RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	NEMS MEDICAL 1550
DRAGON REALM (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.	
THORA'S JOY (V Colgan) – Slow to begin. Contacted and unbalanced for a distance from near the 900 metres until near the 650 metres and forced wide on the track.	

MELILOT (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly and crowded.

LAMBO (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.

GLORIFIED (M McNab) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

S Weatherley (LOCK UP) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

C Barnes (DRAGON REALM) – Admitted a breach of improper riding in that she directed her mount out for a distance from near the 900 metres contacting THORA'S JOY which became unbalanced on numerous occasions until near the 650 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended C Barnes' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 14 July up to and including racing on Saturday 07 August, 11 national riding days.

Race 2 | **CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550**

HIT THE ROAD JACK (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout after improving forward to dispute the pace from near the 900 metres.

SERENGETI (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

THE ACTRESS (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly. Improved onto heels over the final 100 metres.

VITANI (V Colgan) – Crowded 300 metres to the outside of PACHECO which shifted out after being briefly contacted by ALAMODE with VITANI losing ground as a result.

PACHECO (R Elliot) – Jumped the shadow near the 300 metres.

IMPLICIT (E Leighton) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 3 | **BANANA FEEDS AUSTRALIA 1550**

CAPELLANI (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

KIRRA LAD (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

NITRATE (T Newman) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

VIBRATO (E Leighton) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

GLEN FREY (M McNab) – Raced wide in the early stages improving forward to sit outside the leader.

GERI (D Danis) – When questioned regarding performance D Danis could offer no excuse.

Race 4 | **LIQUORLAND CAMBRIDGE 1300**

LINE OF FYRE (E Nicholas) – Hampered soon after leaving the barriers by LA CAPILLA which shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider.

OCEANS OF STANIMA (E McCall) – Restrained soon after leaving the barrier. Over-raced middle stages making contact for a distance near the 900 metres.

LETS NOT FORGET (E Leighton) – Slow to begin.

TREVINO (T Newman) – Steadied off heels when LE CAPILLA lay out under pressure in the concluding stages. D Danis was advised to exercise care.

SUPER CENTIE (L Innes) – Raced in restricted room 900 metres between OCEANS OF STANIMA which had commenced to race keenly and shifted out, and SHADOW MAN which shifted in slightly with SUPER CENTIE becoming unbalanced and then restrained as a result. When questioned regarding performance L Innes advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 5	NZB INSURANCE \$10K BONUS HEAT 3 (1300 metres)

SHANG CHI (K Asano) – Declared a late scratching after arriving at the barrier at 1.41 pm acting on veterinary advice after blood was detected in the nasal area.

JAMESON (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

SPOILER ALERT (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

CIVIL UNREST (A Calder) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier. Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, running wide.

ODINPOWER (T Newman) – Jumped the shadow near the 300 metres.

TELLMESOMETHINGBOY (T Thornton) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

MAENAD (A Goindasamy) – Hung out when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing SPOILER ALERT passing the 100 metres.

T Thornton (TELLMESOMETHINGBOY) – Reminded of her obligations with regards to her whip use.

Race 6	HARRISON'S FENCE PAINTERS 1300

THREADTHENEEDLE (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin.

CASTANI (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

SECRET SHOW (M McNab) – Slow to begin. Not persevered with in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance M McNab advised the gelding had not hit out after beginning poorly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up with Trainer S Marsh in the days subsequent regarding the gelding's condition.

MINI MYSTIC (V Colgan) – Held up for clear running until passing the 100 metres.

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (H Schofer) – When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer M Da Cruz advised that the gelding had appreciated the step up in distance and had been working well leading into today's event.

F Ritchie (RADIANT ROSIE) – Issued with a warning for presenting RADIANT ROSIE without notified gear (blinkers).

Race 7	WAIKATO TRACTORS 1300

LONDON BOUND (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

NOW IS NOW (A Calder) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

BOLT FROM THE BLUE (T Newman) – Steadied over the concluding stages when briefly hampered by **MASTER PARK** which shifted out slightly approaching the winning post.

FIGHTING FIRE (R Elliot) – Improved into restricted room approaching the 400 metres then becoming awkwardly placed near the 250 metres on the heels of **LONDON BOUND** which then shifted out with **FIGHTING FIRE** having to steady as a result. M McNab was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

LOOKSEASY (T Yanagida) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

PABLO CASALS (L Satherley) – When questioned regarding performance L Satherley advised that the gelding had not been entirely suited when racing amongst runners from an inside barrier draw and would likely improve with the run.

E Nicholas (FELIX FAURE) – Issued with a warning after returning to scale 0.5 kgs overweight.

Race 8 | **GUTHRIE BOWRON 970**

WEY TOO COOL (T Thornton) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Was held up for clear running from near the 300 metres and then lay in passing the 150 metres.

NETANYAHU (V Colgan) – Was inclined to lay in in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed near heels passing the 700 metres.

HASSTOBEMAGIC (E Nicholas) – Improved inside the heels of **DOVES BAY** becoming awkwardly placed for a distance from near the 600 metres. Apprentice Rider E Nicholas was reprimanded by Stewards in the presence of Riding Master N Harris and advised she must exercise better judgement.

Race 9 | **PK SOUND 2000**

KOOLASCUZ (J Fillmore) – Slow to begin.

LUDUS (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly. Hampered approaching the 500 metres when crowded by **ASPIRING** which shifted out to avoid the heels of the weakening **RUSALKA**.

ALEGRE (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

PIERRO ROSSO (K Asano) – Over-raced when being restrained 1400 metres.

SELVA VERDE (T Newman) – When questioned regarding performance T Newman advised that the filly was unsuited by the synthetic track conditions.

PROSPEROUS (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Crowded for a distance passing the 300 metres between **SELVA VERDE** which lay out when making the bend despite the efforts of its rider, and **ALEGRE** which shifted in slightly. **PROSPEROUS** was then steadied and shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

NOTHINSWEETABOUTME (E Leighton) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up in days subsequent regarding the condition of the filly.

J Fillmore (KOOLASCUZ) – Admitted a breach in that she used her whip above shoulder height on a runner that was out of contention. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

T Yanagida (ASPIRING) – Issued with a warning after permitting ASPIRING to shift out near the 500 metres when insufficiently clear of LUDUS which was hampered. When assessing the incident Stewards took into account that RUSALKA had been weakening at the time.
