Race 4 BEAUDEN CUP (2400 Metres)
BEAUDACEA (D Bradley) – Stable representative D Moseley advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of BEAUDACEA, however, during the running did receive a small abrasion to the right hind fetlock area. D Moseley further advised it is their intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.
Race 6 US NAVY FLAG AUTUMN SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL (1200 Metres)
EXCELLERATION (S O'Malley) – Trainer Mr P Didham reported to Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of EXCELLERATION, however, has now been sent for a spell.

Race 1	SPRAY SPECIALIST LTD/REILLY JOINERY 2YO (1100 Metres)
<p>RUACH (L Allpress) – Knuckled on jumping away, shifting out contacting MOOVIT ONOVA which became briefly unbalanced, shifting out hampering VESPARADO and BARRI HYDE.</p> <p>MOOVIT ONOVA (S Weatherley) - Contacted and unbalanced start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>VESPARADO (S Macnab) - Hampered start losing ground. Held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>BARRI HYDE (H Schofer) – Hampered start losing ground.</p> <p>ELUSIVE TEN (T Taiaroa) – Made the final bend awkwardly then lay out making contact with SHEIKHYABOOTY passing the 200 metres with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>SHEIKHYABOOTY (A Mudhoo) – Contacted 200 metres, becoming briefly unbalanced.</p>	
Race 2	TOMOS ALUMINIUM SERVICES/METRO WINDOWS AND DOORS 3YO (1200 Metres)
<p>ISPYWITHMYLITTLEYE (L Hemi) – Steadied when in restricted room on jumping away, losing ground.</p> <p>WINSTON (L Allpress) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>TED LASSO (C Dell) – Raced in restricted room near the 200 metres.</p> <p>SACRED PEARL (S Macnab) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the filly to have lacerations to both nostrils.</p>	
Race 3	BENCHTOP SURFACES LTD/IMPEYS SINCE 1951 (1550 Metres)
<p>WEST COAST (C Dell) – Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>THATZ TIGERLILY (A Mudhoo) – Went off stride near the 1200 metres and was pulled up by its rider. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the mare to have sustained a tendon injury. Connections will be advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to its next start.</p> <p>DERECHO (D Hirini) - Held up when in restricted room rounding the turn and had to be steadied when PLATINUM BORDEAUX (R Elliot) shifted out when not clear. R Elliot was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>WOTARIPPER (L Hemi) - When questioned into the disappointing run of WOTARIPPER, L Hemi had no tangible excuse other than reporting that the gelding may benefit with the addition of a tongue tie.</p>	
Race 4	PRYDA 1400 (1400 Metres)
<p>PRINCE TURBO (F Lazet) - Became fractious in the barriers and after being removed and undergoing a veterinary examination was declared a late scratching. M Breslin was advised a warning will be placed against the gelding with regard to its barrier manners.</p> <p>POWER 'N'PASSION (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MANOLO (L Hemi) – Slow away.</p> <p>MONKEY TOWN (S Weatherley) – Slow away.</p> <p>PARISIAN (B Rogerson) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied through the early stages.</p>	

SYBARITE (S Macnab) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres.	
Race 5	CARTERS 1400 (1400 Metres)
COOGA MOON (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.	
CHILLAX 'N' CHASE (S Macnab) – Slow away. Jostled with IF YOU DANCE (J Kamaruddin) for some distance early in the home straight when seeking a run.	
DEEP BLUE (K Hercocock) – Slow away.	
FREE SPIRIT (T Taiaroa) – Held up early in the home straight until shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.	
FLORAL BELT (L Allpress) – Raced in restricted room early in the home straight.	
Race 6	PLACEMAKERS 2200 (220 Metres)
SHOAL BAY (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly then steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Commenced to give ground passing the 800 metres and in doing so went back on to FATHER DOM, which was checked. When questioned T Taiaroa advised the mare raced greenly throughout, changed legs several times and was unsuited to the going underfoot today. T Taiaroa reported that SHOAL BAY clipped a heel of FATHER DOM when weakening.	
IZYMYDAAD (S O'Malley) – Began awkwardly and got back.	
FATHER DOM (S Macnab) – Slow away.	
HOSEL ROCKET (L Allpress) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary examination, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. HOSEL ROCKET is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.	
ORIENTAL BAY (S Weatherley) - When questioned rider advised the mare had failed to see out the 2200 metre distance.	
Race 7	LAMINEX NZ 2100 (2100 Metres)
BRINGITONPET (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
CAST IN BRONZE (C O'Beirne) - Held up rounding the bend into the final straight.	
Following this event S Weatherley advised Stewards he was unwell so was stood down for his remaining two rides.	
Race 8	DESIGN BUILDERS 1400 (1400 Metres)
MOHEGAN STAR - L Hemi replaced S Weatherley (unwell).	
VENATO (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the turn. When questioned into the improved performance of the winner, VENATO, Trainer M Eales advised the gelding had got too far back at its previous start.	
HARDTIMES (D Hirini) – Checked shortly after the start.	
LEVON (C Dell) – Hampered shortly after the start.	
D Bradley (SIR BRIG O' DOON) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in shortly after the start when not fully clear of HARDTIMES, which was checked and LEVON, which was hampered. D Bradley	

had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 6 June up to and including racing on Sunday, 13 June (4 days) and in addition a fine of \$250 was imposed.

Race 9	CENTRAL ITM 1400 (1400 Metres)
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MIDNIGHT SPARK – A Mudhoo replaced S Weatherley.

AIR WAVES (K Hercock) – Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious and following a veterinary examination was cleared to start.

CHOLULA (C O'Beirne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SPANISH ANGEL (M Hudson) – Slow away.

NADAL (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly.

SCYLLA (J Kamaruddin) – Placed in restricted room just short of the finish.
