After hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Thursday, 15 July, up to and including racing on Saturday, 14 August (8 days).</p> <p>B Lammas (BUDDY MARVELOUS) - Spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.</p> | |

| <p>ROYAL PATCH (M Singh) – Began awkwardly and shifted out, crowding MIRACULOUS, LALA LAND and HAKA BOOGIE, with FACETIME having to be steadied when placed in restricted room.</p> <p>LALA LAND (A Goindasamy) - Crowded shortly after the start. Commenced to give ground rounding the home turn and finished some distance last. A Goindasamy had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.</p> <p>HAKA BOOGIE (L Hemi) - Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>MIRACULOUS (B Rogerson) - Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>FACETIME (H Schofer) - Crowded having to be steadied shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> | |
| Race 8 | RIVER CITY CABS MAIDEN 1360M |
| <p>Barrier staff will be spoken to at the upcoming Wellington meeting regarding the manner in which they loaded horses in this race.</p> <p>ZAKRA (L Hemi) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>HERMES (M Singh) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Lost the right front plate during the running.</p> <p>IRISH PRAYER (D Hirini) – Held up for a distance rounding the final bend, having to be steadied before shifting outwards passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ORLA (M Hudson) - Contacted just prior to the winning post when BLUE ARROW shifted out when placed under pressure.</p> <p>ALBERT O’CEIRIN (J Parkes) – When questioned into the disappointing run of ALBERT O’CEIRIN, J Parkes advised the gelding raced greenly when amongst other runners but was nevertheless disappointing. J Parkes added that in his opinion the gelding would improve with the run.</p> | |
