At an adjourned enquiry, M Singh ROC LEGEND admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards in the home straight when not clear of JACKAROO which clipped a heel and fell. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Singh's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Thursday, 13 May 2021 up to and including racing on Monday, 7 June 2021 (16 national days).

Race 1	PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MAIDEN HURDLE (3000 Metres)
<p>KANGAROO (T Moki) - Was removed from its barrier after becoming fractious to undergo a veterinary examination and cleared fit to race. Crowded on landing after jumping the fence near the 250 metres when weakening.</p> <p>IZYMYDAAD (B Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MY TOMMY (H McNeill) - Lost ground after jumping the fence near the 500 metres.</p> <p>CARNABY (J Seivwright) - Poor jump at the fence near the 500 metres.</p> <p>BEAU GESTE (D Parker) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p>T Moki (KANGAROO) – Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after failing to claim down to her declared riding weight.</p>	
Race 2	FASTTRACK INSURANCE OPEN HURDLE (3000 Metres)
<p>SON OF ANNA KAY (D Parker) – Placed in restricted room near the 850 metres on the first occasion when racing keenly and continued to race keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>IT'S A WONDER (S Phelan) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being challenged for the lead.</p> <p>MAX (E Farr) - Ran down the final two fences.</p>	
Race 3	KEN DUNCAN RACING STEEPLECHASE (3800 Metres)
<p>FANTASY FLIGHT (D Parker) – Jumped indifferently in the early to middle stages. Hampered when jumping the second to last fence by ZARTAN, which shifted out when running the fence down.</p> <p>GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (H McNeill) - Poor jump at the fence near the 1800 metres. Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and did not jump the final two fences.</p> <p>THE ROLLING STONE (B Donoghue) - Blundered after jumping the last fence.</p>	
Race 4	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE MAIDEN (1360 Metres)
<p>FIRE DANCER (K Hercock) - Permitted to race in visor blinkers after blinkers had been declared due to a misinterpretation. Slow away then hampered.</p> <p>ZOEY SATIN (a Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Ducked in near the 30 metres briefly crowding CHER AMI on to JENEVA, which was steadied.</p>	

CHER AMI (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

LURID (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly and then hampered. Raced keenly in the early stages.

COLLECTOR (S O'Malley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

HAKA BOOGIE (M Singh) - Hampered soon after leaving the barrier.

KINGSTON FLYER (T Bau) – Restrained for a distance approaching the 800 metres when awkwardly placed near heels. Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages contacting **SASSY SUSAN**.

FALCON SCOTT (A Goindasamy) – Commenced to hang out in the early stages making the bend awkwardly placing its rider in difficulty and becoming awkwardly placed near heels approaching the 400 metres.

SASSY SUSAN (S Macnab) - Contacted and briefly steadied approaching the winning post when shifting in and contacting **KINGSTON FLYER** (T Bau), which was shifting out under pressure. Both T Bau and S Macnab were advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

JENEVA (T Taiaroa) - Steadied over the concluding stages when crowded.

MR FABULOUS (M Hudson) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding would likely benefit from today's race.

S O'Malley (COLLECTOR) - Was reminded of his obligation regarding whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 5

NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE (1200 Metres)

ONCE BITTEN (T Taiaroa) - Slow to load. Connections were advised a warning has been placed against the filly's barrier manners.

PLEASURE (S Macnab) – Began awkwardly shifting out.

SCYLLA (J Kamaruddin) – Crowded start. Shifted out to obtain clear running 300 metres inconveniencing **MISS DIXIE**. J Kamaruddin was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

UBER ROCA (R Aukett) – Crowded start. Steadied passing the 75 metres when awkwardly placed.

THE WITCH (A Mudhoo) - Crowded start losing ground.

POROTENE SLING (C Johnson) – Crowded approaching the 1100 metres and steadied. Rider C Johnson was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out to the finish of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

ALEXAVIA (D Montes de Oca) - Crowded approaching the 1100 metres and steadied losing ground. Improved into restricted room 200 metres and then had difficulty obtaining clear running for a distance.

ICONIC LASS (M Hudson) – Crowded approaching the 100 metres and steadied. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly failed to handle today's track conditions.

MISS DIXIE (H Schofer) – Steadied approaching the 400 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of **KOOL POWER** (J Riddell) which shifted out. J Riddell was reprimanded and advised to ensure he is clear when shifting ground. Inconvenienced approaching the 300 metres by **SCYLLA** which shifted out to obtain clear running.

S Macnab (PLEASURE) – Issued with a warning after permitting PLEASURE to shift in approaching the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of **POROTENE SLING**, which became awkwardly placed near that runner's heels when over-racing crowding **ALEXAVIA** on to **ICONIC LASS** with **ALEXAVIA** being steadied.

CASAQUINMAN (A Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

BALALAIKA (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

CARDINAL O'CEIRIN (T Taiaroa) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SPIDERMAN (C O'Beirne) - Crowded for a distance approaching the 150 metres and steadied.

C Johnson (BALALAIKA) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted BALALAIKA to shift out approaching the 150 metres when insufficiently clear of SPIDERMAN, which was crowded and hampered. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended C Johnson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 20 May 2021 up to and including racing on Wednesday, 26 May 2021 (3 riding days) and in addition imposed a fine of \$150.

Race 7	FLAIR (AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES) MAIDEN (2060 Metres)

SHACKELTONS EDGE (L Zydenbos) - Crowded 2000 metres and steadied clipping, a heel and blundering.

MRS TWINKLETOES (P Matthews) - Crowded 2000 metres and steadied to avoid heels.

HOLD MY BEER (T Mercer) - Crowded 2000 metres.

OUR CUZZIE (S Malki) - Shifted out leaving the barriers crowding **LIZZED** which lost ground. **OUR CUZZIE** then contacted **MIDGE MAISEL**, which was forced out on to **ECHO BAY** with **OXYMORON** shifting away from that runner. Also crowded was **HOLD MY BEER** which then continued to shift out into the line of **MRS TWINKLETOES**, which was crowded on to **SHACKELTONS EDGE** which clipped a heel and blundered. Contributing was some brief inward movement from **MR FLYNN**. Footage of this incident was inconclusive as the head-on camera had malfunctioned with all riders advising to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

NADEEMS DREAM (M Singh) – Saddle shifted forward near the 1600 metres placing the rider in difficulty for the remainder of the race and not being persevered with in the final straight.

PHELAN FOXY (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly and hampered and steadied.

DR HANK (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly.

SOVEREIGN EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Steadied when in restricted room 1600 metres between **CELTIC WONDER**, which shifted in slightly and **SIDEBAR** which had made the corner awkwardly.

GEEZAS GEORGE (F Lazet) – When questioned F Lazet had no excuse and advised the gelding was disappointing.

Race 9	COMMDIVES NZ CELEBRATES 30 YEARS IN BUSINESS MAIDEN (1600 Metres)
<p>OCEANIDES (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>PINSK (S Macnab) – Attempted to buck soon after leaving the barrier, losing ground. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the barrier manners of PINSK.</p> <p>VISHAKHA (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SHEZ SUPER (M Singh) – Hung outwards throughout the race.</p> <p>RONIN POROTENE (J Fawcett) – Crowded and hampered 100 metres.</p> <p>ITS MARGO (H Schofer) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly was unsuited to the Heavy track.</p> <p>R Elliot (BLACK FOREST) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted BLACK FOREST to shift in passing the 100 metres when insufficiently clear of RONIN POROTENE which was hampered, losing ground. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended R Elliot's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 23 May 2021 up to and including racing on Friday, 28 May 2021 (3 national riding days) and in addition imposed a fine of \$150.</p> <p>Following the race, the connections of the 5th placed RONIN POROTENE viewed the Stewards films alleging interference by the 1st place BLACK FOREST, electing not to protest.</p>	
Race 10	NGA TAWA DIOCESAN SCHOOL (1600 Metres)
<p>ATOMIC KITTEN (C Johnson)- Underwent a veterinary examination after being kicked behind the barrier and was passed fit to start.</p> <p>BRINGITONPET (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin. Rider reported to the Stewards that the mare held its breath during the running.</p> <p>LADY CALYPSO (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DOTHRAKI (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up when improving into a marginal run passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>LA JUNGLES (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>RELDA (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TRANSITORY (S Macnab) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>DEUCE COUPE (T Taiaroa) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and then raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 11	WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE (1600 Metres)
<p>MOGADOR (M Singh) – Slow to begin. Hampered soon after leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced keenly through the middle stages having to be steadied away from heels.</p> <p>LUCKY PARK (D Hirini) – Hampered soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.</p>	

THE BIG BOSS (D Montes de Oca) – Hampered 1500 metres losing ground. Shifted in passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

MI GRACIE (F Lazet) - Raced in restricted room early in the final straight.

OSTASIO (R Elliot) – Hampered and steadied 250 metres.

AKELA BELLE (A Goindasamy) - Hampered 250 metres when attempting to improve to the inside of THE BIG BOSS which simultaneously shifted in. As a result, AKELA BELLE shifted into the line of OSTASIO, which was hampered and steadied.
