| Race 1 | VICTOR & FRANK MATIJASEVICH HURDLE (3100 metres) |
| <p>BANKS ROAD (M Roustoby) – Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover in the middle stages. Contacted after jumping the second to last fence by OUR CRAFTSMAN which shifted in.</p> <p>AONGATETE EXPRESS (N Downs) – Jumped the last fence awkwardly. Hit the second to last fence. Hit the final fence.</p> <p>RAUCOUS (H McNeill) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Misjudged the fence near the 1150 metres and again near the 1000 metres. Commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>TWIN SPINNER (D James-Parker) – Hit the second to last fence.</p> <p>CARLSBERG (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor jump at the final fence.</p> | |
| Race 2 | RANGIORA EQUINE – JULIE LAURICH MEMORIAL 2200 |
| <p>FIRE DANCER (R Brennan) – Slow to begin losing ground (7L).</p> <p>TAKEITEASY (N Smith) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BRUCIE (S Malki) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CATS RANSOM (S Rennie) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 2100 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>BURCHA (C Isdale) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Shifted out under pressure passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>FLYINGWITHOUTWINGS (S Mynott) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>TYCOON WARRIOR (K Wiles) – Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>M Hill (MRS TWINKLETOES) – Issued with a warning for the manner in which he used his whip.</p> <p>C Isdale (BURCHA) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of TYCOON WARRIOR which was inconvenienced passing the 350 metres.</p> | |
| Race 3 | YELAVICH TRANSPORT LTD 2200 |
| <p>VAN BLANC (S Phelan) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>KEPELLA HEIGHTS (A Roustoby) – Restrained shortly after the start. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's racing performance which would be expected to be more competitive in the future. Mr Rees advised that he was preparing the mare to be tried over fences.</p> <p>RICHARD OF YORKE (M Roustoby) – Raced wide in the middle stages.</p> <p>G Walsh (WINDY HEIGHT) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.</p> | |

C Chipperfield (LOCALLY SAUCED) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

C Chipperfield (LOCALLY SAUCED) – Issued with a warning for leaving the Jockeys area without permission.

S Phelan (VAN BLANC) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 | **STEVE LUNJEVICH CONTRACTING STEEPLECHASE (3500 metres)**

LA JUNGLES (T Moki) – Ran down the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion.

DELEGATE (H McNeill) – Hampered on jumping the fence near the 400 metres on the first occasion.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (J Seivwright) – Misjudged the second to last fence. Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres, having to be steadied.

Race 5 | **FRANK & ANNIE MATIJASEVICH MEMORIAL (3500 metres)**

EL DISPARO (S Phelan) – Stewards granted permission for S Phelan to ride the gelding 1 kg overweight. Made contact with SUFFICE TO SAY jumping the first fence. Put in a poor jump at the final fence losing ground. When questioned regarding performance S Phelan advised that the gelding had felt flat during the running.

SUFFICE TO SAY (S Fannin) – Made contact with EL DISPARO jumping the first fence. Jumped the fence near the 1000 metres awkwardly. Jumped indifferently throughout.

LACUSTRE (C Thornton) – Misjudged the fence near the 600 metres.

ITISWHATITIS (H McNeill) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres when in restricted room. Lost the right fore plate during the running. Received veterinary attention post-race for minor abrasions.

EION (D James-Parker) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres. When questioned regarding performance D James-Parker advised that the gelding had tended to run its fences down throughout.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (K Joyce) – Misjudged the fence near the 600 metres.

Race 6 | **FRED LAURICH MEMORIAL 1200**

DONNSTAR (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.

SNAKEYE (J Seivwright) – Skied its head jumping out of the barriers. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

FOURCHOUX (C Chipperfield) – Slow to begin.

C'EST LA GRIS (E Farr) – Began awkwardly.

K Joyce (SHOCKOVA) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 | **JADRAN BASKETBALL TEAM 1600**

ACQUITTAL (S Fannin) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

YOURMIRRORLIES (C Chipperfield) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Inconvenienced approaching the 350 metres by JUDAH which shifted out when being struck with the whip. T Moki was advised to exercise care.

POCHESTI (E Farr) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards, before being corrected by its rider.

S Fannin (ACQUITTAL) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances allow him to do so.

Race 8 | **MLAADI LAURICH (YOUNG LAURICH'S) 1600**

MR BAZAMOUR (M Roustoby) – Slow to begin (4L).

MARBUZET (S Fannin) – Restrained from its wide barrier in the early stages.

HUSK (N Downs) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1300 metres.

GOODNIGHT IRENE (K Joyce) – Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

GINGER TOO (S Phelan) – Had to shift in passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.

N Downs (HUSK) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
