## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>KUROW JOCKEY CLUB MAIDEN 1600m</b>
<b>KENKI</b> (B Murray) – Slow to begin.	
<b>B Murray</b> (KENKI) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JOHN BROWN MEMORIAL 2200m</b>
<b>NESTA</b> (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.	
<b>JACKFROST</b> (J Lowry) – Was restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover.	

**HOT TAP** (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had travelled well enough during the running but had been unable to quicken once placed under pressure in today's very deep and testing track conditions.

**MISS TAVI** (K Williams) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

**Race 3** | **TAPLIN RACING 2200m**

**RAISE YOUR SIGHTS** (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

**COUNTESS RUBY** (C Campbell) – Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

**YING RESOLUTE** (R Mudhoo) – Steadied to avoid the heels of ODYSSEUS which shifted inwards passing the 1900 metres when not fully clear. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.

**GINNY** (K Williams) – Under pressure passing the 700 metres and was not persevered over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer T Kennedy advised that the mare would now be retired.

**ODYSSEUS** (L Callaway) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**C Johnson** (RAISE YOUR SIGHTS) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 4** | **OAMARU CUP WINTER CUP BONUS BET 1400m**

**MANHATTAN FLAME** (D Bothamley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**SO MUCH MOUR** (K Mudhoo) – Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover.

**THE GREEN GREMLIN** (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**WILLPOWER** (T Moseley) – Rider reported the gelding had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure finding today's conditions too testing resuming from a spell.

**Race 5** | **HAPPY 2<sup>ND</sup> BIRTHDAY SADIE WILLIAMSON MAIDEN 1400m**

**NELLIE GREY** (L Callaway) – Slow to begin and failed to keep contact with the body of the field for the majority of the event.

**SPONSOR** (J Lowry) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground.

**LACHIE'S MATE** (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly then shifted outwards becoming briefly unbalanced when making contact with SPONSOR.

**CAROLINE MARGARET** (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**NO QUARTER ASKED** (C Campbell) – Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in today's track conditions.

**Race 6** | **EASY MADE MARMALADE LTD MAIDEN 1200m**

**NO RIGMAROLE** (C Johnson) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

**PANDDE** (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

**MOVIE STAR** (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Briefly steadied just short of the finish when shifting away from PANDDE. Prior to the authorisation of dividends S Wynne viewed films electing not to proceed with an objection.

**SHEZA PRO** (T Jonker) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when over racing and being restrained to obtain cover through the early stages.

**KHITAN WARRIOR** (J Lowry) – Raced keenly in the lead in the early and middle stages. Rider advised that after over racing the gelding had been unable to finish the race off in today's testing track conditions.

**AORANGI ASSASSIN** (T Moseley) – Not persevered with in the straight when well beaten with the rider unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**VIVA LA BLUES** (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.

**ARNAGE** (K Mudhoo) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1100 metres.

**STELLA DAZE** (Z Bholah) – Crowded and had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.

**J Laking** (ROC MUSIC) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount ROC MUSIC to shift inwards when not fully clear of BLEW BY YOU which shifted away from ROC MUSIC placing STELLA DAZE in restricted room with STELLA DAZE having to be steadied losing ground passing the 1000 metres. Contributing was SWEET FIELDS which was being straightened when racing to the inside of STELLA DAZE.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>OAMARU SCAFFOLDING LTD 1600m</b>

**HILLERSDEN** (S Wynne) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching at 4.01 pm on veterinary advice as it was found to be 4/5 lame in the left hind leg. The horse ambulance was deployed to remove the injured horse from the course. Trainer D Crozier was advised that a veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing again.

**ORAKA PLAYBOY** (J Laking) – Slow to begin (4L).

**FAUX PAS** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**YOUVEBEENLITUP** (K Williams) – Checked near the 700 metres. After interviewing riders and viewing films which were somewhat inconclusive it was considered that CHARLIE BROWN had shifted away from BENNY LINCOLN as PEARL DAVONE was attempting to improve to the outside of CHARLIE BROWN then been forced out onto SENOR MOSS causing the check to YOUVEBEENLITUP. Also hampered as a result was YANNICK. Again checked near the 600 metres with films again being inconclusive but there appeared to be movement from runners to either side.

**YANNICK** (D Bothamley) – Hampered near the 700 metres.
