Race 1 - 17 JULY ITM/GIB WHANGAREI GOLD CUP

TAVIROCK (L Innes) – Stable representative Miss C Myers advised will undergo an endoscopic examination on Monday 12 July. A further follow up with Team Rogerson will be completed by Stewards next week.

Race 7 MOUNTFIELD QUARRY (1200 metres)

NICE FANDANGO (C Grylls) – Co-trainer Mr R Vance reported that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of NICE FANDANGO, however, will look to apply blinkers and a tongue tie prior to the gelding's next race day start.

Race 8 NORTHBEAM TIMBER BEAM AND POSTS (2100 metres)

BARBARA (S Spratt) – Trainer Ms K Grass advised she was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and it is her intention to continue on with BARBARA'S current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 SVS STARTING GATES MILE (1600 metres)**

TIN SOLDIER (E McCall) – Slow to begin.

DELUXE EDITION (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin.

MEKELLE (D Johnson) – Restrained in the early stages. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

TWO MADISON (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TEEN TITAN (E Leighton) – Steadied when placed in restricted room going into the bend near the 850 metres. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

TIMBERLAKE (V Colgan) – Came under pressure near the 800 metres and was a beaten runner shortly after not being persevered with in the straight finishing a distant last. When questioned regarding performance V Colgan advised that the gelding had never travelled well. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

J Riddell (WORDSWORTH) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

E Leighton (TEEN TITAN) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 2 SUPER SETH @ WAIKATO STUD MILE (1600 metres)

The start of this race was delayed due to **POP STAR PRINCESS** having to be re-saddled behind the barriers.

BELT ROAD (K Asano) – Slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding had never travelled in today's track conditions after getting back early appearing to resent the kick back from the track.

CHERRY LANE (T Newman) – Began awkwardly.

BATTLE TIME (E Leighton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SWEET CLEMENTINE (A Calder) – Restrained in the early stages from a wide barrier draw.

POP STAR PRINCESS (E Nicholas) – When questioned regarding performance E Nicholas advised that the mare had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions combined with it's clear topweight carried and stepping up in distance.

Race 3 WAIKATO DRAUGHT MILE (1600 metres)

SON OF SASANOF (T Abel) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 400 metres.

STYAL (K Asano) – Contacted at the start losing ground.

AURORA DOLCE (M McNab) – Jumped away awkwardly. Gave ground approaching the final turn and was eased down in the straight finishing a distant last. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the filly to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing again.

TAVITRONIC (D Danis) – Slow to begin.

FLAVIUS (J Riddell) – Held up early in the straight before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

BARRACUDA (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 | **DYLAN JOHNSON BLOODSTOCK 2YO (1200 metres)**

TREASURE STATE (M McNab) – Slow to begin, then crowded losing ground.

QUARTZ QUEEN (K Asano) – Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover in the early to middle stages.

FLASH MARY (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly making contact with QUARTZ QUEEN.

BURGUNDY DANCER (J Fawcett) – Hampered at the start.

JIMMY JANDAL (T Yanagida) – Crowded at the start.

SAFANIYA (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously when steadying off heels passing the 800 metres. When questioned regarding performance M Hashizume advised that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions and had felt disinterested.

L Satherley (FLASH MARY) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 5 | **GROUP ONE TURF BAR SPRINT (1200 metres)**

BELTOY (B Rogerson) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

MR UNIVERSE (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly then restrained from its wide barrier. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

AERO DE PARIS (E Leighton) – Jumped away awkwardly.

IHU (S Spratt) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

M Hashizume (JUSTASKME) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **SKYCITY HAMILTON STAYERS (2200 metres)**

DIVINE DUKE (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin losing ground.

INNAMINCKA (J Fillmore) – Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

BORDER LEICESTER (D Danis) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

ELLE D'BERRY (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

HUGH GLASS (A Lawson-Carroll) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of ALASKAN GOLD after RODMAR lay out and ALASKAN GOLD shifted inwards away from PEECEE PUSSYCAT.

RODMAR (L Satherley) – Over-raced when being restrained near the 2000 metres.

ALASKAN GOLD (T Abel) – Steadied to avoid the heels of PEECEE PUSSYCAT which shifted inwards near the 2000 metres. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.

DOUBLE HAPPY (M Hashizume) – Connections advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 7	DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 2100
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CASH ME OUSSIDE (E McCall) – Began awkwardly.

FLYING FANTASIA (E Nicholas) – Restrained from its wide barrier in the early stages.

LOT OF ZEES (J Fillmore) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

LANDGRAVE (D Danis) – Began awkwardly.

HAIL DAMAGE (T Yanagida) – Raced ungenerously passing the 1800 metres having to be restrained. Over-raced in the early stages making the first turn awkwardly when having to be firmly restrained to avoid heels.

TAIKA (V Colgan) – Over-raced when being restrained near the 1600 metres.

SHEBRINGSMERUBIES (J Kamaruddin) – Lost left front plate during the running.

THE BOUNDER (E Leighton) – Disappointed for a run near the 200 metres.

CLEESE (M McNab) – Rider advised that the gelding may have held its breath and had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary clearance which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

A Goindasamy (TOUCH THE CLOUDS) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

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DIAMOND DELIGHT (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

ROCKWITHATTITUDE (J Riddell) – Slow to begin then crowded shortly after the start by GNASHER.

GARNET (A Calder) – Began awkwardly.

GNASHER (E Leighton) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards and raced ungenerously in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance E Leighton advised that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

HIT THE SWITCH (D Danis) – Began awkwardly.

FINN MCCOOL (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TICKLE ME ALMO (L Satherley) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

RUBYSHOWOFF (T Newman) – When questioned regarding performance T Newman advised that the filly had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

J Fawcett (PACIFIC MASTER) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
