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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HYPNOS 1550
JUST A SUPER BOY (E Leighton) – Broke through the front of the barrier stalls and after galloping some distance, was declared a late scratching at 11:00am with the start of the race being delayed by approximately 7 minutes as a result. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.	

LOGAN'S LOGIC (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 100 metres.

RISING STORM (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

WAIPAPA (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres when SHIBUYA KOSATEN lay out when making the bend and RISING STORM shifted in slightly.

SILVER NUGGET (T Newman) – Steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1400 metres. Had to be steadied after improving onto heels approaching the 100 metres before shifting inwards to obtain clear running.

RUA ROCKS (A Calder) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN THUNDER (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding may benefit from a freshen up.

Race 2	CONCERT HALL 1550
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KIKI (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before improving into a marginal run passing the 100 metres.

SEVEN PAIRS (A Goindasamy) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Held up until passing the 100 metres.

MILLENNIUM DAWN (L Satherley) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight before having to be firmly restrained passing the 100 metres after improving onto heels.

GOLDEN EAGLE (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SMUG (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Crowded when weakening having to be steadied passing the 400 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

LAMBO (D Johnson) – Crowded having to be steadied near the 250 metres when SEVEN PAIRS (A Goindasamy) shifted out slightly and OPTIMUM SWEET lay in and away from WHILE YOU'RE THERE (S Spratt). A Goindasamy and S Spratt were advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

SIR ALLYKHAZANN (C Grylls) – Steadied over the concluding stages after SEVEN PAIRS improved into a marginal run to its outside and KIKI improved into a marginal run to its inside.

OPTIMUM SWEET (T Newman) – Contacted passing the 200 metres by SEVEN PAIRS which had shifted out in an attempt to obtain clear running resulting in OPTIMUM SWEET becoming unbalanced for a distance.

Race 3	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1550 metres)
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DARK SATIN (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

PENNY JANE (H Schofer) – Slow to begin. Shifted out passing the 250 metres making contact with ENDEAN BAY.

SWISS IDOL (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 700 metres.

MISS INTERPRET (M McNab) – Hampered shortly after the start.

SOPRANO SUPREME (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

SCREEN BELLE (L Satherley) – Had to be steadied after being placed in restricted room passing the 1150 metres.

ENDEAN BAY (E Leighton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted passing the 250 metres.

CARNIVAL LADY (V Colgan) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 700 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider V Colgan could offer no excuse.

D Johnson (SOPRANO SUPREME) – Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear placing SCREEN BELLE in restricted room passing the 1150 metres. Contributing was slight outward movement from MISS INTERPRET.

Race 4

NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1550

CHAMPAGNE PRINCESS (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

PROSPEROUS (C Grylls) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.

CATHAY NOVA (R Elliot) – Improved onto heels passing the 1200 metres having to be steadied. Lay inwards passing the 250 metres when weakening onto the heels of ERIDANI which had shifted out slightly with CATHAY NOVA having to be steadied. J Riddell was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections advised that the mare would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

GREENSLADE (H Schofer) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

RHAPSODY IN BLUE (D Johnson) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1200 metres dropping back onto HIBERNIA SEA which had to be steadied. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

HIBERNIA SEA (T Newman) – Steadied having to shift outwards to avoid heels passing the 1200 metres.

THREADTHE NEEDLE (M McNab) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 5

JULIUS – BELL RACING SPRINT (970 metres)

SAMIRA (M McNab) – Slow to begin (5L). Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's record. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

BON BAY ANOOK (M Hudson) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly in the early and middle stages.

POW WOW (S Spratt) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

FASONG (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly.

PERFECTIONIST (C Grylls) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 6

NZB INSURANCE \$10,000 BONUS HEAT 1 (970 metres)

BELLA VOLAIRE (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly then hampered, losing ground.

IPSO FACTO (D Johnson) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

ODINPOWER (J Kamaruddin) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

SHE'S DASHING (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHARLATAN (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lay out rounding the final bend, placing the rider at a disadvantage.

Race 7 | **TRAVELLING LIGHT 970**

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Lay out throughout the running.

NOZI CYCLONE (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 | **JENNIFER ECCLES 2000**

HEART OF A LION (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ANNALONE (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

CURRENT SURGE (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.

LED ZED (T Newman) – Steadied off heels when making the first bend awkwardly shifting wider forcing EXTERSEA wider passing the 1700 metres. Then commenced to race keenly when being restrained in the middle stages.

EXTERSEA (L Satherley) – Forced wider passing the 1700 metres.

LA FAVORITA (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in when placed under pressure from near the 500 metres.

SPIRIT OF KAHA (C Grylls) – Steadied when placed in restricted room when weakening passing the 500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance C Grylls could offer no excuse.

AMABO (A Calder) – Rider dismounted on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a right fore tendon injury. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate would be required prior to racing next.

Race 9 | **DAVE SNOWDEN'S LEGACY – CAMBRIDGE GRAINS 2000**

SAVAPPIEL (S Spratt) – Shifted out abruptly shortly after the start then raced greenly in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare may have been unsuited to the synthetic surface.

ACE OF SPADES (A Calder) – Hampered shortly after the start.

KOOLASCUZ (J Fillmore) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

MASTER PAINTON (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend before shifting inwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin.

SUFFICE TO SAY (B Rogerson) – Restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

Race 10**GO RACING 2000**

SAVEZAR (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly.

TOUCH THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) – Buffeted shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Contacted passing the 1100 metres with its rider becoming unbalanced then shifted in when being corrected hampering **SHE SPEEDS**. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care. Contacted becoming momentarily unbalanced passing the 250 metres.

SHE SPEEDS (S Spratt) – Hampered passing the 1100 metres.

PIERRO ROSSO (J Riddell) – Buffeted then crowded shortly after the start, losing ground.

SAVASTEP (T Newman) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare is unsuited to the synthetic surface. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

CAPELLANI (B Rogerson) – Rider dropped her whip near the 400 metres.

WILLY AWAY (J Kamaruddin) – Improved into a marginal run to the outside of **CAPELLANI** passing the 250 metres making contact with **TOUCH THE CLOUDS** before having to be steadied after improving onto the heels of **CAPELLANI** approaching the 200 metres.
