race 6 MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 970

ADDICTED TO YOU (B Rogerson) – Slow away.

SHANG CHI (E Leighton) – Crowded shortly after the start when bumped outwards onto IMPRESA. Held up until shifting outwards passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

IMPRESA (L Allpress) – Contacted shortly after the start. Held up for the majority of the final straight.

MYLA (C Grylls) – Checked near the 700 metres when crowded for room by SHANG CHI which lay inwards away from PHOENIX IKKI despite the efforts of its rider. Held up for the majority of the final straight.

HASSTOBEMAGIC (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ODINPOWER (T Newman) – Improved onto heels having to be briefly steadied passing the 100 metres.

Race 7 MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 2000

GLEN FREY (C Grylls) – Jumped away awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend. Rider dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

DRAGON REALM (D Danis) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ALAMODE (D Johnson) – Over-raced when being restrained going into the first turn, getting its head up.

JOJAKK (T Abel) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Shifted in passing the 950 metres making contact with ALEGRE.

ALEGRE (L Satherley) – Contacted and unbalanced passing the 950 metres. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres.

HEART OF A LION (T Yanagida) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room between ALEGRE and DRAGON REALM near the 950 metres. Footage of this incident proved inconclusive with no further action being taken.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (E Nicholas) – Lay out when placed under pressure rounding the final bend and in the straight.

RISING STORM (L Allpress) – Rider dropped her whip near the 300 metres. Raced greenly when placed in restricted room to the inside of MISS ONAKI (M McNab) which shifted in passing the 100 metres. M McNab was advised to exercise care.
