GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THANK YOU ASHBURTON RACEWAY MAIDEN (1400m)
COME ON COME ON (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin and failed to take a competitive part in the race. The connections were advised that the filly was under a warning for its racing performance.	

WILD LIKE (S Wynne) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied when runners to either side shifted ground, steadied when disappointed for a run passing the 400 metres then having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

EASYRIDER (K Chowdhoo) – Steadied when crowded passing the 1200 metres.

B Murray (GEE TEE GIRL) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards passing the 1200 metres when not fully clear crowding EASYRIDER.

SERAPHIC (D Bothamley) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1200 metres.

SAVANNAH GOLD (G Jogoo) – Raced wide throughout.

LADY MODENA (R Mudhoo) – Raced three wide without cover.

GEE TEE GIRL (B Murray) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

D Bothamley (SERAPHIC) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards passing the 400 metres crowding WILD LIKE which was attempting to improve to its outside.

IZZY HOUDINI (T Moseley) – Crowded between LACHIE’S MATE and LADY MODENA when both runners shifted ground passing the 250 metres.

Following the race **B Murray** advised that he was unwell feeling the effects of wasting and was stood down from his remaining rides.

Race 2	WINTER CUP ENTRIES CLOSE 15 JUNE RATING 74 (2100m)

HEAD OFFICE (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

JINGO (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1600 metres, weakened from the 500 metres with the rider advising that the mare had commenced to hang when placed under pressure. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a poor rate of recovery.

MASTER COURTSMAN (T Jonker) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

VERMONT (M Gestain) – Lay in under pressure early in the straight having to be steadied away from the heels of MANHATTEN AFFAIR near the 300 metres.

K Chowdhoo (DEELS DONE) was spoken to regarding his whip use.

C Campbell (FIRODEN) admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 6 June up to and including 13 June.

FOLKTALE (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.

RUE DE LA PAIX (K Mudhoo) – Displaced both side winkers shortly after the start.

IRISH HI (L Callaway) – Had to be steadied away from heels near the 650 metres when over racing.

RUSSIAN FABLE (C Barnes) – Shifted inwards under pressure in the final 200 metres.

GREEN EXPRESS (C Campbell) – Rider reported that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 4 | **GRAND NATIONAL TICKETS ON SALE NOW RATING 65 (1200m)**

MAXIMUS PRIME (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

SELFIE (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages. Rider dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

FASTMOSA (J Laking) – Raced wide throughout.

STRAIGHT SETS (K Chowdhoo) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 900 metres when racing to the inside of SHE'S RECOMMENDED which shifted away from FASTMOSA which was improving to its outside.

MADAM SEQUOIA (K Kwo) – Weakened from the 800 metres.

MAXIMUS PRIME (S Wynne) – Shifted inwards under pressure having to be straightened by its rider near the 50 metres hampering LOUIE LOUIE. S Wynne was advised she would be expected to straighten her mount more quickly in similar circumstances than she had on this occasion.

LOUIE LOUIE (C Campbell) – Had to be steadied near the 50 metres.

S Toolooa (PAPAGENA) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **BARNESWOOD FARM OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)**

SHOW BAZZ (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly.

SO NATURAL (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

T Jonker (CELINE) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

T Jonker – Issued with a warning with her whip arm being raised above shoulder height over the concluding stages.

Race 6 | **COUPLAND'S BAKERIES OPEN HANDICAP (1600m)**

QUEEN SWEEP (M Gestain) – Slow to begin.

GOODANYA (D Bothamley) – Raced wide throughout.

REDFORD (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover from the 900 metres.

SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) – Was not persevered with from the 300 metres, with the rider reporting the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 | **BETAVET RATING 65 (1600m)**

TAKE THE DEEL (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, briefly held up entering the straight near the 400 metres.

AQUATTACK (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

FAUX PAS (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly, unable to obtain clear running over the final 300 metres.

JIN LU (S Toolooa) – Raced wide throughout.

DARCEE QUE (S Wynne) – Steadied losing ground near the 1400 metres when THE BUFFER lay out crossing the junction onto the course proper, raced wide from the 900 metres.

THE BUFFER (J Lowry) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Apprentice **M Taylor** (FLOAT) – Spoken to regarding her whip use in consecutive strides.

Race 8	RACING NEXT AT ASHBURTON – 8 JULY RATING 74 (1400m)

S Wynne (WHISKEY IN THE JAR) - Issued with a warning for her use of the whip prior to the preliminary.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (S Wynne) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after making contact with the fence leaving the birdcage and was cleared to race. Slow to begin, lay out near the 400 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

ST ANDRE (L Callaway) – Slow to begin losing several lengths. Co-trainer M Pitman was advised that the gelding was under a warning for its barrier manners.

LINEDANCEKING (G Jogoo) – Fractious in the barriers. Crowded between runners near the 100 metres.

ITSONLYMONEY (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

ISLAND HOP (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

HARBOURSIDE (K Williams) – Blundered on jumping unbalancing the rider, over raced in the early stages.

YANNICK (T Moseley) – Crowded at the start, over raced in the early stages.

BECKIDBOO (M Taylor) – Raced wide throughout and was inclined to hang inwards.

SILENT BATTLER (C Campbell) – Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.
