Race 1	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)
<p>MOOVIT ONOVA (S Weatherley) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was then restrained.</p> <p>SHOW US PLENTY (R Elliot) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>OVER THE MOON (T Newman) – Held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>M Hashizume (ME LIBEREZ) – Defended a charge of careless riding after reducing the speed of his mount abruptly near the 900 metres shifting back onto BARRI HYDE which clipped a heel and blundered with the Judicial Committee finding the charge proven, suspending his license to ride at race meetings for 3 national riding days effective from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 27 June up to and including racing on Saturday 3 July.</p>	
Race 2	STELLAR BACKDROPS 1200
<p>RED INFERNO (J Fawcett) – Late scratched at 12.21 pm after refusing to enter the barrier. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>BULLYBROOK (C Jones) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HONG KONG'S FOLKS (M Hashizume) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TINY TERROR (E McCall) – Lay out under pressure early in the final straight making contact with PACIFIC MASTER approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p>PACIFIC MASTER (J Kamaruddin) – Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p>NITRATE (T Newman) – Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres when being restrained making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>FONTES DE L'ALGAR (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p> <p>J Kamaruddin (PACIFIC MASTER) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p>	
Race 3	MONARCH CAFÉ 1200
<p>SILVERSTREAM (B Rogerson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>CINNAMON STAR (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>KID ROC (J Kamaruddin) – Crowded at the start. Shifted in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>MARLEY (C Jones) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LITTLE MADAM (E Leighton) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>ANTIGUA (T Abel) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.</p>	

E Nicholas (SNAKEYE) - Admitted a breach in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

B Foote (KID ROC) – Trainer B Foote was permitted to race KID ROC without gear which had been notified (side winkers) and was fined \$150 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 4 | **DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 1200**

STREET CAT (E McCall) – Began awkwardly. Crowded and checked 900 metres.

BANG BANG (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly and restrained. Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

SHOW 'N' TEASE (L Satherley) – Crowded and checked 900 metres.

GNASHER (E Leighton) – Held up entering the final straight shifting out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running. Rider dropped her whip near the 350 metres.

C Grylls (GREY WOLF) – Admitted a charge of careless riding after permitting his mount to shift in near the 900 metres when not sufficiently clear of AURORA STAR which was dictated in crowding STREET CAT and SHOW 'N' TEASE which were both checked with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride at race meetings for 4 national riding days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 July up to and including racing on Saturday 10 July and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 5 | **HAUNUI FARM 1400**

WHO'S SAM (E Leighton) – Contacted and unbalanced at the start losing ground.

KING KHAN (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the middle stages.

HIT THE SWITCH (D Danis) – Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing ROCHMIE RAY approaching the 250 metres.

Race 6 | **ALF COLE MEMORIAL 1600**

BUNKERS (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.

REY SOL (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly then crowded.

HARD DONE (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages when disputing the pace.

Race 7 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 metres)**

MODESTY (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 1400 metres.

MRS BIG (C Dell) – Slow to begin.

GINGER BERRY (C Jones) – Raced greenly when making the crossing onto the course proper approaching the 1400 metres shifting out and hampering DAADS EXPRESS and MODESTY. Raced greenly when improving to lead passing the 1000 metres. Raced greenly through the middle stages slowing considerably, making the corner awkwardly. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's racing manners. Trainer S Ralph advised that the mare was not likely to be persevered with as a racing proposition.

DAADS EXPRESS (E McCall) – Slow to begin.

CANNSEA CLEARLY (J Kamaruddin) – Hampered for a distance passing the 900 metres when improving to the inside of the heels of GINGER BERRY which was racing greenly and had slowed considerably.

KEPELLA HEIGHTS (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAESTRO BLU (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZENNTARI (H Schofer) – Steadied from a wide barrier. Contacted 1000 metres by MAESTRO BLU which shifted out

CERYs (A Calder) – Steadied from a wide barrier.

HUSK (A Goindasamy) – Crowded approaching the 400 metres by HOT PINX which shifted in when over-racing.

V Colgan (TIMBERLAKE) – Reminded of his obligation with regards to whip use prior to the 100 metres.

H Schofer (ZENNTARI) – Reminded of her obligation with regards to whip use prior to the 100 metres.
