RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JOANNE HALE JULY 15 1978 HURDLES 3000m
The start was delayed approximately 8 minutes due to three riders arriving on course late due to flight delays.	
Trainer S Cameron – Issued with a warning after presenting CASHEL with gear not notified (blinkers).	
HEAD OFFICE (B Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground, retired from the race after jumping the third last fence when out of contention.	

FRANCIS DRAKE (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards, raced four wide from the 1000 metres and was retired from the race after jumping the third last fence when out of contention.

RINGBOLT (D Parker) – Crowded at the start.

CASHEL (N Downs) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

GOLD'NGURU (G Walsh) – Made a poor leap at the fourth last fence. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after hitting the fourth last fence hard when leading the gelding had then been a beaten runner.

BULLITT (R Cole) – Made a faulty leap at the last fence.

The track was downgraded to Slow(9) retrospective to this race.

Race 2	WAIMATE RACING CLUB MAIDEN 2200m

ROCCO (J Laking) – Very slow to begin and could not maintain contact with the field, was not persevered with from the 800 metres finishing a distant last. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. A post race veterinary inspection confirmed the gelding to have bled and accordingly faces the mandatory stand down periods. Trainer S Cameron advised Stewards it is his intention to retire the gelding from his stable.

WHEREABOUTS (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MIDDLE ISLAND (K Chowdhoo) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start.

CHOICE MOMENT (A Balloo) – Slow to begin.

NO DANCING TODAY (R Mudhoo) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

BEALEY INN (K Chowdhoo) – Restrained shortly after the start after jumping from a wide barrier, over raced in the middle stages.

MADAME CHERIE (K Kwo) – Restrained shortly after the start after jumping from a wide barrier, hampered near the 1400 metres when SARAYU shifted outwards when being steadied.

TREKOLURE (T Jonker) – Raced in restricted room going into the first turn passing the 1400 metres, raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

DIOR ROSETTA (S Wynne) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

SARAYU (T Moseley) – Raced four wide without cover through the early and middle stages, had to be steadied when over racing near the 1400 metres.

JIMMY WHO (M Taylor) – Commenced to over race approaching the 1000 metres, shifted outwards to avoid the heels of ALL LIT UP near the 900 metres.

A Balloo (CHOICE MOMENT) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

ALL LIT UP (G Jogoo) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's holding track conditions.

Race 4	GARRARDS & LIVAMOL 1200m
<p>KING COUGAR (M Taylor) – Began awkwardly getting its head up then raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FINBARR (S Wynne) – Slow into stride, lay in under pressure in the straight.</p> <p>SABER (K Chowdhoory) – Lay out throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p>	
Race 5	GEORGE & MARY HENNESSY MAIDEN 1200m
<p>CAPTAIN (K Chowdhoory) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Lost a hind plate during the running.</p> <p>GOOSE BAY (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly and making contact abruptly with the front gate of its barrier stall, lay out rounding the final turn. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that when racing in a fresh state today the gelding had found track conditions too testing and would take benefit from the race. S Wynne was attended to by St John Paramedics following the race after injuring her right foot leaving the barriers and was permitted to fulfil her riding engagements.</p> <p>LILYBET (C Johnson) – Slow to begin and further hampered losing ground when inside runners shifted outwards shortly after the start.</p> <p>BARRY’S CHOICE (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin, contacted passing the 400 metres, shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip in the early stages of the straight hampering MEGALOMANIAC passing the 300 metres, again ducked in sharply after being struck with the whip near the 150 metres hampering MIND YOU and continued to lay in for the remainder of the race. R Beeharry was shown footage and spoken to regarding his ride.</p> <p>PRINCESS NADIA (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MEGALOMANIAC (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover throughout, made contact with BARRY’S CHOICE when shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres, hampered passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>MIND YOU (T Moseley) – Hampered near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 6	LOVERACING.NZ MAIDEN 1200m
<p>PIKEY PRINCESS (M Taylor) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>JUSTABELLE (A Balloo) – Bounded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>CAROLINE MARGARET (L Callaway) – Shifted out at the start making contact with LENNON losing ground as a result.</p> <p>MR HASS (J Laking) – Blundered when contacted shortly after leaving the barriers, over raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>SPINDLESHANKS (R Mudhoo) – Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover in the early stages.</p> <p>CHIPPEWA (R Beeharry) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>M Taylor – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	BOB & DIANNE GOODEVE 1200m
<p>MR FOX (T Moseley) – Permission was granted to race without hind plates as replacements could not be refitted in the time available prior to the start following presentation.</p>	

DRAKE BAY (M Taylor) – Began awkwardly getting its head up losing several lengths.

PETE (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards contacting VIVA LA BLUES losing ground as a result.

VIVA LA BLUES (A Balloo) – Contacted at the start.

BARRETT (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

THE GREEN GREMLIN (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover.

TARABEEBEE (G Jogoo) – Held up passing the 250 metres then when attempting to improve into a tight run between MR FOX and SHE'S A SMASH HIT received slight contact when MR FOX shifted inwards marginally. TARABEEBEE then ducked inwards making contact with the hindquarters of SHE'S A SMASH HIT unbalancing both runners near the 200 metres.

SHE'S A SMASH HIT (R Mudhoo) – Unbalanced after receiving contact to its hindquarters near the 200 metres. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

THE BUFFER (J Laking) – Briefly held up near the 200 metres behind the weakening MR FOX.

K Williams (WHERE'S WALLY) - Spoken to regarding her celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

K Chowdhoo (MASQUE) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8	DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS WAIMATE CUP 2200m

HOT TAP (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

TAKE THE DEEL (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly losing ground, hampered shortly after the start having to be checked to avoid heels.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (K Chowdhoo) – Crowded and checked shortly after the start.

M Gestain (OUR BOY RITCHIE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start causing ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN and TAKE THE DEEL to check losing ground, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today Sunday 13 June up to and including Friday 25 June.

KING OF THE DANCE (R Beeharry) – Crowded between runners at the start losing some ground.

RAINMAN (G Jogoo) – Over raced through the early to middle stages.

S Toolooa (MANHATTEN AFFAIR) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

C Johnson (HOT TAP) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9	MARK MEYER 1600m

POWNCE (S Wynne) – Bounded at the start losing ground, raced keenly in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to lead.

RODOLFO (M Taylor) – Slow to begin, raced wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

RICKY BAKER (A Balloo) – Taken back after jumping to obtain cover from a wide draw.

NESTA (C Johnson) – Over raced in the middle stages.

A Balloo (RICKY BAKER) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides.

THANK YOU PHAR LAP RACEWAY 1600m

TUILANA (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

COLORADO MISS (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

ARE YOU CEREAL (M Gestain) – Raced wide rounding the first bend.

MISS OAKS (K Williams) – Had to be steadied away from the heels of LAPIS LAZULI which shifted inwards before being straightened by its rider passing the 150 metres.
