Race 6 - METROWASTE MILE
Stewards concluded an enquiry into the reasons why MARRONI fell bringing down CUTTING UP ROUGH passing the 350 metres. It was established that MARRONI had become awkwardly placed after improving near the heels of ORAKEI OVERLORD and STAND TALL and when attempting to steady his mount, clipped a heel of STAND TALL and fell with STAND TALL then shifting in after being struck from behind. In the circumstances the fall was deemed accidental

with no rider being held culpable, however, M Hashizume was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance when pursuing a run that has not fully developed.

Held up until passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>CHAMPAGNE PRINCESS (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>TAVITRONIC (J Fillmore) - Steadied from its wider barrier.</p> <p>OREMUS (J Riddell) - Briefly crowded approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>LOQUITA (H Schofer) - Crowded and hampered approaching the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the filly may have been unsuited by the synthetic track.</p> <p>CAMAROSA (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised the filly may have been unsuited by the synthetic track.</p> <p>LATE TO THE PARTY (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ANOTHER ENTRÉE (A Calder) - Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SWORD OF MERCY (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>CIAMBELLA (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.</p> <p>JOJAKK (C Jones) - Improved onto the heels of the weakening LATE TO THE PARTY having to be steadied passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>A Calder (ANOTHER ENTRÉE) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of OREMUS which was forced inwards hampering LOQUITA approaching the 1000 metres.</p>

<p>DUBY (J Kamaruddin) - Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p>GLORIFIED (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Held up until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>ALAMODE (M McNab) - Crowded soon after leaving the barrier and steadied. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>GALAXY POWER (R Elliot) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Steadied when placed in restricted room when weakening passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>FASONG (H Schofer) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Unable to obtain clear running for a majority of the final straight.</p> <p>JUST A SUPER BOY (E Leighton) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p>	

E Leighton (JUST A SUPER BOY) - Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of GALAXY POWER which had to be steadied passing the 300 metres.

WAIPA EARTHWORKS 1300

FUNTONIC (T Yanagida) - Hampered start losing ground.

SKY OASIS (M McNab) - Began awkwardly.

RUA ROCKS (A Calder) - Began awkwardly then crowded.

HARD NOSE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly then crowded shifting out and hampering FUNTONIC which lost ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

BURCHA (L Satherley) - Contacted soon after leaving the barriers, becoming crowded and unbalanced.

SECRET SHOW (C Grylls) - Raced wide in the early stages.

MOET BELLE (S Weatherley) - Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had hung out throughout the running and may have been unsuited by the synthetic track.

JENESSA (D Johnson) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of FUNTONIC which shifted in approaching the 100 metres.

T Yanagida (FUNTONIC) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of JENESSA which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

FRONT PAGE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.

KIKI (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

GRACEFUL WAY (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

PENNY JANE (H Schofer) - Steadied from a wide barrier.

RICH GIRL (R Elliot) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

BANCOMAT D'ORO (T Newman) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

SIDE HUSTLE (D Danis) - Improved onto heels and steadied approaching the 450 metres.

DARK SATIN (M McNab) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres then shifted out crowding LAMBO.

LAMBO (S Weatherley) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 1000 metres. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres after DARK SATIN (M McNab) shifted out. M McNab was advised to exercise care. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 100 metres by SIDE HUSTLE which shifted out.

R Elliot (RICH GIRL) - Was issued with a warning after momentarily entering the jockey's room prior to weighing in. R Elliot was called back to weigh in with Stewards being satisfied that the weigh in process had not been compromised.

D Danis (SIDE HUSTLE) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of LAMBO passing the 100 metres with LAMBO being contacted and unbalanced.

<p>PAMPAS (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>CHAMPAGNES ON ME (T Newman) - Reared as the start was affected beginning awkwardly and was then crowded losing ground. Had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of CANTCALLIT which shifted out slightly approaching the 50 metres. Also inconvenienced as a result was THE CHARGING.</p> <p>ARABIAN SEA (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.</p> <p>THE CHARGING (S Spratt) - Crowded leaving the barriers shifting in crowding CHAMPAGNES ON ME and ARABIAN SEA. Inconvenienced approaching the 50 metres.</p> <p>IMA ROCA BEE (E McCall) - Raced wide without cover and hung out for the majority of the race.</p> <p>LA DOLCE VITA (A Goindasamy) - Improved onto heels approaching the 300 metres and steadied for a distance before shifting out approaching the 200 metres and then improving onto the heels of IMA ROCA BEE which shifted out slightly resulting in LA DOLCE VITA having to be firmly restrained.</p>

<p>VIKING (M McNab) - Slow to begin (3L). Held up from near the 450 metres when awkwardly placed near heels then improved onto heels 250 metres being held up for the remainder of the race. Held up throughout the final straight.</p> <p>ERIDANI (A Goindasamy) - Steadied from its wide barrier.</p> <p>DARCI PALMER (C Grylls) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>ROSE BOWL (S Collett) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>SO GORGEOUS (D Johnson) - Hung out for the majority of the race proving difficult in the final straight and was not persevered with from near the 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>RADIANT ROSIE (S Weatherley) - Briefly steadied 300 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.</p>	
Race 7	MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 1990 (970 metres)
<p>OUR SASSY CAT (S Weatherley) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>REMARKABLE RUTH (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact.</p> <p>BOLD PERFORMER (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly with its hindquarters contacted becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>PRECIOUS COLOURS (M McNab) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>SNIP (S Collett) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SKIPPING STONES (T Newman) - Began awkwardly then crowded.</p>	

SO CHARMING (B Rogerson) - Raced wide without cover. Contacted and forced wider passing the 500 metres by PRECIOUS COLOURS which shifted out when racing keenly.

JUST KATE (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover.

HIGHBORN (D Johnson) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

NO SECRET (J Fillmore) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight before shifting in passing the 150 metres inconveniencing FLYPAST. J Fillmore was advised to exercise care. Raced greenly when attempting a marginal run between runners over the concluding stages.

SUPERACE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly then crowded, then ridden urgently to recover.

LA DIVA (T Thornton) - Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres when racing keenly making brief contact with EL ROSEAY which shifted in slightly placing ANGELINA LAURO in restricted room which had to be steadied.

ANGELINA LAURO (H Schofer) - Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres and steadied. Briefly crowded passing the 300 metres to the outside of LEX'S ONE which shifted out. V Colgan was advised to exercise care.

LEX'S ONE (V Colgan) - Held up entering the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres, briefly crowded ANGELINA LAURO.

SILVERDALE CHIEF (C Grylls) - Raced greenly just prior to the winning post and shifted out hampering EL ROSEAY which had been forced inwards slightly by LEX'S ONE. V Colgan was advised to exercise care.

EL ROSEAY (D Johnson) - Hampered just prior to the winning post.

Race 9	ELEKTRON GROUP LTD (2000 metres)

BORDER LEICESTER (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly then contacted with the rider becoming unbalanced and losing ground as a consequence.

TARWYN (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly then steadied.

SHEBRINGSMERUBIES (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied from a wide barrier.

CHARMINGAFFAIR (S Collett) - Steadied near the 1600 metres when in restricted room to the inside of SHE SPEEDS which was dictated in slightly by BECAUSE. T Newman was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight.

MASTER PAINTON (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BECAUSE (T Newman) - Held up from near the 400 metres and could not obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

SHE SPEEDS (C Grylls) - Improved onto heels approaching the 100 metres after attempting a marginal run to the inside of NOWANAGEN which shifted in slightly.

NOWANAGEN (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.
