Race 7 SPOONER, HOOD & REDPATH 1360M

LALA LAND (A Goindasamy) – Trainer Mr R Manning advised Stewards, LALA LAND underwent a post-race veterinary examination, which at that time revealed no abnormalities, however, R Manning, requested a second veterinary examination around thirty minutes after the first examination was completed, which then revealed the gelding to be showing signs of colic. R Manning further advised LALA LAND returned to his stable and is recovering well.

Race 8 - RIVER CITY CABS MAIDEN 1360M

Gate staff were spoken to regarding what is acceptable practice when loading horses away.

Race 1 – AVONDALE SUNDAY MARKETS 2100M

CHARRED – Trainer P Mirabelli reported the gelding had suffered a colic attack on return to his stable and was now to be spelled.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 PGG WRIGHTSON 2YO (800 Metres)

BELLACONTTE (S Macnab) – Slow away.

LADY VADAMOS (A Mudhoo) - Slow away.

GATO MONTES (B Rogerson) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

LA GRANDE RUE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly then ridden urgently to recover. Lay outwards and inclined to get its head up rounding the bend through the middle stages.

TUI ROCKS (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover.

HEROIC WARRIOR (H Schofer) - Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres inconveniencing POLAR BLAST near the 100 metres.

POLAR BLAST (J Riddell) - Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

A Mudhoo (LADY VADAMOS) – Reminded of his obligation to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

Race 2 HYDRA-CELL PUMPS WELLINGTON HURDLE (3100 Metres)

THE COSSACK (S Phelan) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up striking S Phelan in the face, with THE COSSACK then losing ground and settling well back.

EL LUCHADOR (J Seivewright)- Crowded 900 metres contacting the rail losing ground.

AIGNE (D Parker) - Shifted in abruptly second to last fence hampering CHIEF SEQUOYAH

CHIEF SEQUOIYAH (E Farr) - Hampered second last fence

ALI BABA (K Joyce) - Misjudged the second fence and knuckled on landing.

BAK DA MASTER (M Roustoby) - Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

NO CHANGE (H (McNeill) - Blundered after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres.

MY TOMMY (L Douglas) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the 900 metres.

ZAC BROWN (N Downs) - Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres and went back on to EL LUCHADOR, which in turn forced AIGNE to steady.

MASTER FIN (M Cropp) – Retired from the race prior to the second last fence.

MY TOMMY (L Douglas) – Retired from the race prior to the second last fence

Race 3 JIMMY RURAL/CARPET KING 1200 (1200 Metres)

TINY TERROR (L Hemi) – Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection at the barrier after receiving a kick. Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

LUCKY SHARK (S McKay) - Jumped away awkwardly.

MATT CAIN (T Taiaroa) – Had to be firmly restrained when improving on to the heels of HEZA LOOKER going into the bend passing the 800 metres.

HOOTER (D Bradley) - Changed ground after improving onto heels near 75 metres

HEZA LOOKER (T Newman) - Unable to obtain clear running prior to shifting out to improve near the 100metres

T Newman (HEZA LOOKER) – Issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards to obtain clear running inconveniencing TINY TERROR near the 100 metres.

Race 4 FARMERS TRANSPORT MILE (1650 Metres)

DONARDO (S Mohammed) – Slow away (5L).

KICK ON (S MacNab) - Crowded going into the first turn near the 1400 metres when ECHO BAY was taken outwards following movement from runners to its inside, forcing KICK ON out onto MARBUZET. Over-raced in the middle stages. Was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened.

ECHO BAY (L Kennedy) - Unbalanced when making contact near the 1400 metres.

MARBUZET (M Northcott) - Unbalanced when contacted near the 1400 metres.

TROSETTEE (V Mason) - Disappointed for a run near the 250 metres when attempting a marginal gap which closed to the inside of SYBARITE.

T Mercer (SYBARITE) – Advised to exercise greater care after allowing her mount to shift in when not fully clear of TROSETTE which was attempting a narrow run.

Race 5 GRANT PLUMBING WELLINGTON STEEPLECHASE (Prestige Jumping Race (5500 Metres)

MESMERIZE (S Phelan) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence, dislodging rider S Phelan who was uninjured.

YARDARM (S Fannin) - Blundered on landing after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres on the final circuit. Contacted final stages.

ZARTAN (J Seivwright) - Jumped outwards at the second fence hampering SHACKELTONS EDGE. Badly hampered when contacted by the riderless horse after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres on the second circuit. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 750 metres on the second circuit landing awkwardly. Retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres on the final circuit. Required veterinary attention following the race, which revealed the gelding to be suffering from heat stress.

SHAMAL (B Lammas) - Misjudged the fence at the 1000 metres on the first circuit.

SHACKELTONS EDGE (H McNeill) - Hampered second fence. Shifted out under pressure over the final stages and made contact with YARDARM.

NOTABADROOSTER (M Cropp) – Hampered by the riderless horse approaching the fence near the 1000 metres on the second circuit. Fell at the fence near the 1000 metres on the final occasion. Rider M Cropp was uninjured. NOTABADROOSTER underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed abrasions to the left hind stifle and right hind fetlock.

PERIAN SPRING (E Farr) - Retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres on the final occasion.

Race 6 ROSS DYER LIVESTOCK/WAIROA WANDERERS 1650 (1650 Metres)

GEHRIG (S MacNab) – Slow away.

PRINCE TURBO (T Mercer) – Slow away. Improved up on to heels near the 75 metres then had to be angled inwards to improve.

MANOLO (N Smith) - Slow to begin.

HE'S RIC (L Kennedy) - Raced three wide without cover.

Race 7 CP WOOL/CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1200 Metres)

QUATORZE (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover.

ALCHEMIA (L Allpress) – Commenced to hang outwards from near the 500 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. L Allpress advised the filly would improve with the experience.

LINDA LOLA (S Macnab) - Hampered home straight.

SHARKY (K Hercock) - Shifted ground under pressure in the home straight.

H Schofer (BEAU MONDE) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift outwards in the final straight hampering LINDA LOLA, which was improving to its outside.

Race 8 KEN BROWNE/NEILSON LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1650 Metres)

JENEVER (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

CHER AMI (L Hemi) - Slow away. Raced three wide without cover.

BIG PAPI (S Macnab) - Held up for some distance near the 400 metres. When questioned S Macnab could offer no excuse.

Race 9 FOLEYS TRANSPORT MAIDEN (1650 Metres)

COUNTESS CONTI - (K Hercock) – Slow away.

PRECIOUS NIAMH - (S Macnab) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ZAKRA (D Hirini) – Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

MR GHIBSON (J Riddell) – Steadied off heels for a distance near the 1400 metres.

JAMESON (K Asano) – Rider dropped whip near the 100 metres.

RIVER OF HOPE (C Grylls) - When questioned into the run of RIVER OF HOPE, C Grylls could offer no excuse.

Race 10 STOCKCO 1400 (1400 Metres)

MOSA MOSA – Late scratched at 11.27am on veterinary advice.

LAKEMAN (J Fawcett) – Raced three wide without cover.

LILLY LAGUNA (L Hemi) – Got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres.
