Race 1	WESTBURY STUD HONOURS ROCK ON WOOD CUP (1600 Metres)

HIGH QUALITY (A Mudhoo) – Slow away.

BELLISSIMO (M Sanson) - Jumped away awkwardly.

SEMPER MAGICO (T Taiaroa) – Got its head up for a distance when being steadied near the 1400 metres.

PABLO ESK (F Lazet) – Shifted inwards under pressure, making contact with YOSSARIAN passing the 300 metres.

YOSSARIAN (L Hemi) – Contacted 300 metres.

PASSWORD (S Macnab) - Rider reported the gelding was unsuited to the holding track.

NOT SANTA (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than possibly not being suited by today's Heavy, holding track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2	KING OF COMEDY AT NOVARA PARK/NORTH ISLAND CHALLENGE STAKES (1400 Metres)

DOLCETTO (A Mudhoo) – Jumped in the air at the start.

MADURO Blundered leaving the barriers.

ROSEWOOD (H Schofer) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the mare had not been suited by the re-application of blinkers today. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

COLLINSTREET (C Jones) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards across the heels of MADURO near the 100 metres.

COLOSTRUM – F Lazet replaced M Hudson who was not aware of the engagement and unable to be on course in time to take the ride. Improved on to heels passing the 800 metres and had to be steadied.

CHICA BONITA (L Allpress) – Slow to begin.

GREYSTONE (T Taiaroa) - Jumped away awkwardly.

PHARAH (D Hirini) - Raced greenly in the back straight and passing the 1200 metres shifted in hampering MASSO, which in turn went back on to SMART ATTIRE, which had to steady. A short distance further PHARAH lay in hampering BUDDY MARVELLOUS.

MASSO (A Mudhoo) - Hampered 1200 metres. Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

BUDDY MARVELLOUS (C Jones) – Raced greenly when placed in restricted room towards the end of the back straight. A short distance further was again hampered when briefly placed in restricted room to the inside of PHARAH passing the 800 metres.

SMART ATTIRE (C Campbell) - Hampered when MASSO made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

MR FABULOUS (C O'Beirne) - Inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight. Improved up on to the heels of HOT SHOCKOLATE over the final stages and was steadied and had to change ground inwards in order to improve.

HOT SHOCKOLATE (H Schofer) - Inclined to shift out under pressure over the final stages.	
Race 4	BEAUDEN CUP (2400 Metres)
<p>ITALIAN LOVER (F Lazet) - Declared a late scratching at 2.16pm on veterinary advice after dislodging F Lazet in the preliminary and galloping some distance. F Lazet was examined by paramedics and cleared by to fulfil her remaining engagements.</p> <p>WANNABE 'N' PARIS (C Jones) - Over-raced in the early stages with the saddle shifting forward passing the 2000 metres placing its rider in difficulty.</p> <p>ZAC BROWN (S Macnab) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>BEAUDACEA (D Bradley) - Commenced to give ground passing the 800 metres and was not persevered with, dropping out finishing a distant last. D Bradley considered there may be something amiss with the mare. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>C O'Beirne (BEAR GRYLLES) – Issued with a warning regarding the use of her whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 5	FIVE WISE MEN CUP (1200 Metres)
<p>GURTLYN (M Sanson) - Jumped away awkwardly, getting its head up, losing ground.</p> <p>SECRET SQUIRREL (T Taiaroa) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up losing ground.</p> <p>ATENARTIN (F Lazet) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>PLEASURE (S Macnab) – Over-raced when wide without cover in the early stages. Ran wide entering the final straight hampering HOOTER near the 400 metres.</p> <p>HOOTER (D Bradley) - Hampered 400 metres, had to change ground inwards.</p> <p>DUBAI'S MOKO (C O'Beirne) - Inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>RINGTHEBELLEDARCI (L Allpress) – When questioned rider reported that the gelding had over-raced in a fresh state and had little left at the finish.</p> <p>WORLD TOUR (K Hercock) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>TANGO LOVE (L Hemi) - Shifted out under pressure in the final stages.</p> <p>S Macnab (PLEASURE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she permitted her mount to shift out near the 400 metres when not clear of HOOTER, which had to hampered and change ground inwards to improve. After viewing footage and hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended S Macnab's licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 5 June up to and including racing on Thursday, 10 June (4 National riding days). In addition a fine of \$500 was imposed.</p> <p>F Lazet (ATENARTIN) - Spoken to regarding the use of her whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 6	US NAVY FLAG AUTUMN SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL (1200 Metres)
FIANO (A Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly after being fractious in the barriers.	

TELLYAWHAT (B Rogerson) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned, rider reported the gelding was unsuited to the Heavy going underfoot.

SPIDERMAN (C O'Beirne) - When questioned into the run of SPIDERMAN, C O'Beirne reported the gelding was comfortable in the going down the chute but once reaching the course proper floundered in the heavy going.

EXCELLERATION (S O'Malley) – When questioned, rider reported the gelding had not handled today's Heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a poor post-race recovery.

DIOGENES (C Jones) - Lost the near side hind plate during the running.

DEUCE COUPE (T Taiaroa) – Slow away.

CHASE (D Bradley) – Jumped away awkwardly.

HESACITIBOY (B Rogerson) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RELDA (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide when improving from the 800 metres.

DEDOJE (F Lazet) – Raced three wide without cover. Inclined to shift ground under pressure in the straight.

SPEED CALL (H Schofer) - Raced wide throughout.

K Herccock (STORMY HABIT) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. K Herccock had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 5 June up to and including racing on Saturday, 12 June (5 National riding days).
