Race 3 TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS HAWKE'S BAY HURDLE (3100m)

BAK DA MASTER (M Roustoby) – Stable representative Miss L Richards advised Stewards, upon return to the stable, BAK DA MASTER, underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have slight swelling behind the right fore knee. L Richards further advised the swelling is now being treated with an anti-inflammatory and BAK DA MASTER, will not be partaking in trackwork until the swelling has subsided.

Race 6 JUST A SWAGGER / PERRY MASON STEEPLECHASE (4000m)

WICKLOW (L Douglas) – Trainer Mr W Wheeler advised Stewards; he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding.

Race 7 AHD HAWKE'S BAY STEEPLECHASE (4800m)

IT'S A WONDER (S Phelan) – Trainer Mr H Wilson advised Stewards, IT'S A WONDER, underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 5 July, with no abnormalities being detected, however, H Wilson further advised, IT'S A WONDER showed signs of lameness on Thursday 8 July, which revealed the gelding to have a stone bruise to the near fore sole. IT'S A WONDER will not partake in trackwork until the stone bruise subsides.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 DONAGHYS N-BOOST (2200m)**

STORMY HABIT (V Mason) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

I AM A CRAFTSMAN (M Singh) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages restrained off heels passing the 1500 metres. I AM A CRAFTSMAN had to be steadied when over racing in the back straight.

MANDALAY (M Hill) - Slow to begin.

SPEED CALL (A Scott) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced with SPEED CALL then becoming noticeably detached for some distance behind the body of the field prior to making a sustained run to lead towards the end of the back straight. SPEED CALL weakened out over the final stages to finish last. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small cut to the near fore hoof consistent with having struck itself during the running but otherwise no significant abnormality.

MASTER FIN (J van Niekerk) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

KIDDO (S Malki) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

JUNIOR (L Phelan) - Held up for a distance approaching the 300 metres.

LUCKY VIKING (M Northcott) - Raced in restricted room rounding the home turn.

FANTASY FLIGHT (S MacNab) - Held up for some distance around the turn and in the early part of the home straight behind the weakening SPEED CALL gaining clear running over the final stages.

A Scott (SPEED CALL) - Charged with a breach of [Rule 636 (1)(b)] in that he failed to take all reasonable and permissible measures with the matter being adjourned to a date to be set.

Race 2 ULTRASCAN/SANFORDS (2200m)

CHICA BONITA (M Singh) – Began awkwardly then steadied from a wide barrier.

MAJELLA MAY (E McCall) – Raced keenly when being restrained passing the 1700 metres becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of IAN'S LEGACY (D Hirini) which shifted in when not fully clear. D Hirini was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. MAJELLA MAY then raced wide without cover.

Race 3 FOREST360/SPORTZBAR (2200m)

SILENT APPROACH (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly then crowded and steadied. Raced in restricted room early in the final straight to the inside of WEST COAST which lay in.

KANGAROO (J Mudhoo) - Restrained soon after leaving the barriers.

VANGUARD (R Elliot) - Restrained soon after leaving the barriers.

WEST COAST (C Dell) - Restrained soon after leaving the barriers.

VALZITABELLA (D Danis) - Raced keenly in the early stages shifting out passing the 1700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near heels contacting COUNTRY BUMPKIN which was forced wider on the track.

COUNTRY BUMPKIN (T Newman) – Forced wide 1700 metres.

LEGALLY BLONDE (K Hercocock) – Hampered 500 metres when having to be restrained off the heels of the weakening VALZITABELLA.

WEST COAST (C Dell) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

NONAAME (E Leighton) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

Race 4 | **WAVERLEY MOTORS/MURDOCH CONT. (1200m)**

LESLEY HEIGHTS (C O'Beirne) – Very slow to load. Trainer A Clement was advised that a warning would be placed against its barrier manners. Slow to begin. Became tailed off in the early stages and was uncompetitive with a further warning being placed on its racing manners.

COSMIC ROC (C Dell) - Began awkwardly and crowded then hung out in the early stages running wide when making the bend near the 800 metres becoming tailed off. Trainer G Smith was advised that the filly would have a warning placed against its racing manners.

ALL THAT JAZZ (H Schofer) – Slow to begin.

KEANTOKISS (C Jones) – Hung badly when making the final bend ducking out approaching the 200 metres. Trainer J Bliss would be placed on its racing manners.

PULL NO PUNCHES (T Taiaroa) – Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres prior to being angled inwards to improve. Became awkwardly placed near heels over the concluding stages.

T TAIAROA (PULL NO PUNCHES) - Was reminded of her obligations to ride her horse out to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

Race 5 | **IPILEX PIPELINES (1200m)**

TRENDY BELT (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

OLD TOWN ROAD (L Allpress) - Restrained from its wide barrier.

ROSCHANA (T Newman) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

Race 6 | **MAD BUTCHER-WANGANUI (1400m)**

WHISKEY TANGO (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

RONI (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly.

TSUNAMI (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly. Hampered in the early part of the home straight.

BELCLARE (S Macnab) - Raced wide throughout

THE BLIKSEM (K Hercock) - Hampered 250 metres by GALAXY POWER (D Danis) which ducked in when struck with the whip before being corrected by its rider. D Danis was advised to exercise more care in a similar circumstance.

TORRENT (H Schofer) - Finished some distance last – H Schofer had no excuse.

E LEIGHTON (FLEETWOOD BAY) - Issued with a warning under [Rule 638 (1)(d)] for allowing her mount to shift out early in the home straight when not clear.

Race 7 | **TREADWELL GORDON/MARKHAMS (1650m)**

PINSK (D de Oca) - Was removed from the barrier after becoming fractious and declared a late scratching at 2.22pm acting on veterinary advice. Connections were advised the filly must trial prior to its next start.

ESTABLISHMENT (S Macnab) - Slow away.

ONE TO DIE FOR (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EIGHT MILE (C Jones) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TRAMORE (L Kauri) restrained from its wide barrier.

SAME IT'S OVER (M Singh) – Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **NUFARM (1650m)**

SWEET KARMA (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

D MONTES DE OCA (SWEET KARMA) - Was issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift in near the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of ALBUFEIRA which was hampered. Stewards took into account the inconclusive video coverage when assessing the interference.

ALBUFEIRA (D Hirini) – Hampered 1200 metres losing ground.

SHOCKING PIERRE (S Macnab) - Slow to begin.

SPANISH HARLEM (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

HARDTIMES (M Hudson) - Improved up on to heels when over-racing near the 1400 metres and had to be steadied for a distance. Crowded over the concluding stages and steadied.

PLATINUM BORDEAUX (H Schofer) - Held up early in the home straight. Crowded 200 metres. Crowded 100 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

OUR FAIR TRADE (J Parkes) - Raced greenly in the home straight.

JENEVER (L Hemi) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight. Crowded 50 metres hampered and lost ground.

J PARKES (OUR FAIR TRADE) – J Parkes admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in over the final 60 metres when not clear of HARDTIMES, JENEVER and PLATINUM BORDEAUX which were all crowded with JENEVER losing ground. OUR FAIR TRADE ducked in near the finish further hampering HARDTIMES. J Parkes had

his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 15 July up to and including racing on 22 July and fined the sum of \$200.

Race 9 | **GRANGEWILLIAM STUD (1650m)**

RUN LIKE BOO (R Elliot) - Crowded and hampered shortly after leaving the barriers.

RHUZICK (C Dell) - Crowded and hampered shortly after leaving the barriers. RHUZICK then raced ungenerously for a distance through the middle stages.

PRINCE TURBO (F Lazet) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

F LAZETT (PRINCE TURBO) will be spoken to regarding the use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

FATTORE OTTO (L Allpress) - Raced in restricted room for a distance from near the 400 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

MAUNA LOA (C Jones) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

FULL SWING (M Hudson) – Finished well back and rider had no excuse.

Race 10 | **NRM AND MCMILLAN EQUINE (1650m)**

BIG BEN (L Kauri) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers and steadied. Over-raced in the middle stages.

MATARO (R Elliot) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers and steadied.

TIRO (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly

GOBUYIT (J Fawcett) - Raced ungenerously passing the 1300 metres getting its head up shifting back onto ZEEFA ZED which was hampered and shifted in crowding RAZORS EDGE which lost ground.

SMOOTH COGNAC (D Hirini) – Crowded 200 metres between PRINCESS ANI which shifted in when being struck with the whip before being corrected by its rider and FREE SPIRIT which lay out when contacted.

ZEEFA ZED (D Montes de Oca) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.
